## Key Points:

- Two cohorts per year
- Program length: 10 weeks or less (to be determined at this time based on COVID-19 abatement).
- Promotion to PHN by six months and after receiving the CA PHN certificate.
- Competency-based curriculum includes: interactive lectures/presentations online readings, site tours, clinical rotations, one on ones, group activities and a leadership project.
- The PHN placement is based on the nurse resident's area of interest and County operational needs.
- Potential candidates should follow these steps:
  - ✓ Link to the job posting will be sent out to local BSN Schools of Nursing
  - ✓ Fill out on-line application
  - ✓ Human Resources will notify qualified candidates of an interview
  - ✓ Offers of employment will be determined by resume and interview through the HR department.
