

<b>California Children’s Services (CCS)</b>	<b>Medical Managed Care Plans (MCP)</b>	<b>*San Diego Regional Center</b>	<b>*HMO</b>	<b>*PPO</b>
<p>CCS funds treatment and services that are specific to the CCS eligible condition. Treatment services may include Specialist MD visits (Cardiology, Pulmonary, Neurology, etc.), Special Care Center visits (Endocrinology, Craniofacial, Hematology/Oncology, etc.), Emergency visits, medications and DMEs that are related to CCS eligible condition.</p>	<p>Your Medi-Cal managed care plan- MCP (Community Health, Molina, Health Net, Kaiser, United Healthcare, Blue Shield/Care 1<sup>st</sup>, Aetna,) funds general health care visits and majority of healthcare. Such as well child checks, immunizations and other health conditions that do not qualify for CCS. If CCS denies a service, it will get deferred to your MCP.</p>	<p>*Not all may be eligible for San Diego Regional Center services. One may be eligible for SD Regional Center services if there is an intellectual disability. SD Regional Center may fund services and treatment when it is related to the Patient’s intellectual disability. If Patient is eligible for Regional Center services, they should have a Regional Center case worker who can address case.</p>	<p>*If your case is open for non-Benefit services/DMEs and/or Medical Therapy Program, then all of child’s treatment is funded by the HMO, <i>except</i> those that are a “Non-Benefit” of the HMO service.</p>	<p>*If your case is open and you have a PPO, services will be billed to the PPO first, and then CCS.</p>
