## 1 Child Welfare Services Respite Program

### 2 What is Respite?

- ▶ Respite is intermittent care for children
- ▶ All families with at least one dependent of San Diego County Court qualify
- ▶ Foster families are granted 50 Respite hours per calendar quarter
  - · Q1- Jan-March
  - · Q2- April-June
  - · Q3- July-Sept.
  - · Q4- Oct.-Dec.

## 3 Requesting Care

- ▶ Respite is available to caregivers 24/7
- Respite should be requested at least one week in advance
- ▶ Emergency requests are accepted
- ▶ Care can be provided in the family's home or in the provider's home

### 4 🖾 Hours

- ▶ Hours that are not utilized for the quarter will not roll over to the next quarter
- It is the responsibility of the parents to keep track of the hours utilized
  - · Foster families that go over their authorized hours are responsible for the remaining charges
- Families are encouraged to call the office if they are unsure of how many hours they have left

### 5 Hours Continued

- **▶** Excess Hours
  - Excess hours are granted occasionally for special circumstances.
  - They must be requested and approved before the respite takes place
  - Requests are submitted by the caregiver's social worker
  - Maxim has no control over approvals

### 6 Restrictions

- ▶ Respite cannot be used for employment purposes
- ▶ The County has identified the hours between10 pm 6 am to be the designated 8 hours of sleep time
  - Under the contract, these 8 hours will not count towards the allotted 50 hours
  - Under the contract, these 8 hours will not be paid to the provider
- ▶ Providers are not allowed to drive children without prior office approval
- ▶ Providers are not allowed to give <u>any</u> medication to the children
  - Medication reminders are allowed
- Families enrolled in the Options program are not allowed to receive respite through Maxim

#### 7 Join the Maxim Team

- ▶ In order to be considered for a position, candidates must have the following requirements:
  - CPR & First Aid Certification
    - Completed in a classroom setting with return demonstration
  - TB test
  - Done within the past 90 days\*
  - Approved Home Care Aide Registration and LiveScan

## 8 Pay Rates

- ▶1 child
  - Up to 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$12
  - After 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$18
- ▶2 or more children
  - Up to 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$14
  - After 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$21
- ▶ 1 child (Medically Fragile)
  - Up to 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$13
  - After 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$19.50
- ▶ 2 or more children (Medically fragile)
  - Up to 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$19.28
  - After 9 hours- Amount paid to provider \$28.92
