Introduction to the Demographic Profiles

History

The Community Health Statistics Unit (CHSU), under the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) Public Health Services Department, was formed in 2005 to provide a single point of contact for public health data and support to the HHSA Regions and their communities. CHSU generates publications including: the Community Health Profiles, topic specific reports (e.g., older adult falls, economic burden of disease, health disparities, and health status), health briefs, fact sheets, atlases, and the demographic profiles, all of which are available at www.sdhealthstatistics.com.

The *City Demographic Profiles* are a compilation of information relating to demographic characteristics of specific populations in San Diego County. Each profile contains demographic data for municipalities (incorporated cities) including age, sex, race/ethnicity distributions, school enrollment, educational attainment, income, occupation, housing, and other social/economic data. Many of these factors have been implicated at the roots of health disparities.

The purpose of the *City Demographic Profiles* is to provide detailed information about the characteristics of the people living in San Diego County. It is designed to help HHSA staff in each of the Health and Human Services Regions (Regions) and other local organizations, including *Live Well San Diego* recognized partners, to identify and prioritize needs within their communities. These profiles are made available to the public health community and public policymakers to better understand and manage the health and well-being of the residents of our County.

Source of Data

The Census is conducted every 10 years to provide an official count of the entire population in the United States to Congress. The American Community Survey (ACS), on the other hand, is conducted every year by the U.S. Census Bureau to provide more current estimates of the population. The ACS collects sociodemographic and economic data annually; topics include educational attainment, income, poverty, disability, health insurance, workforce and more to describe the population living in the United States. Per Title 13, U.S. Code, completing either or both the Census and the ACS is required by law if your household is selected. Personal identification is protected, but data in aggregate form is released to provide information needed for planning purposes and programs.

If you are looking for official population totals, the U.S. Census Bureau recommends using the 2010 or 2020 Census. However, the ACS provides a more current picture of the population and population characteristics. While ACS estimates are derived from a much smaller sample, data are collected from a representative sample of the population in the nation. Because ACS variables may change over time, some areas and subjects must be compared with caution, or not compared at all.

The Census Bureau recommends that you^{1,2}:

- DO compare similar period lengths, for example, 5-year to 5-year.
- DON'T compare estimates from different period lengths, for example, 1-year to 5-year.
- DO compare estimates from non-overlapping periods, for example, compare a 2013-2017 ACS 5-year estimate to a 2018-2022 ACS 5-year estimate.
- DON'T compare overlapping periods, for example, the 2017-2021 ACS 5-year estimates to the 2018-2022 ACS 5-year estimates.

Why use 5-year estimates?^{1,2}

- Cover 60 months of collected data; for example, from January 1, 2018 to December 31, 2022.
- Data is collected for all areas (including census blocks and tracts), which makes this the largest sample size
- Most reliable, but least current
- Released every year since 2009

Methodology

Data is downloaded for each of the 18 incorporated cities in San Diego County, California, and the United States. Wherever possible, the data for the Unincorporated Area of San Diego, which is managed by San Diego County, is derived from the data available.

Please note that the indicators in the demographic profiles are reviewed every year. Indicators will be added per number of requests showing the need for these to be included and/or modified as needed.

For the 2018-2022 version, indicators for children under 18 years in households by relationship to householder and by household type were added. Previous indicators were not modified for this version.

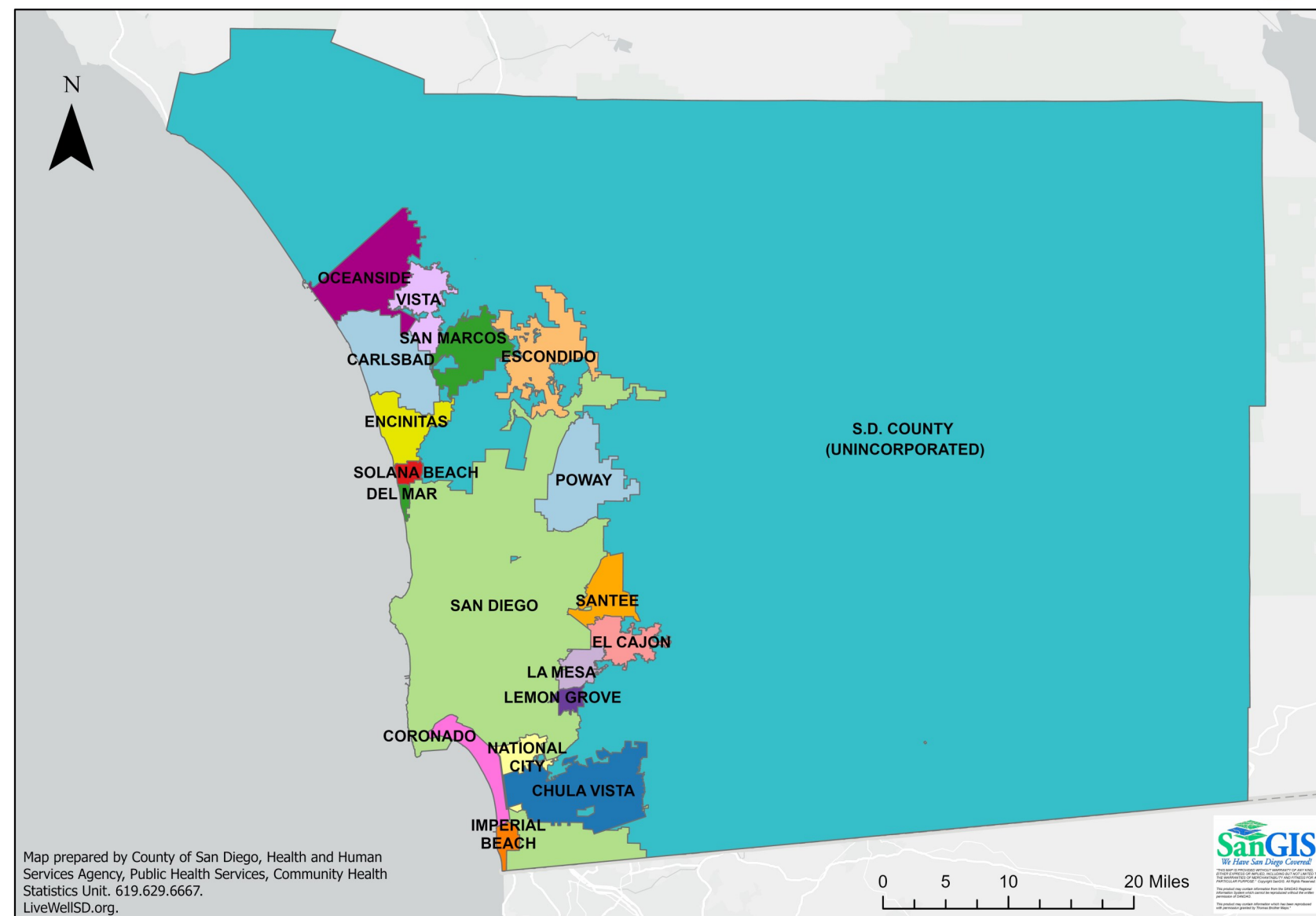

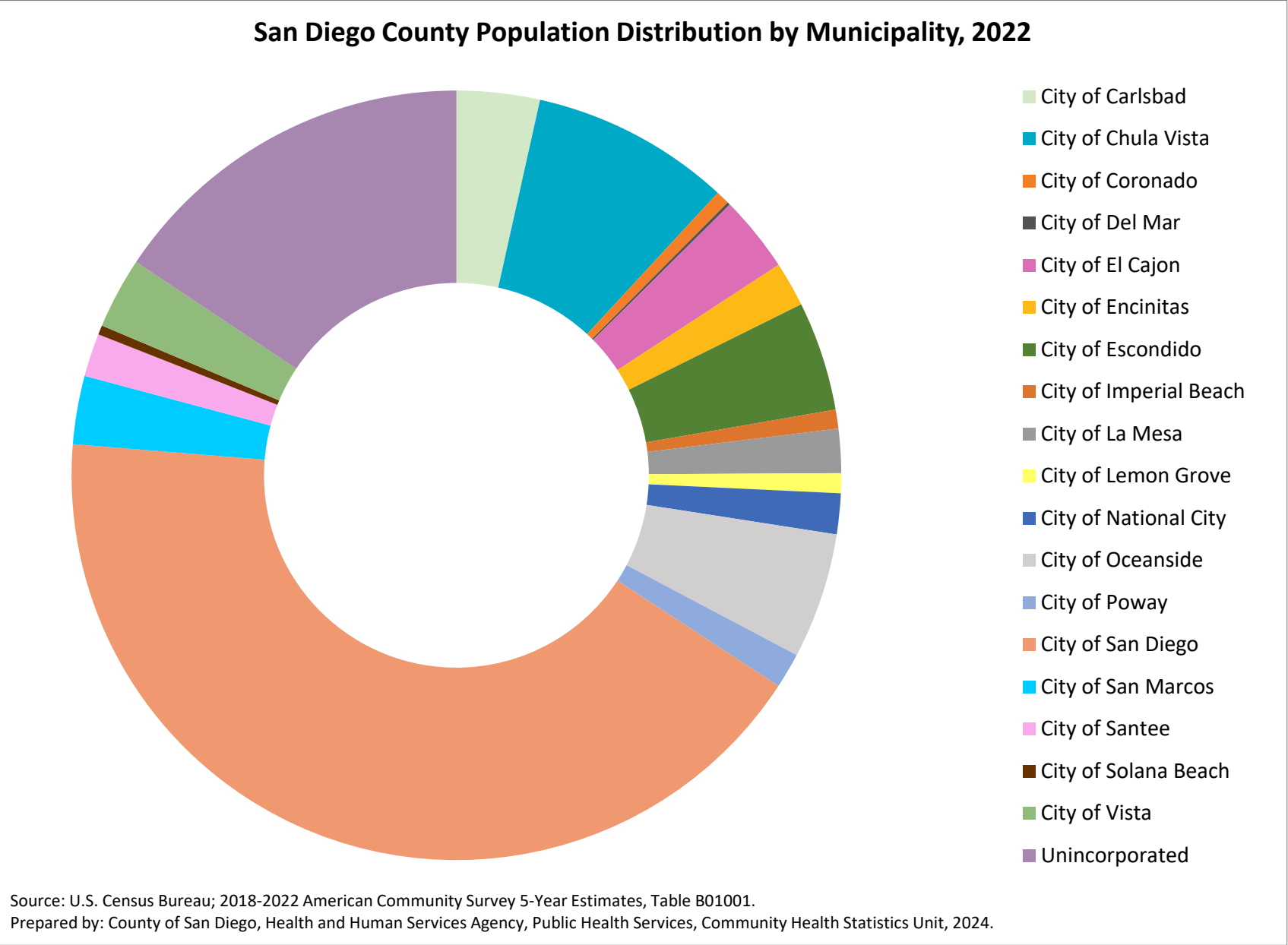

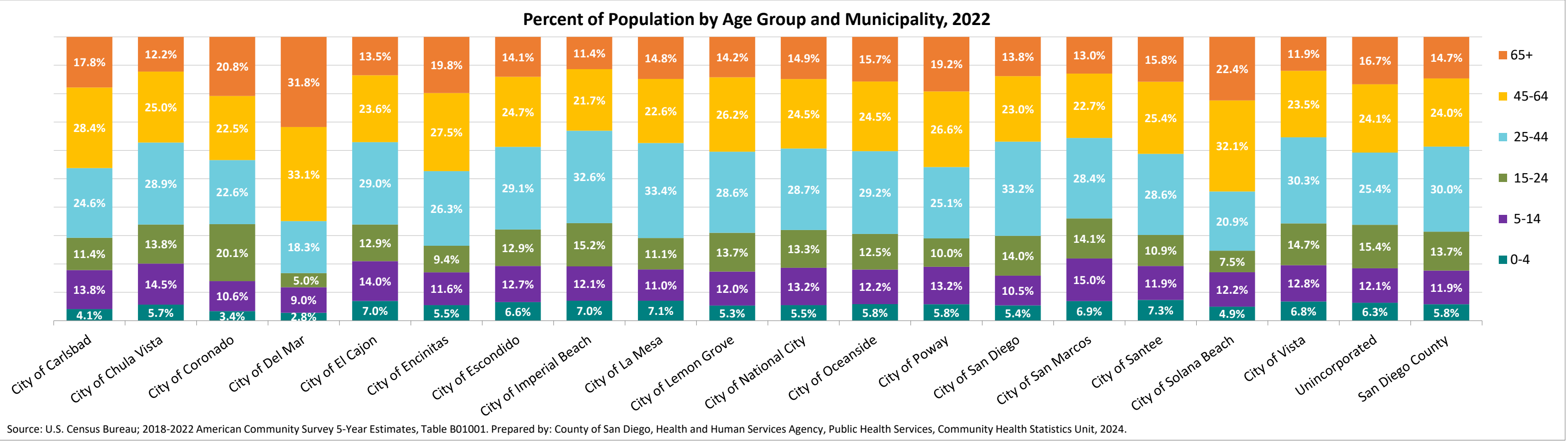
Total Population by Age Group

Older Adult Population by Age Group

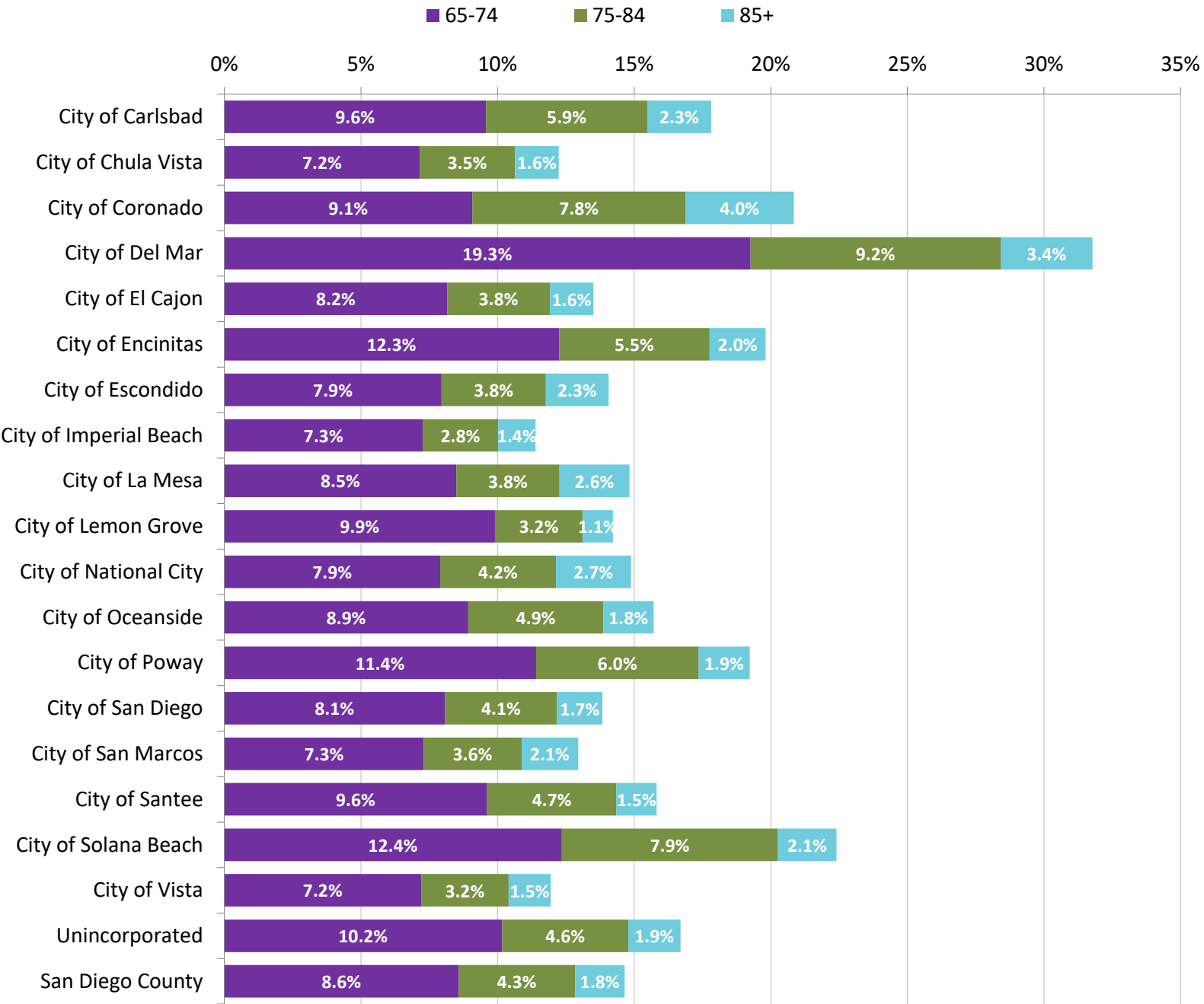

Percent* of Older Adult Population by Age Group and Municipality, 2022



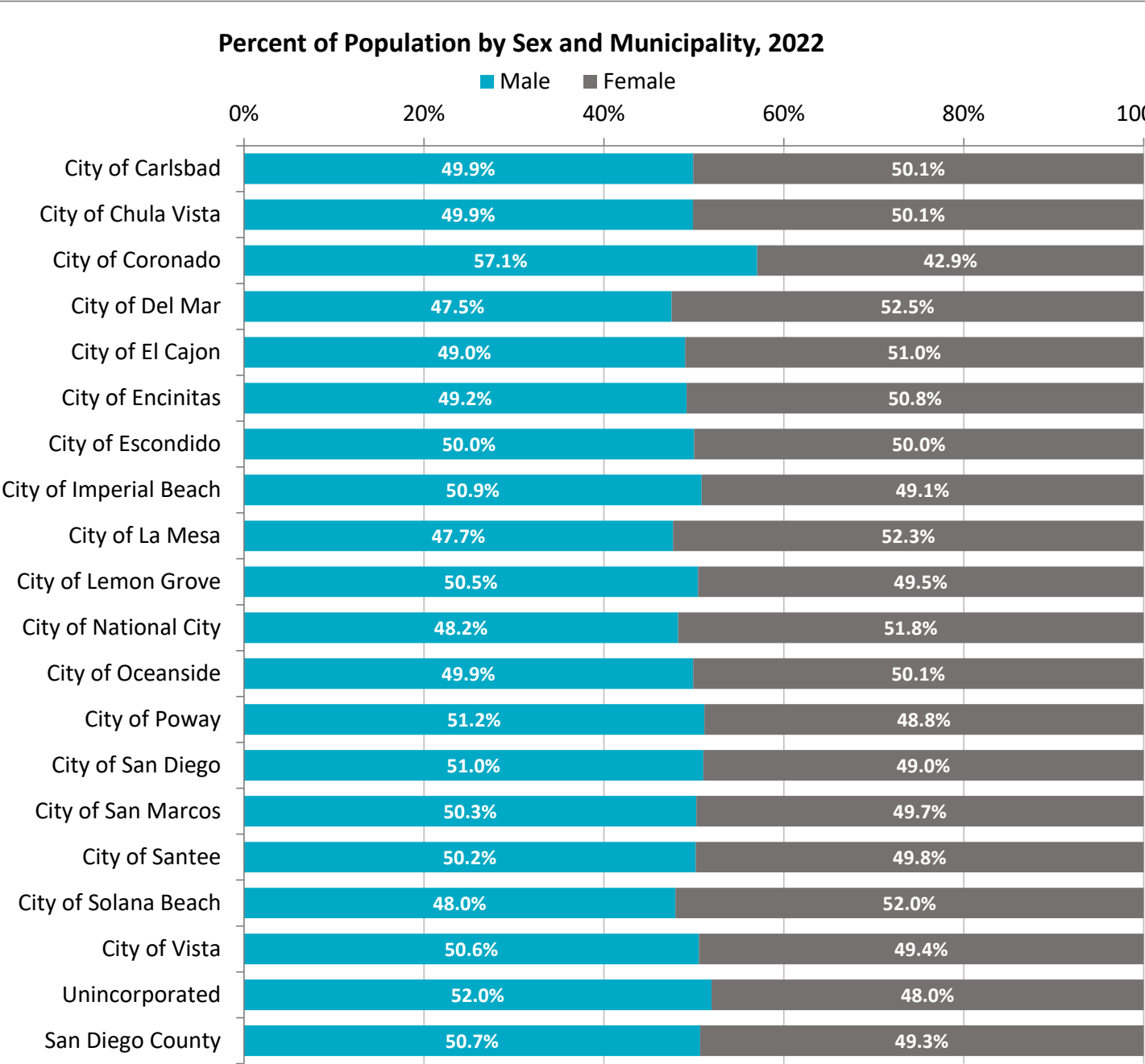

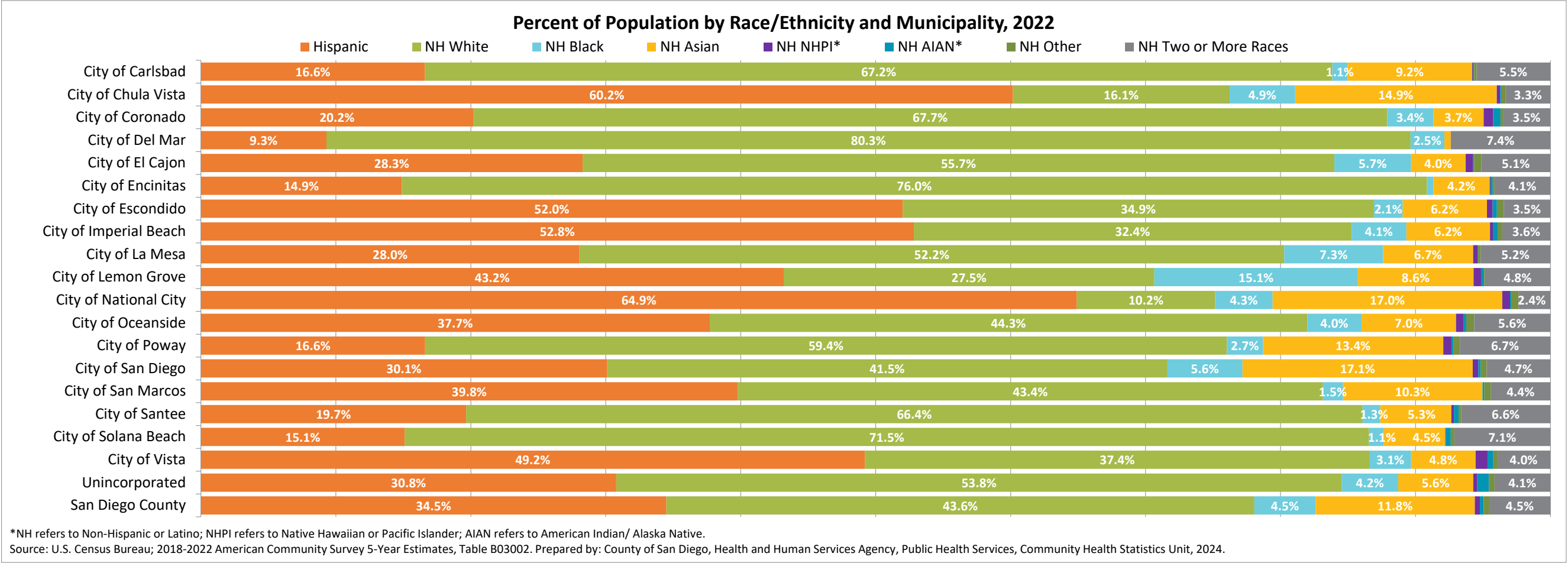

Note: In previous iterations of the Demographic Profiles, American Indian/Alaska Native (AIAN) and Two or More Races had been part of the 'Other' category.

Beginning in 2017, 'AIAN' became a unique category. In previous iterations of the Demographic Profiles, Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander (NHPI) was included in the Asian/Pacific Islander (API) category.

Beginning in 2018, NHPI and Two or More Races became unique categories. *NHPI refers to Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander; AIAN refers to American Indian/Alaska Native.

How to interpret these data: In 2022, San Diego County's population was 34.5% Hispanic. Among the non-Hispanic population, 43.6% were White, 4.5% Black, 11.8% Asian, 0.4% Native Hawaiian or Pacific Islander (NHPI), 0.3% American Indian/Alaska Native (AIAN), 4.5% two or more races, and 0.4% other.

How to interpret these data: Among the Asian/Pacific Islander (API) population in San Diego County in 2022, Filipino, Chinese (except Taiwanese), and Vietnamese were the most populous races with 153,691; 61,476; and 48,314 people, respectively.

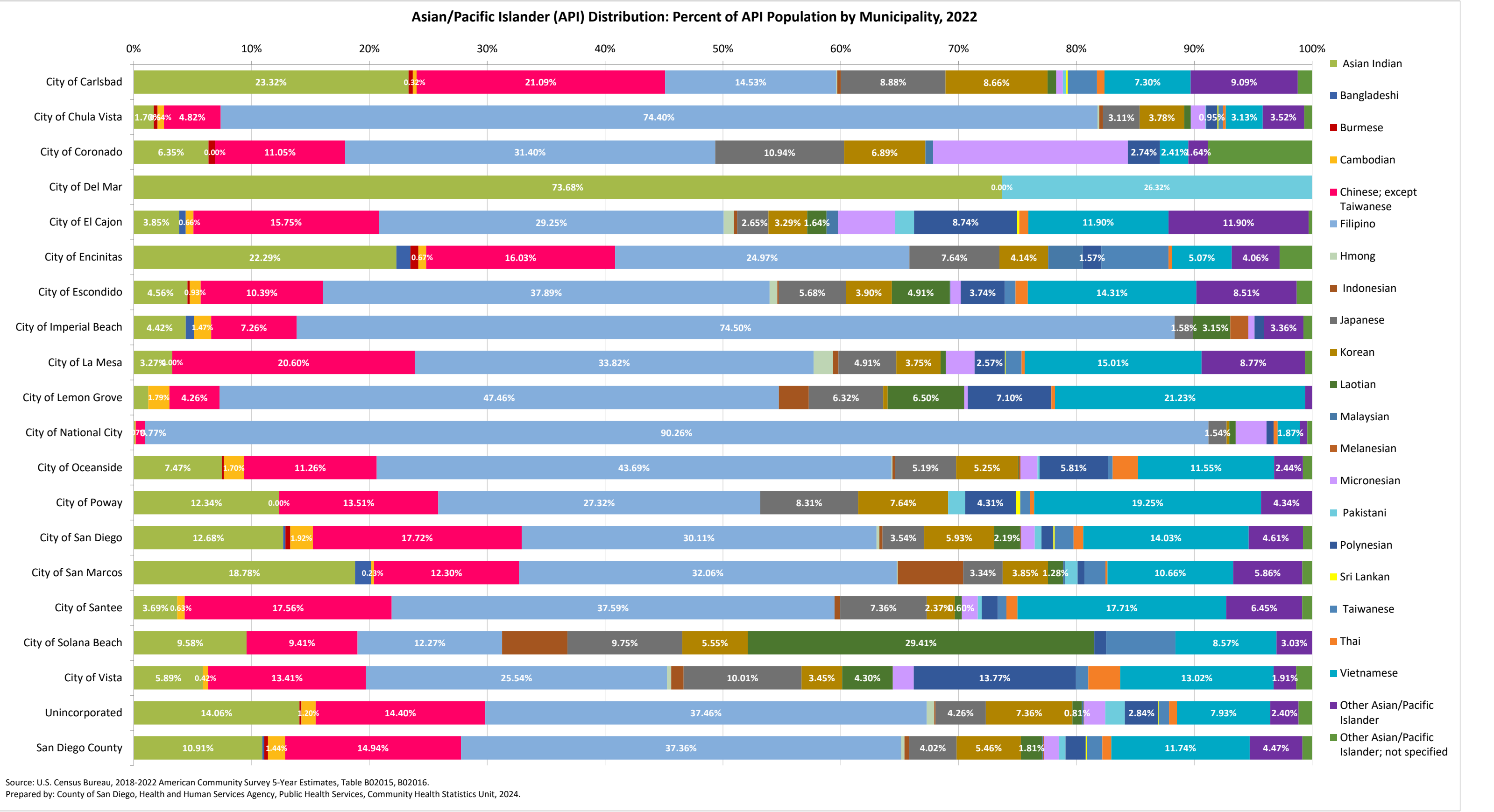

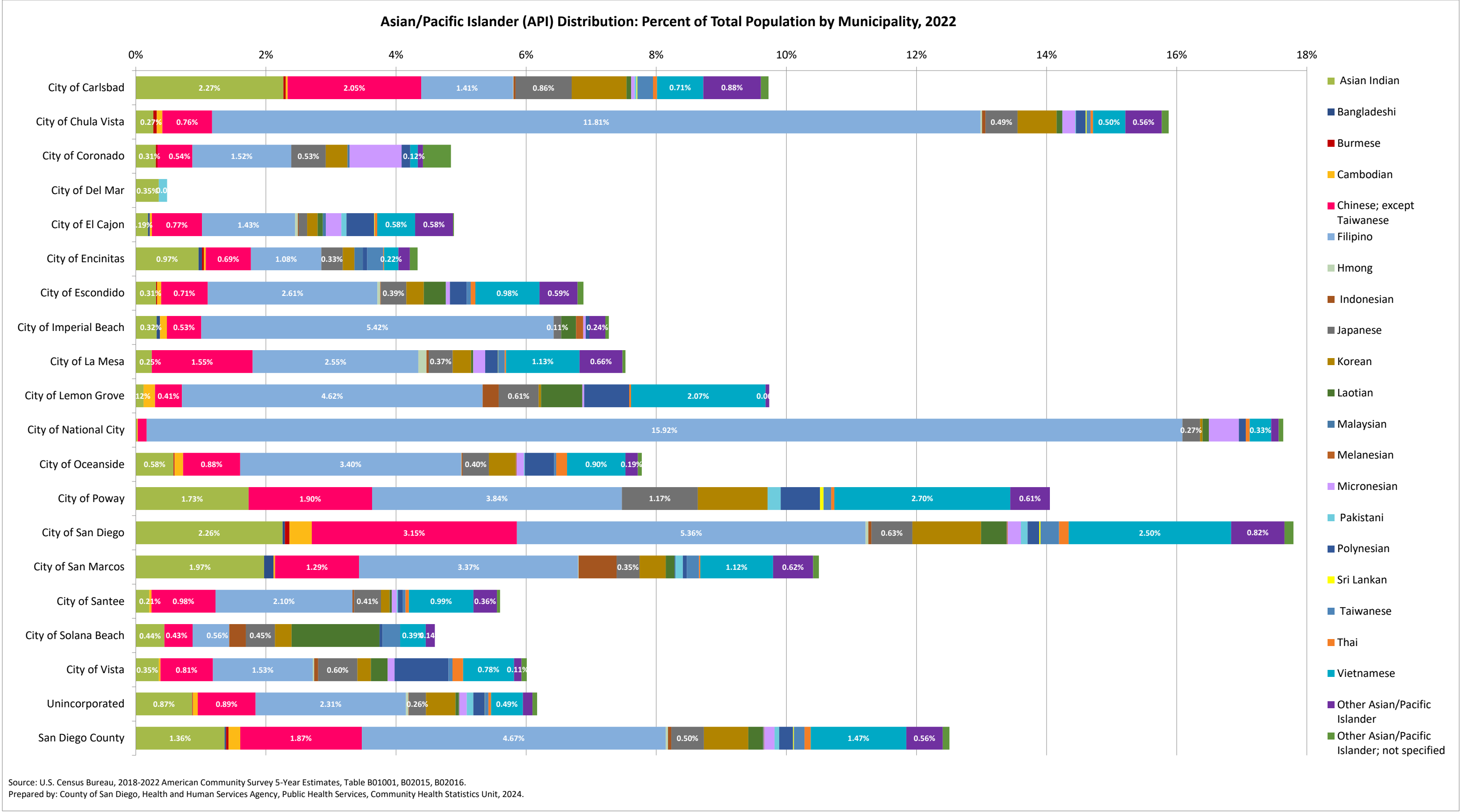
Asian/Pacific Islander (API) Distribution: Percent of Total Population

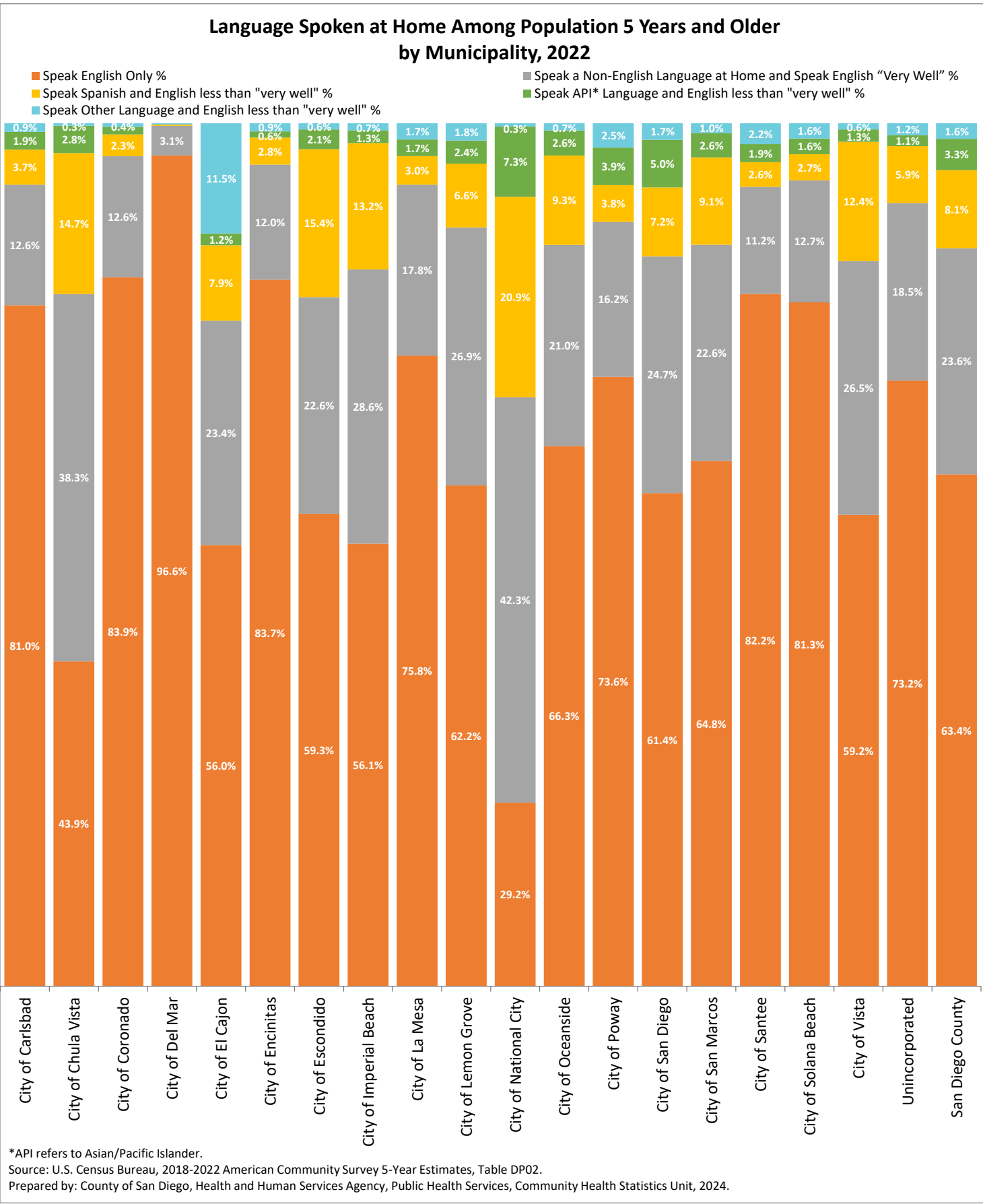

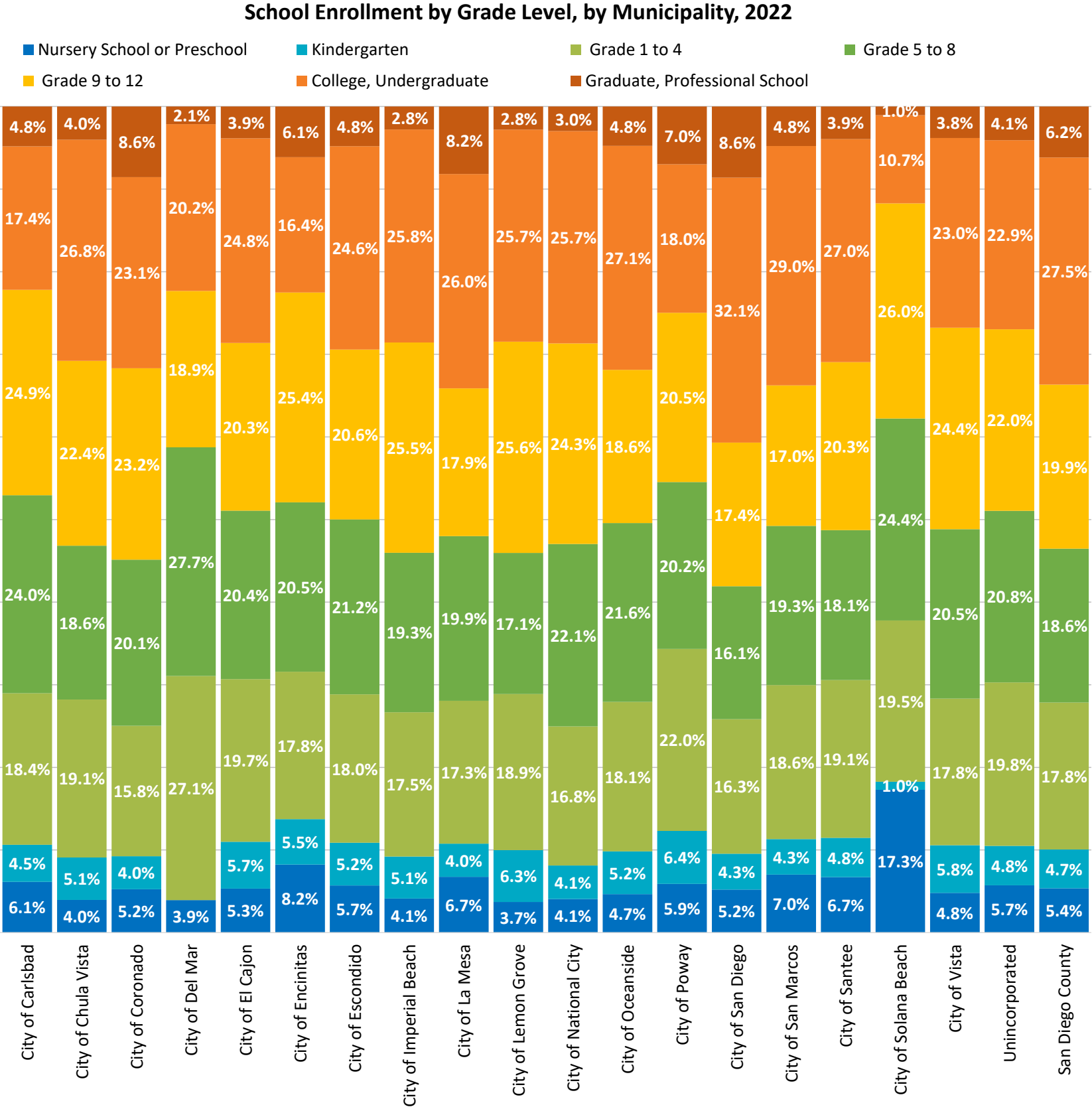

Educational Attainment Among Population 25 Years and Older

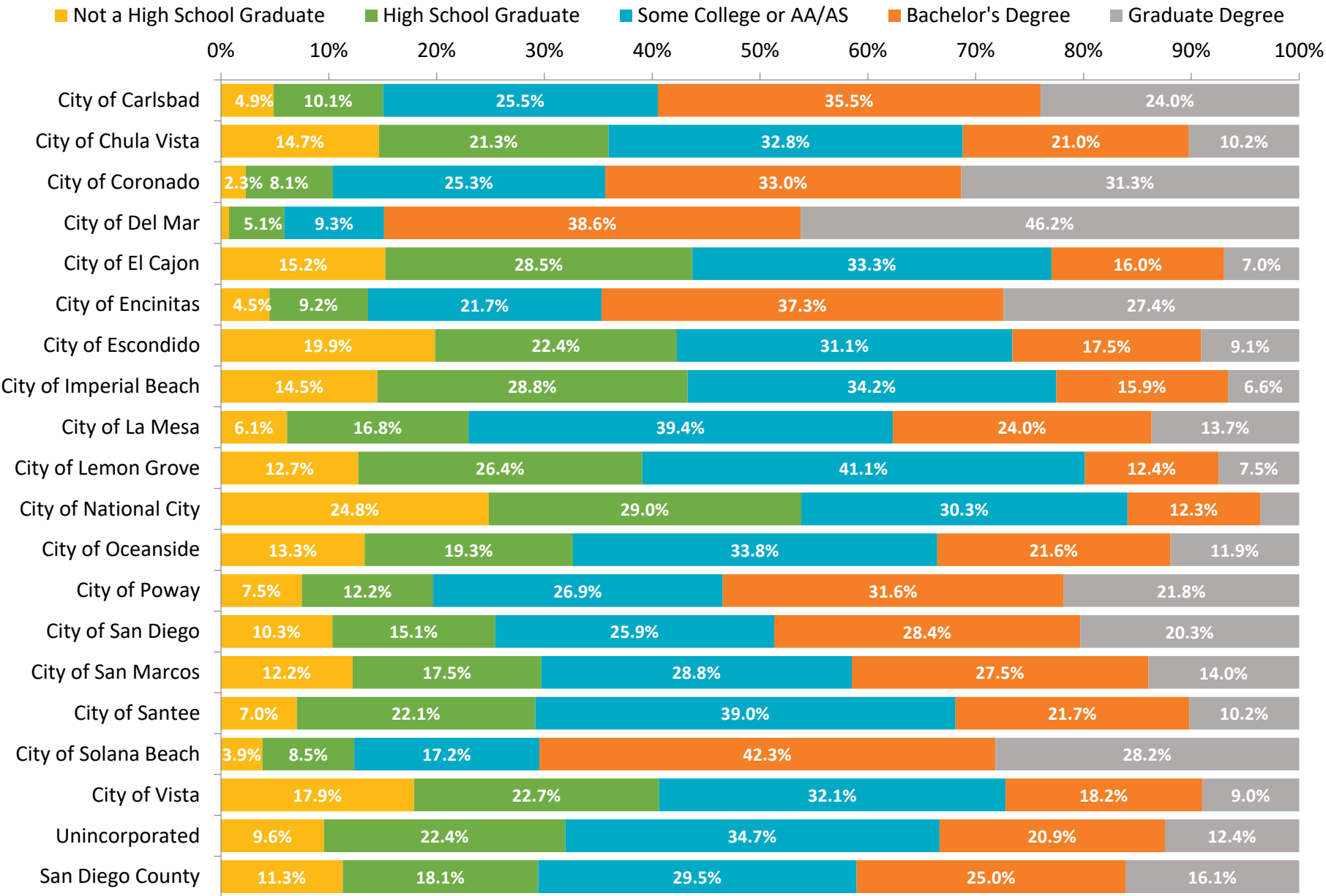

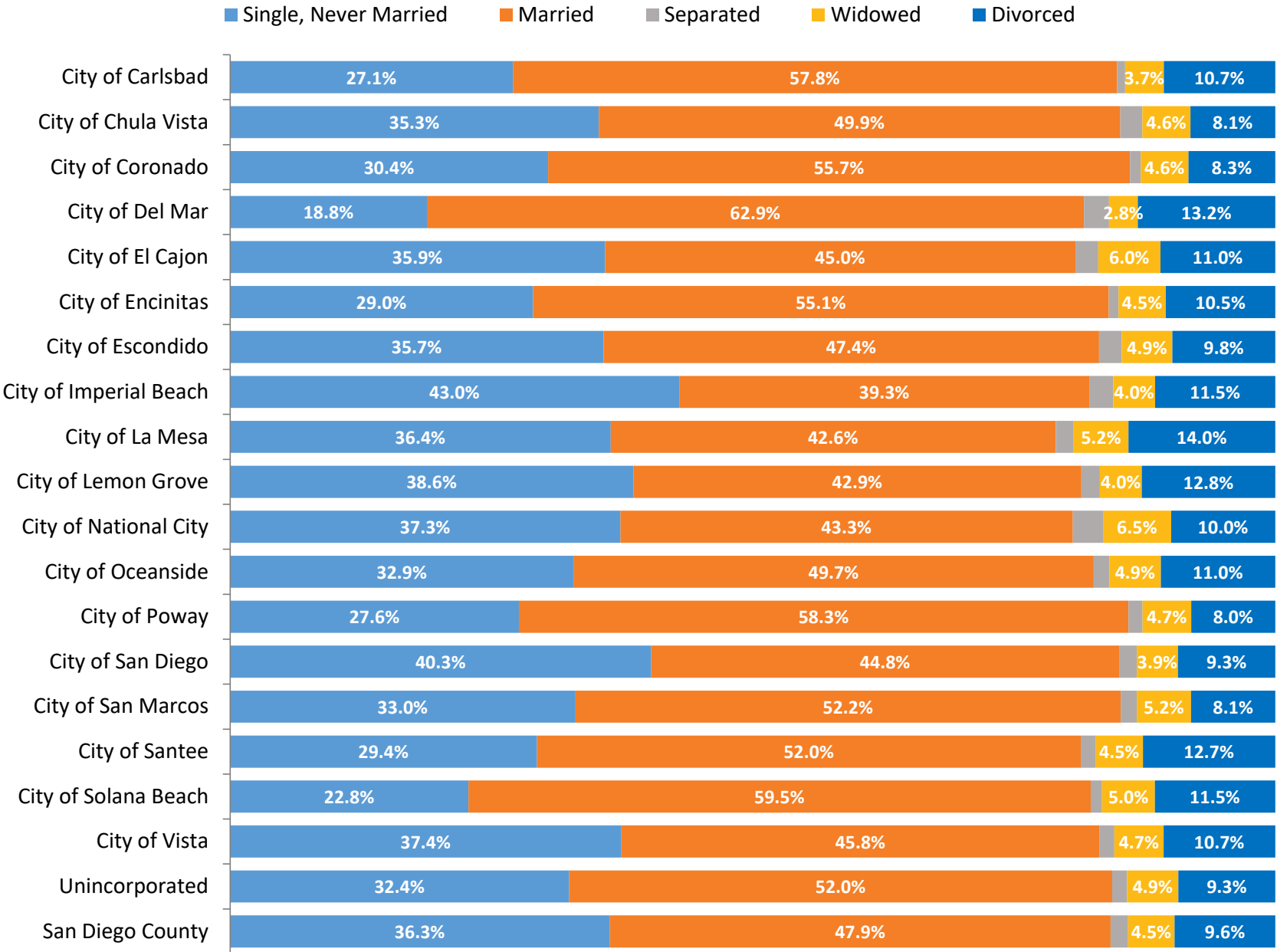

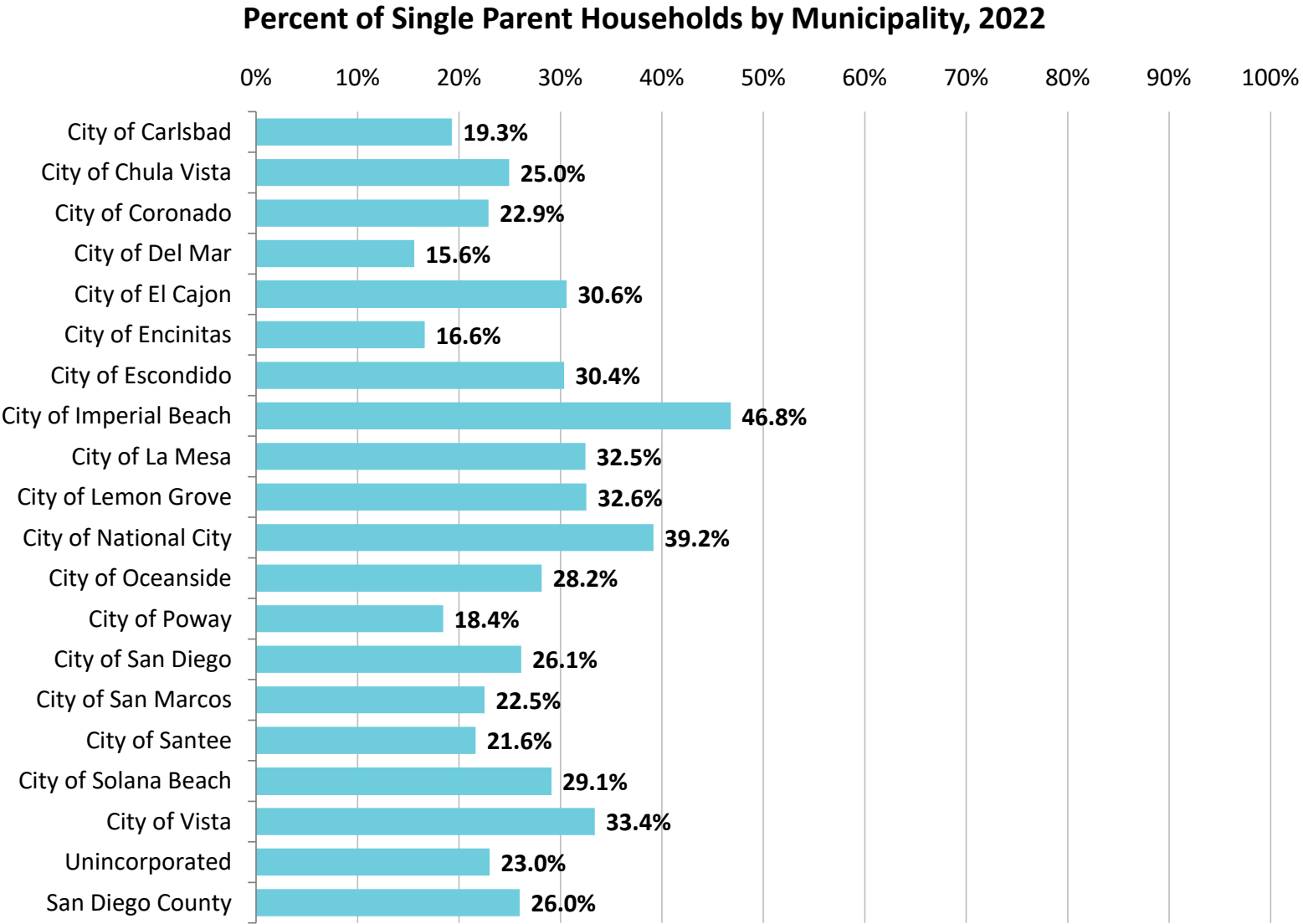

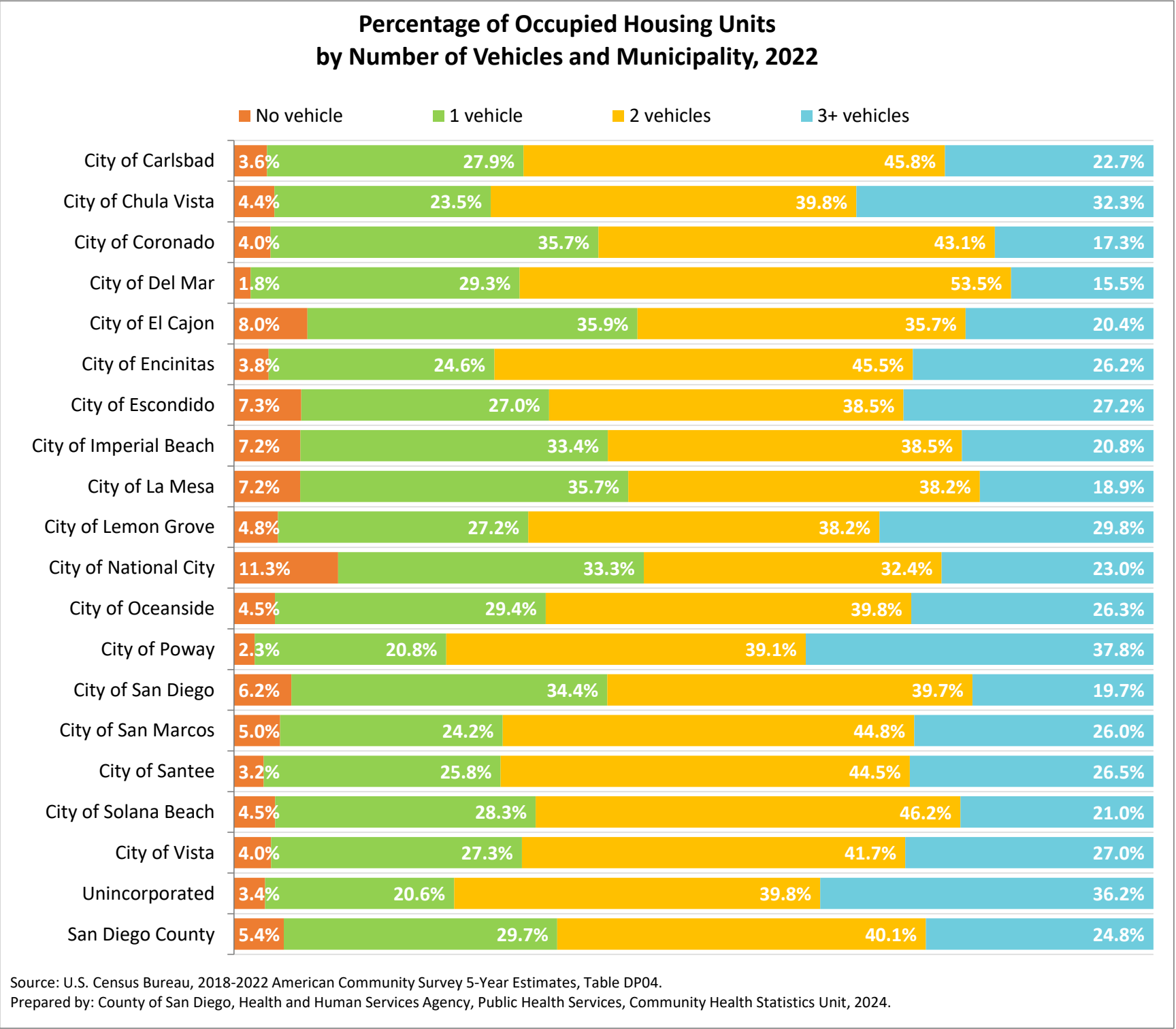

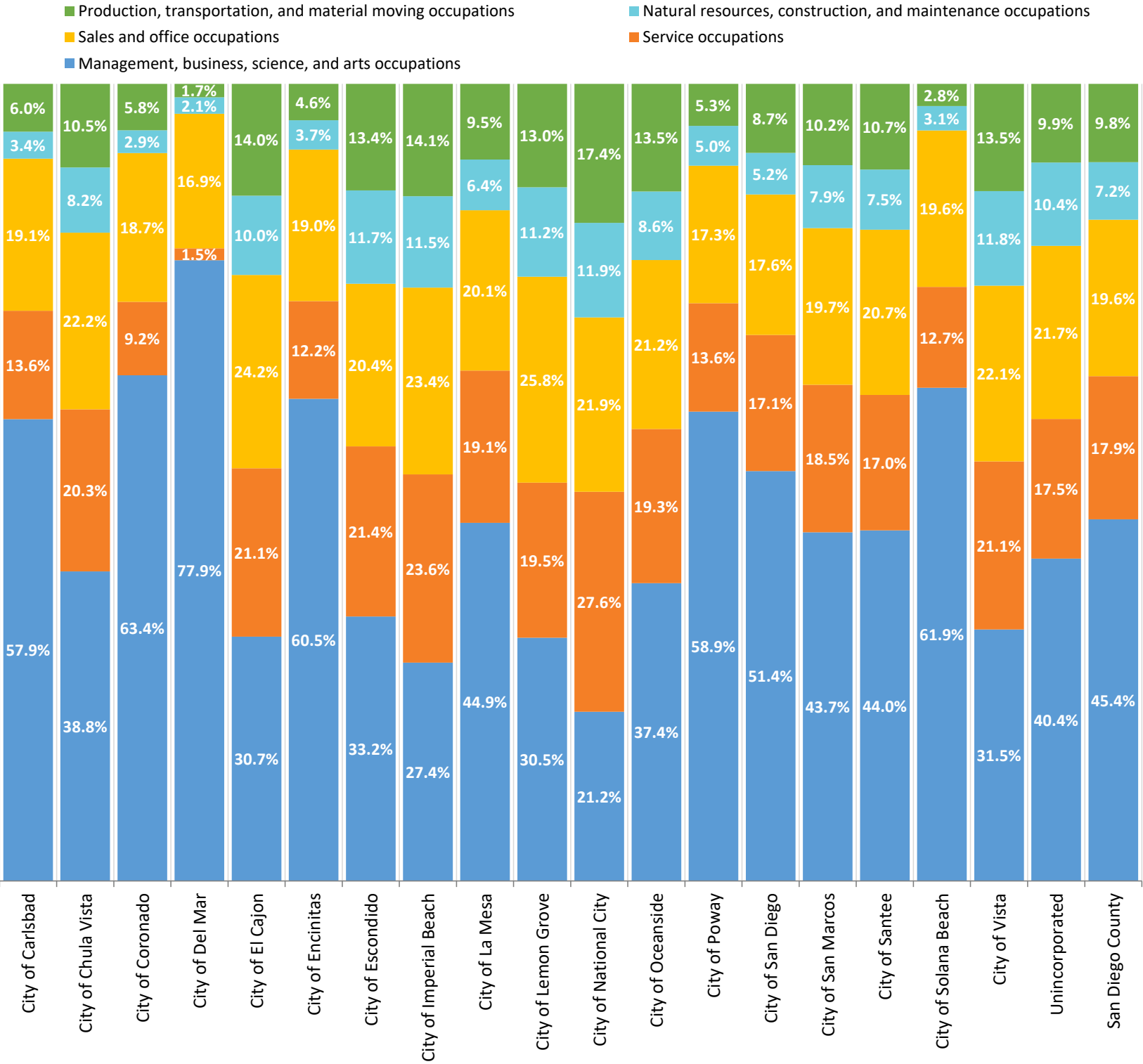

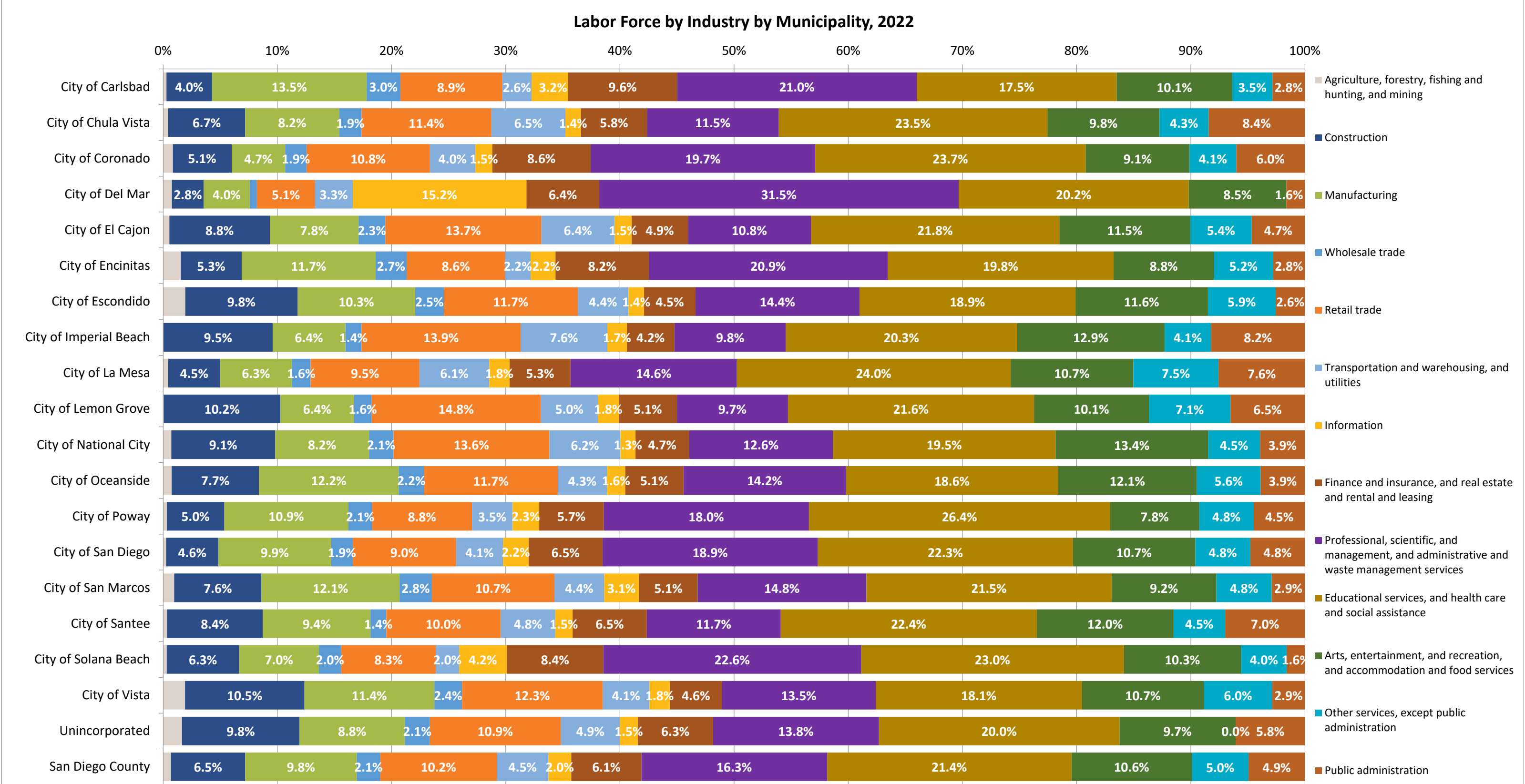

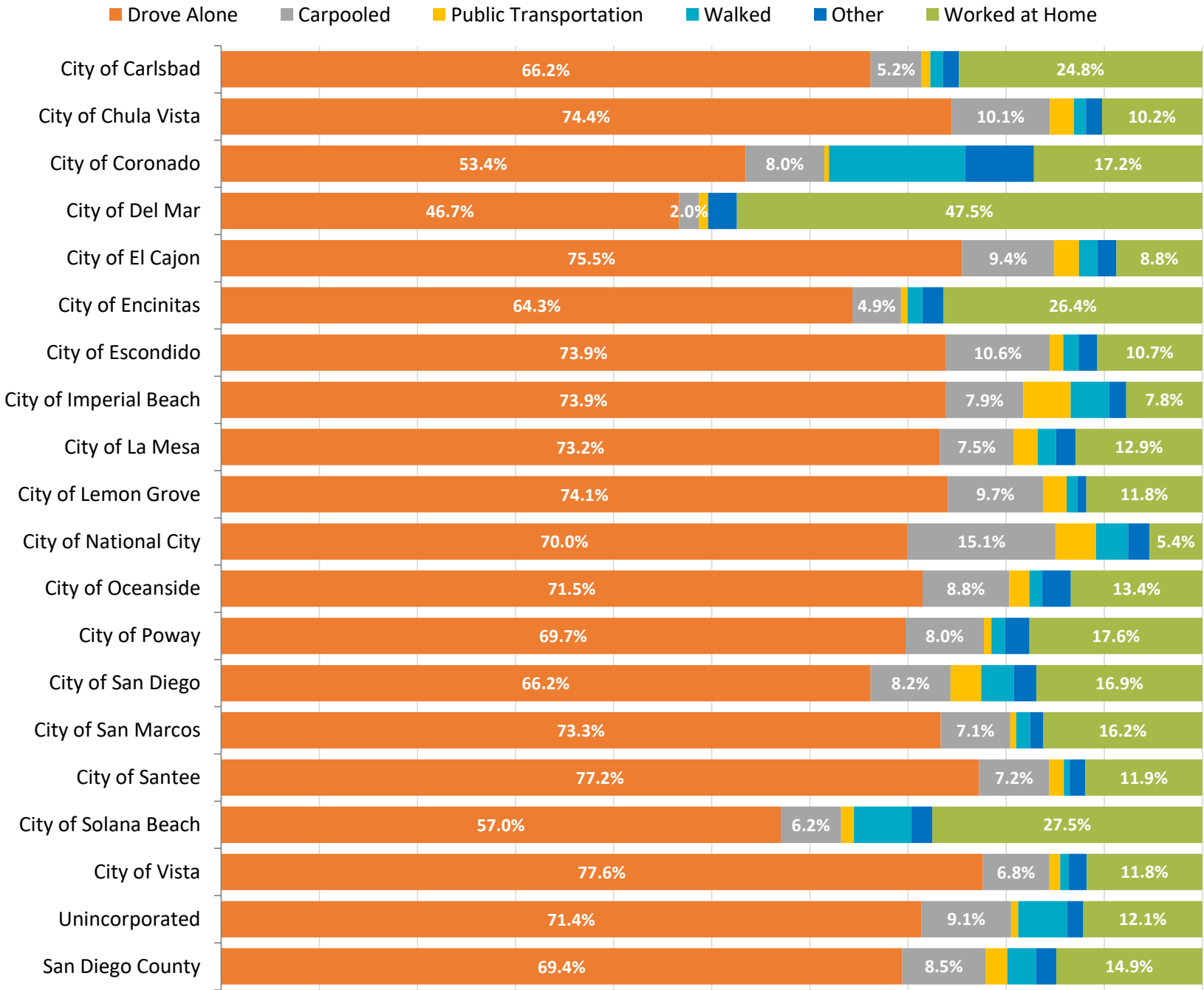

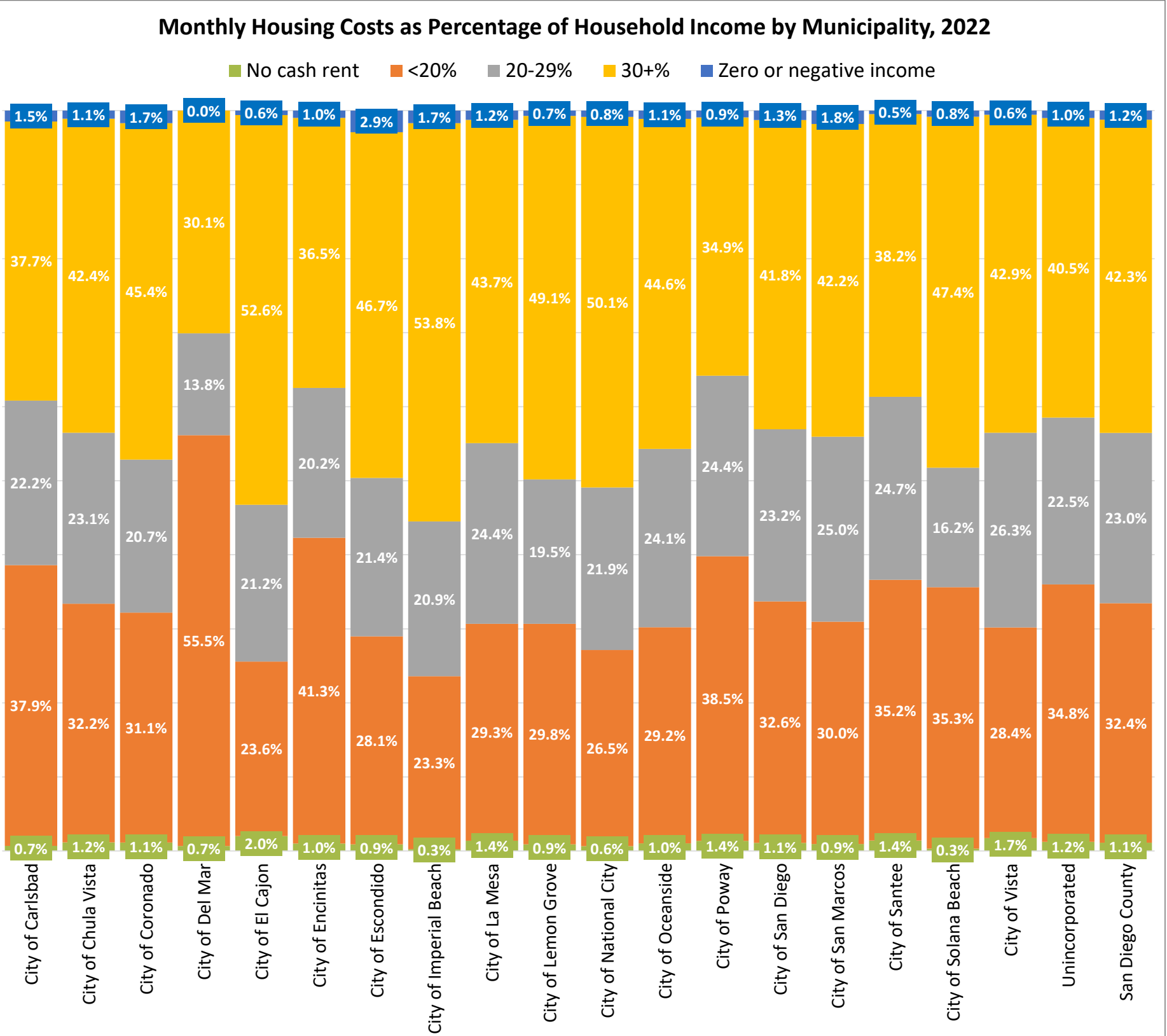

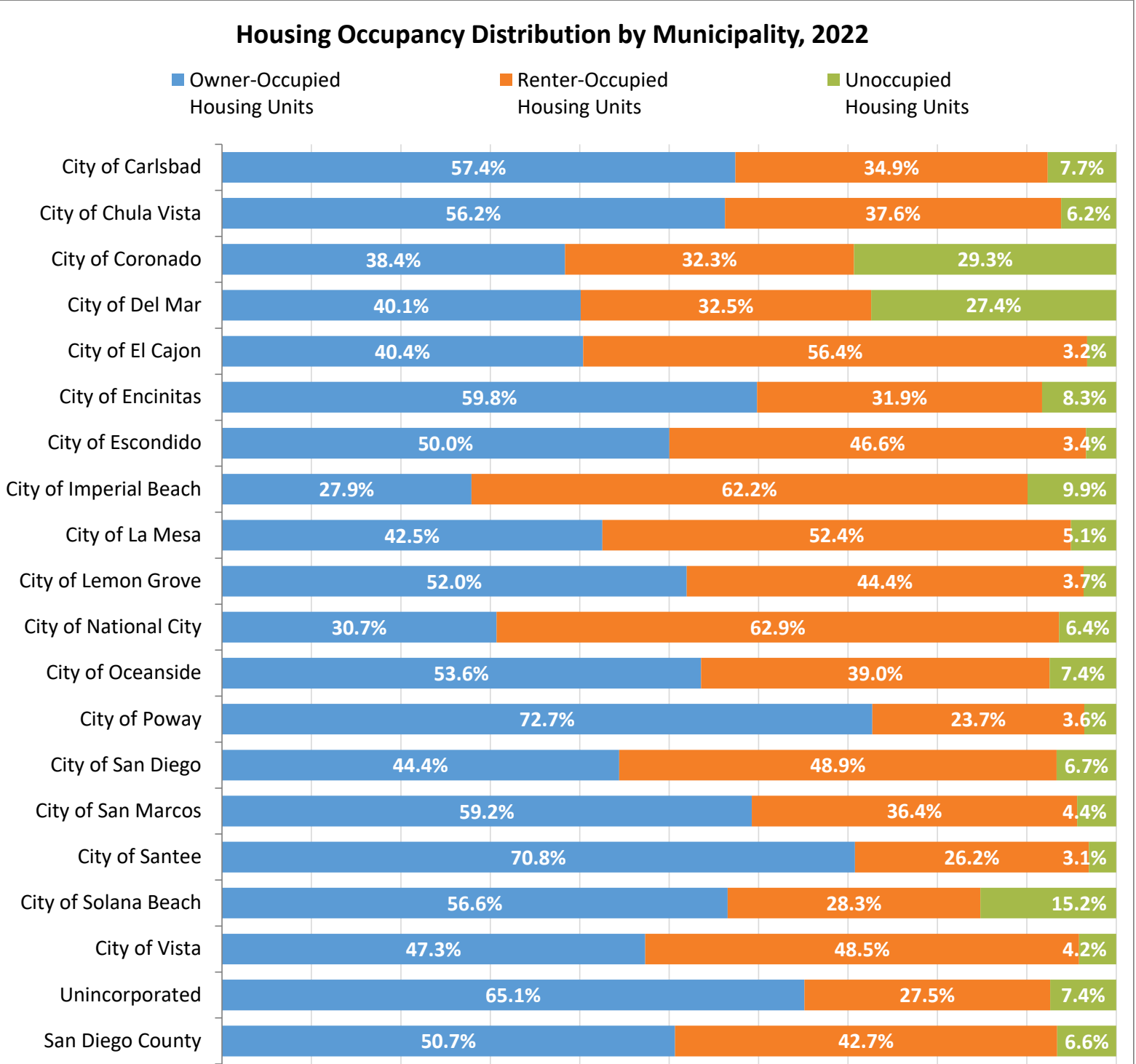

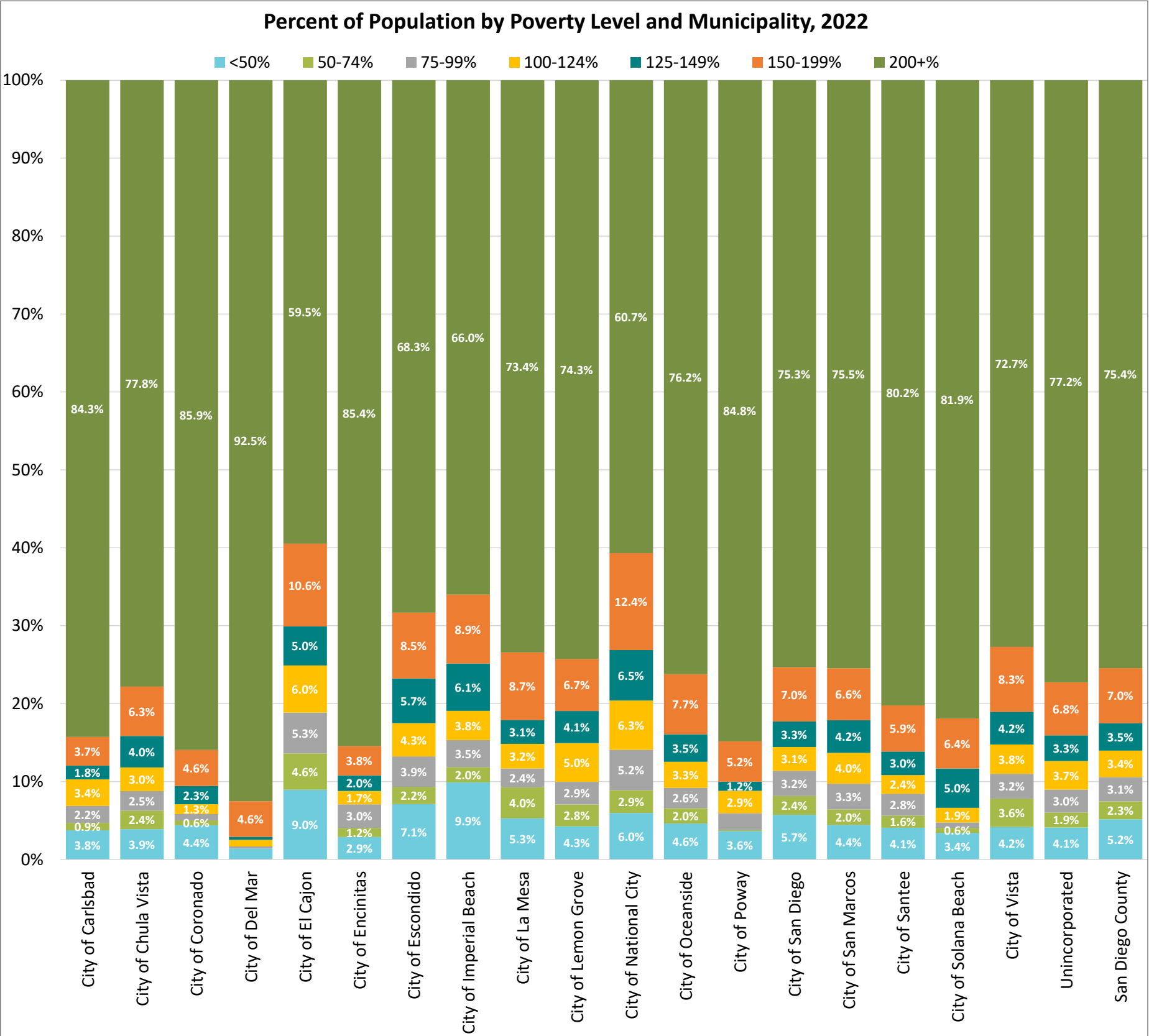

Population, by Age Group, Living Below 100% Federal Poverty Level (FPL)*

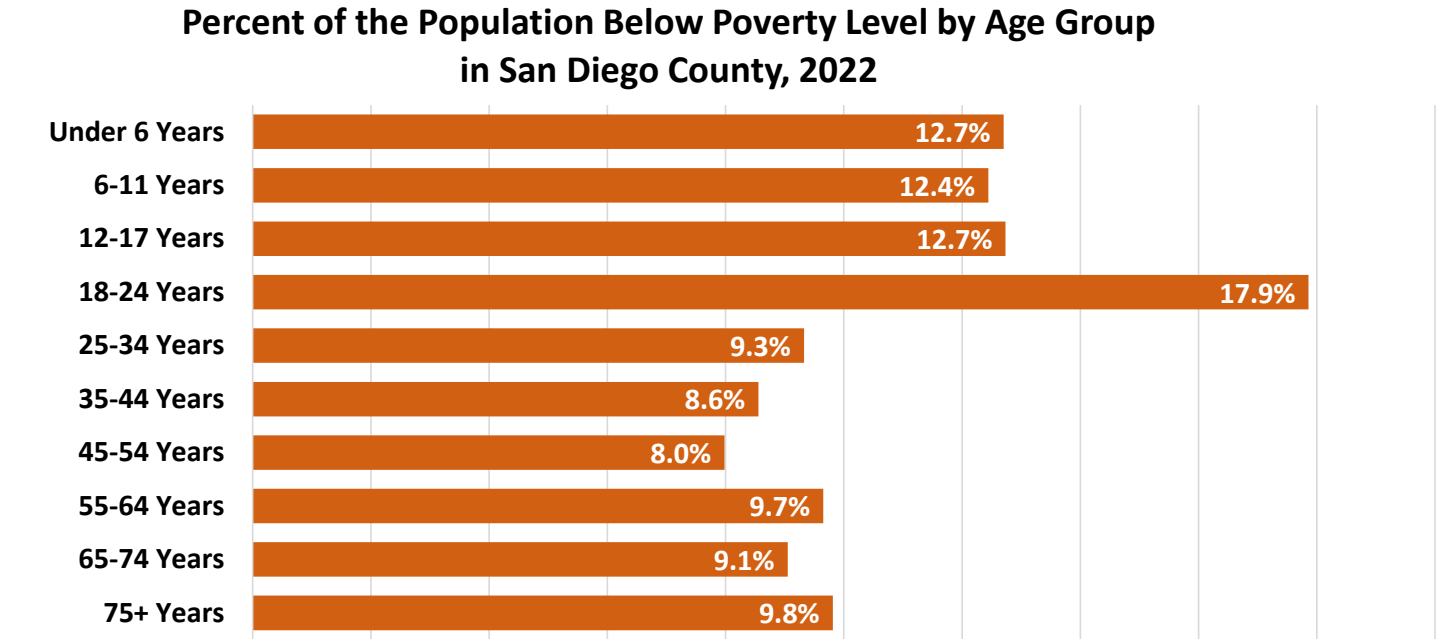

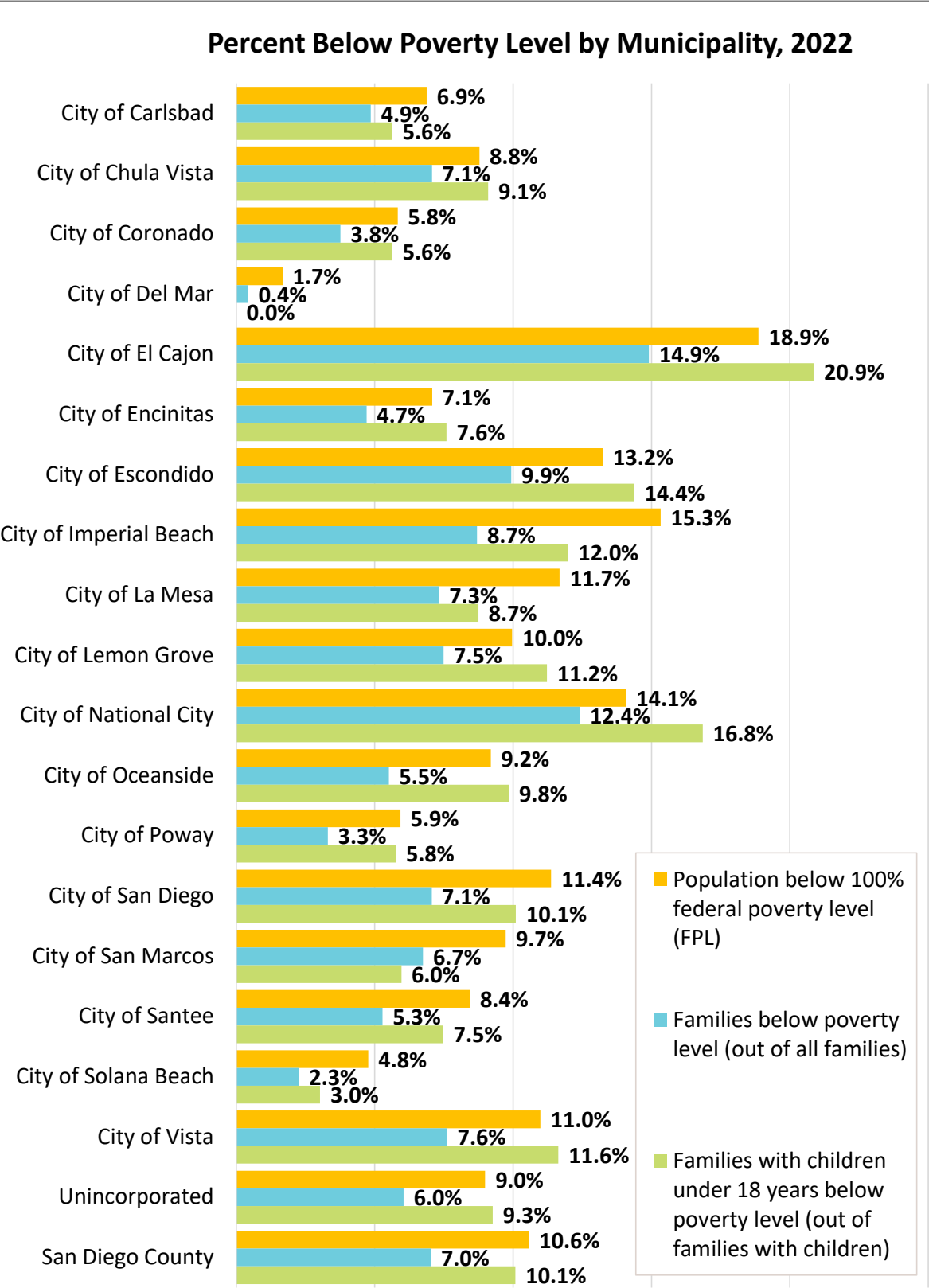

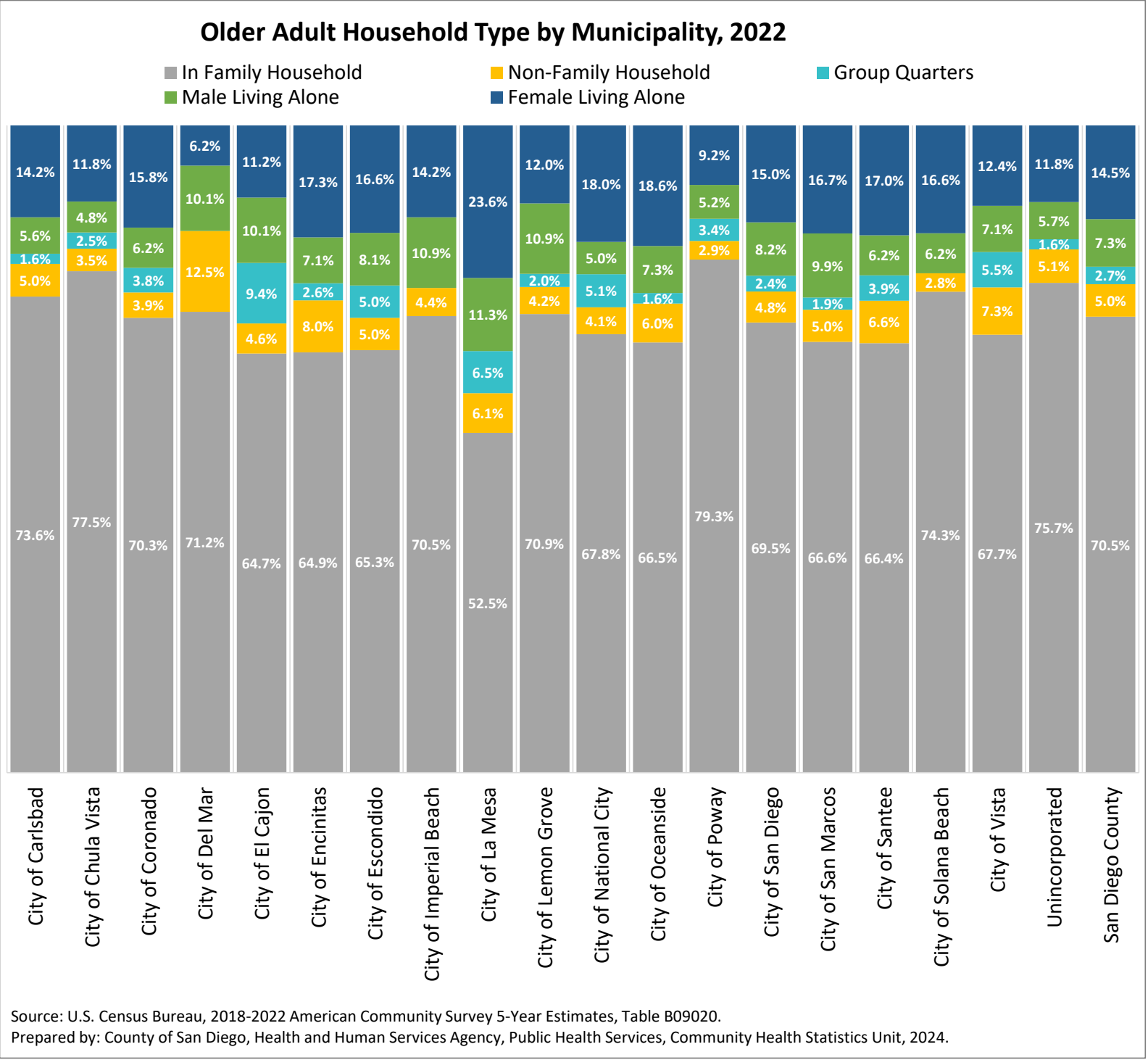

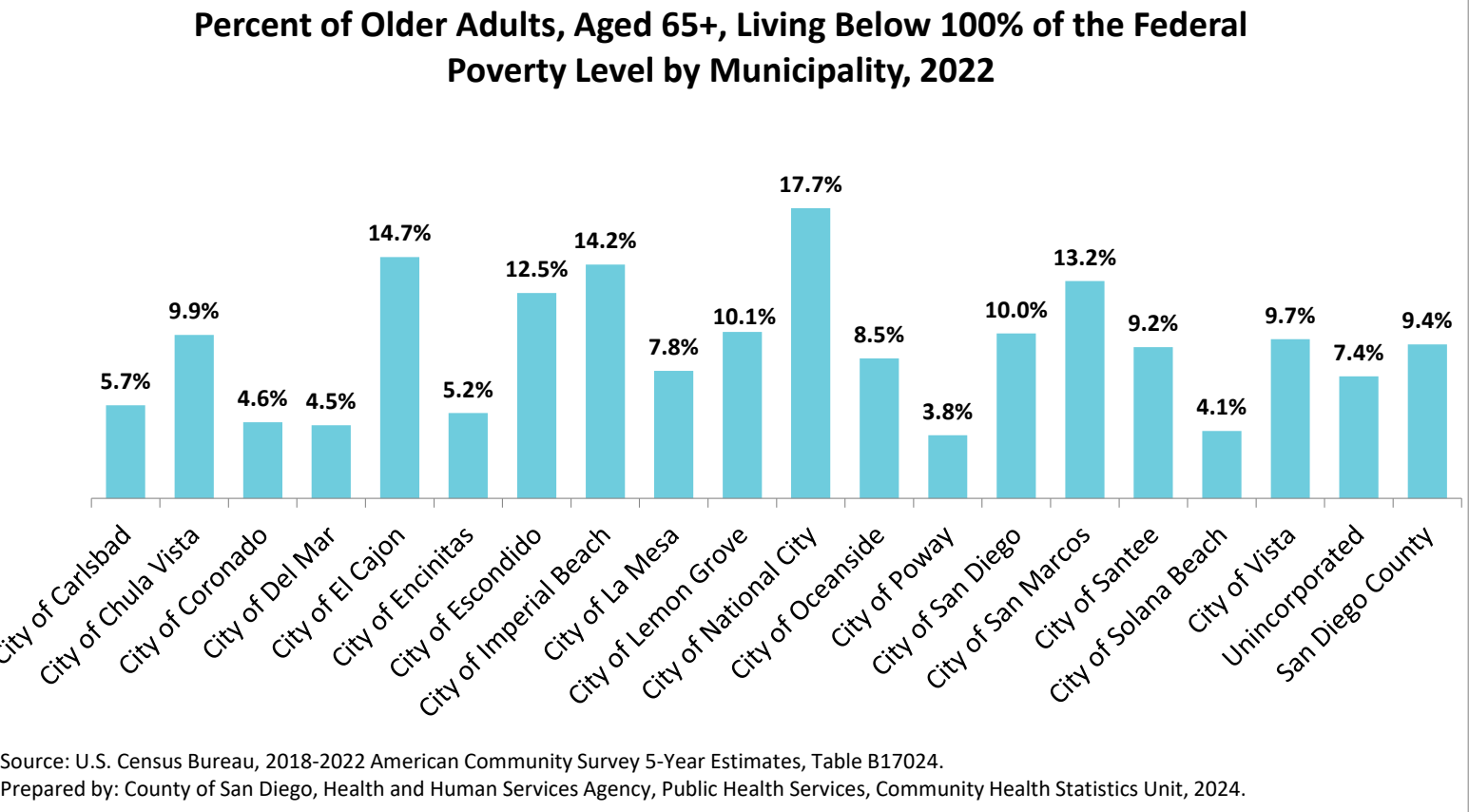

Poverty status was determined for all people except institutionalized people, people in military group quarters, people in college dormitories, and unrelated individuals under 15 years old. These groups were excluded from the numerator and denominator for calculations.

**Federal Poverty levels (FPL)* refer to a measure of income used to assess how low or high income individuals have. FPL is used to determine eligibility for certain government programs and/or benefits that are income-based.

Please note that those with income below 100%FPL are included in the living below 200% FPL category and have much lower income.

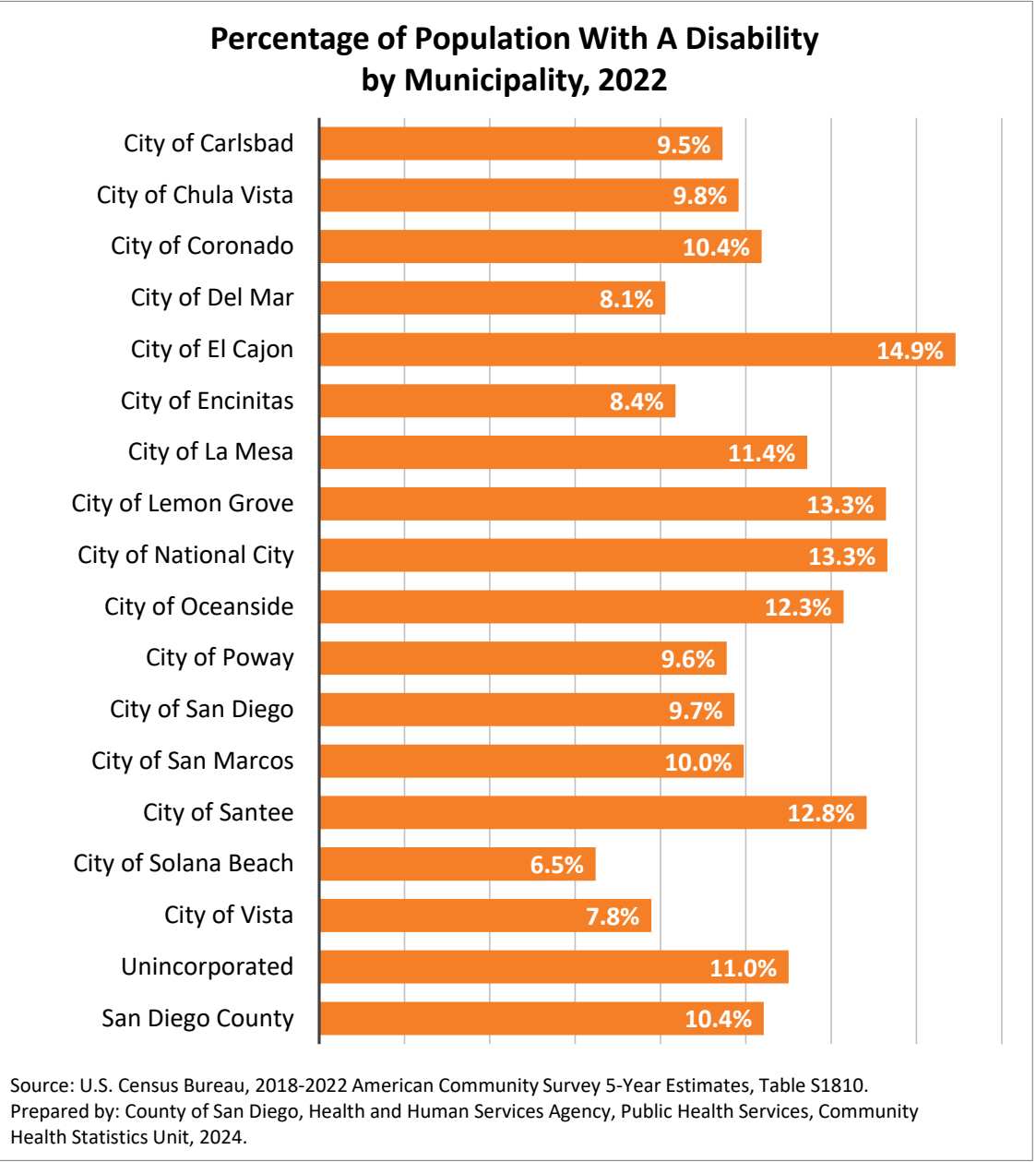

This indicator provides number and percentage of persons with a disability (one or more). Disability is a dynamic concept that changes over time as one’s health improves or declines, as technology advances, and as social structures adapt.

Measuring this complex concept of disability with a short set of six questions is difficult. Overall, the American Community Survey (ACS) attempts to capture six aspects of disability, which can be used together to create an overall disability measure, or independently to identify populations with specific disability types.

***Note:** numbers are NOT mutually exclusive. Persons can have more than one type of disability. This is why percentages will NOT add to 100%.

Hearing difficulty: Deaf or serious difficulty hearing among people of any age.

Vision difficulty: Blind or serious difficulty seeing even when wearing glasses among people of any age.

Cognitive difficulty: Serious difficulty concentrating, remembering, or making decisions due to a physical, mental, or emotional condition among the population 5 years and older.

Ambulatory difficulty: Serious difficulty walking or climbing stairs among the population 5 years and older.

Self-care difficulty: Difficulty dressing or bathing among the population 5 years and older.

Independent living difficulty: Difficulty running errands alone due to a physical, mental, or emotional condition among adults 18 years or older (for example, going alone to an appointment at their doctor’s office or shopping). This is an indicator to a person's ability to live independently.

Limitation: Data is specific to the civilian noninstitutionalized population. Disability distributions in some types of group quarter (GQ) populations may differ from that in the household population; therefore, the inclusion of the noninstitutionalized GQ population could have a noticeable effect in the disability distribution, particularly in areas with large noninstitutionalized GQ population.

How to interpret these data: In San Diego County, 10.4% of the civilian noninstitutionalized population reported having a disability in 2022.

How to interpret these data: The likelihood of having a disability increased as age increased - less than 1% of people under age 5 had a disability, compared to nearly half (47.8%) of the population 75+ that had a disability in San Diego County in 2022.

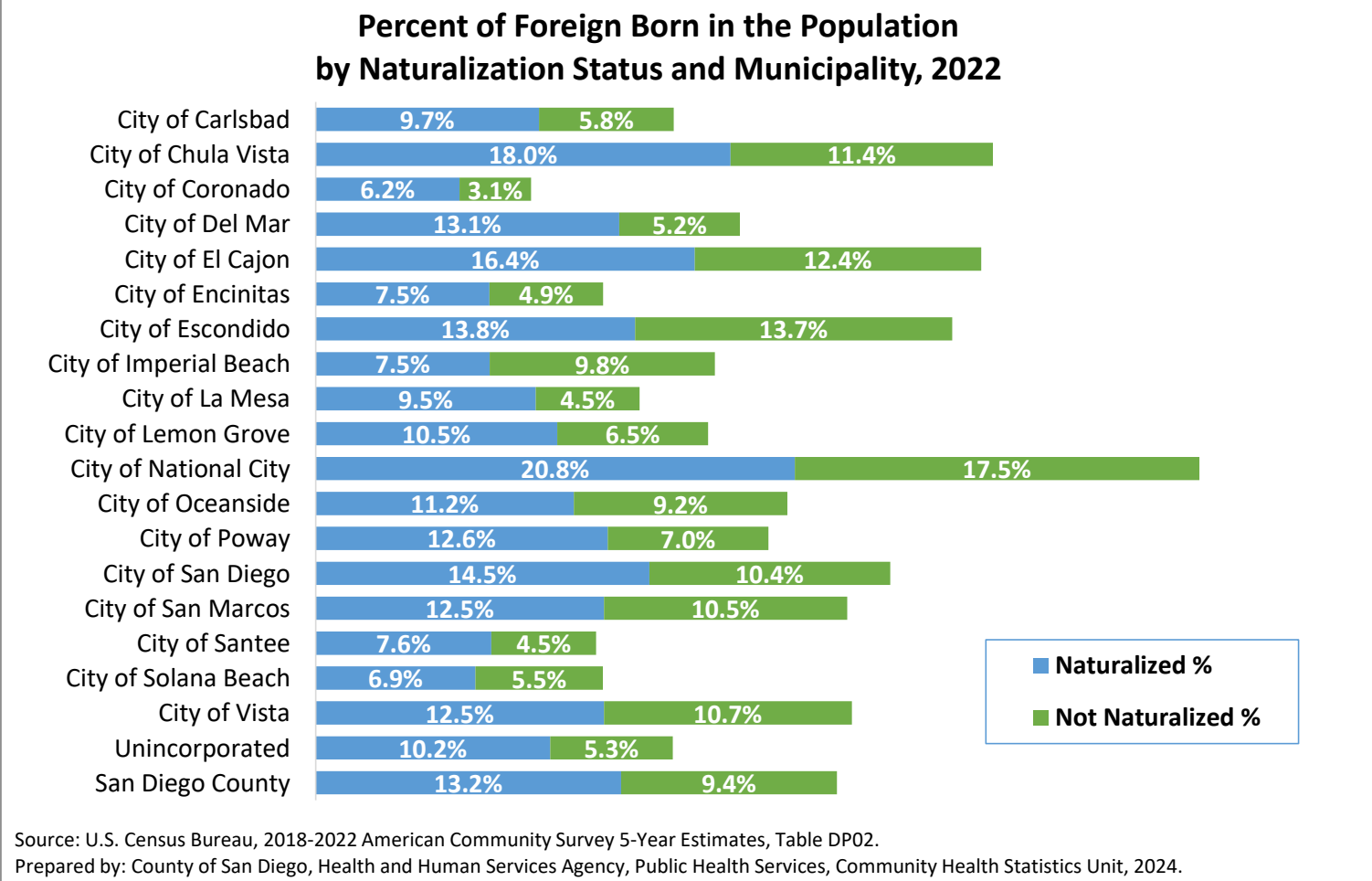
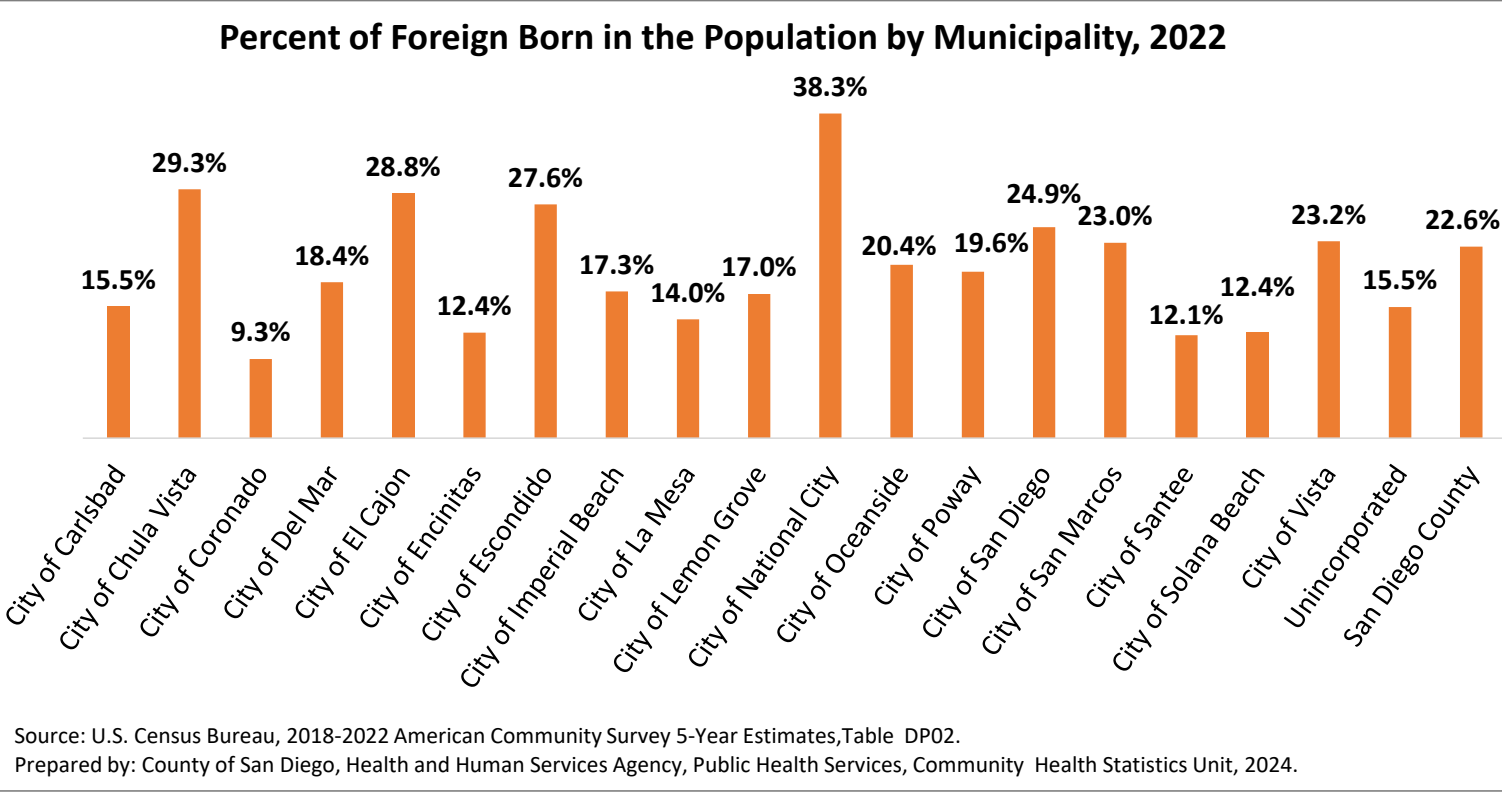

Who is considered foreign-born according the U.S. Census Bureau? The U.S. Census Bureau uses the term foreign born to refer to anyone who is not a U.S. citizen at birth. This includes naturalized U.S. citizens, lawful permanent residents (immigrants), temporary migrants (such as foreign students), humanitarian migrants (such as refugees and asylees), and unauthorized migrants. In other words, the foreign-born population includes anyone who was not a U.S. citizen or a U.S. national at birth. This includes respondents who indicated they were a U.S. citizen by naturalization or not a U.S. citizen.

Everyone else constitutes the native-born population, composed of anyone who is a U.S. citizen at birth, including people born in the United States, in Puerto Rico, in a U.S. Island Area (American Samoa, Guam, the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands, and the U.S. Virgin Islands), or abroad to a U.S. citizen parent or parents.

How to interpret these data: In 2022, an estimated 22.6% (742,955 people) of the people living in San Diego County were foreign-born. Of these, 58.6% of foreign-born were naturalized U.S. citizens. In other words, 13.2% of the San Diego County population were foreign-born naturalized U.S. citizens.

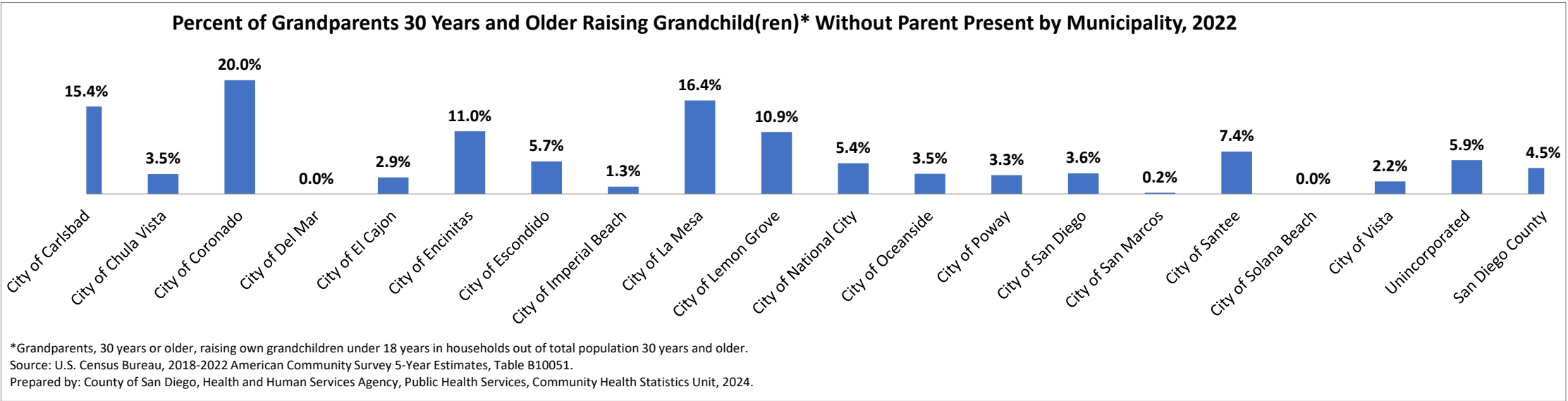

Grandparent Living with a Grandchild in the Household – People 15 years and over were asked if they had "any of his/her own grandchildren under the age of 18 living in this house or apartment." Due to low numbers of persons under 30 years old living with their grandchildren, data is only for people 30 and over.
Responsibility for Basic Needs – This question determines if the grandparent is financially responsible for food, shelter, clothing, day care, etc., for any or all grandchildren living in the household. Responsibility was further classified by presence of grandchild('s) parents.

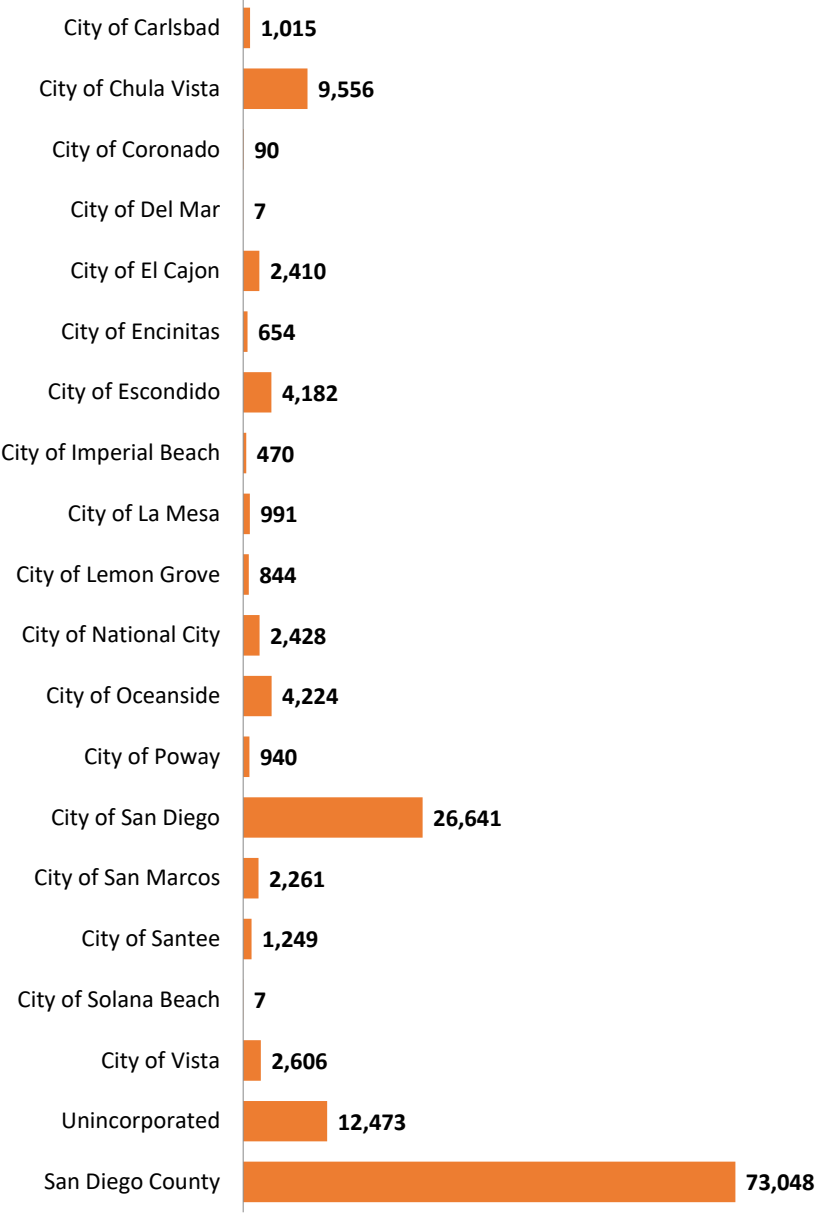
This table shows the number of grandparents 30 years or older living with own grandchildren under 18 years in households by responsibility for grandchildren with or without a parent present. Additionally, it breaks down grandparents living with and those responsible for their grandchildren without a parent present by age group.

How to interpret these data: In San Diego County in 2022, 73,048 grandparents lived with their grandchild or grandchildren under 18 years old. Of those grandparents, 22.2% were responsible for the basic needs of their grandchildren (includes those with parent of child present).
How to interpret these data: Of the 73,048 grandparents who lived with their grandchild or grandchildren under 18 years old in San Diego County in 2022, 4.5% were responsible for grandchildren without a parent present. Of these, 67.2% were grandparents 60 years and over and 32.8% were 30 to 59 years old.

Children Under 18 Years in Households by Relationship to Householder*

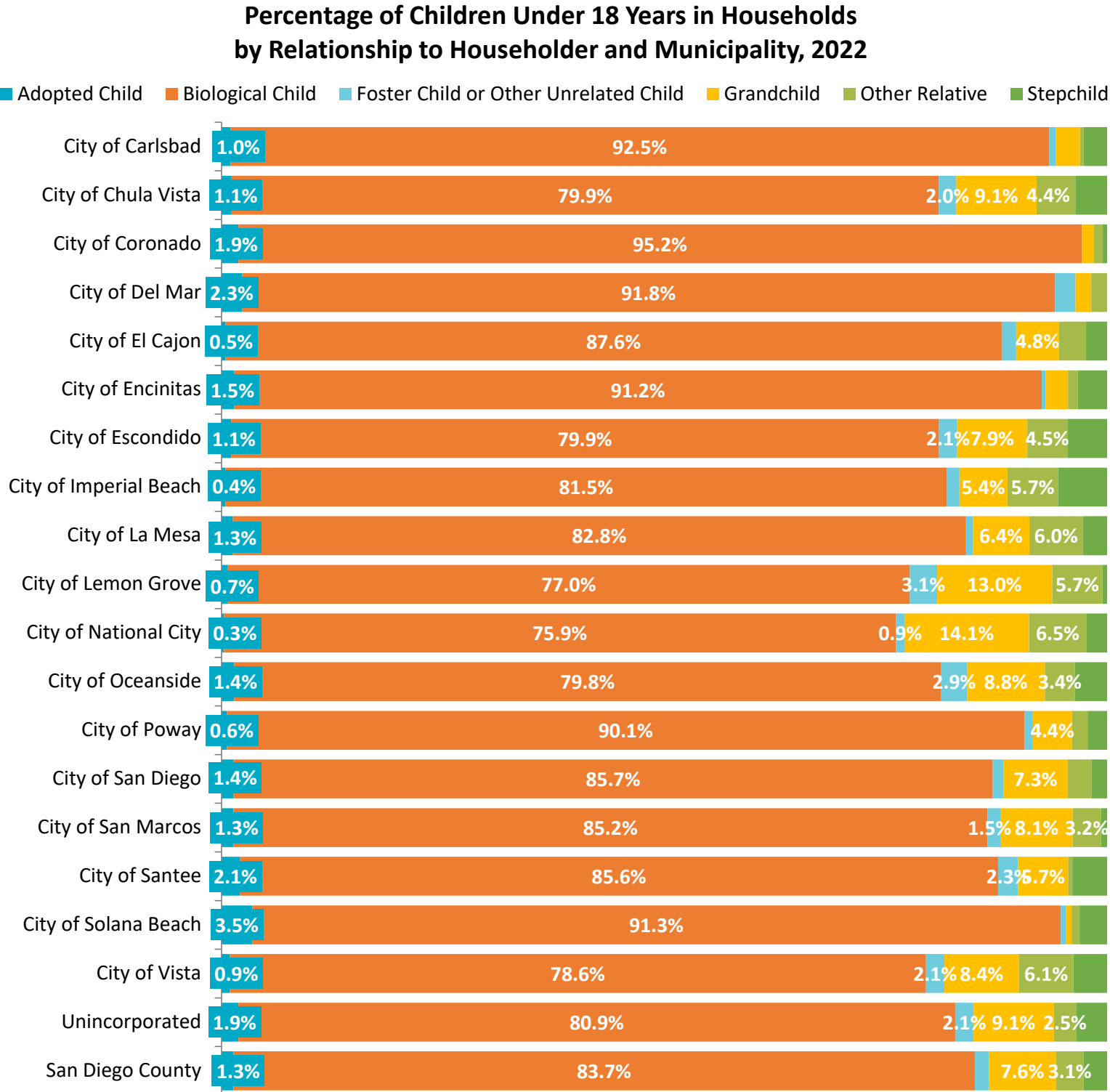

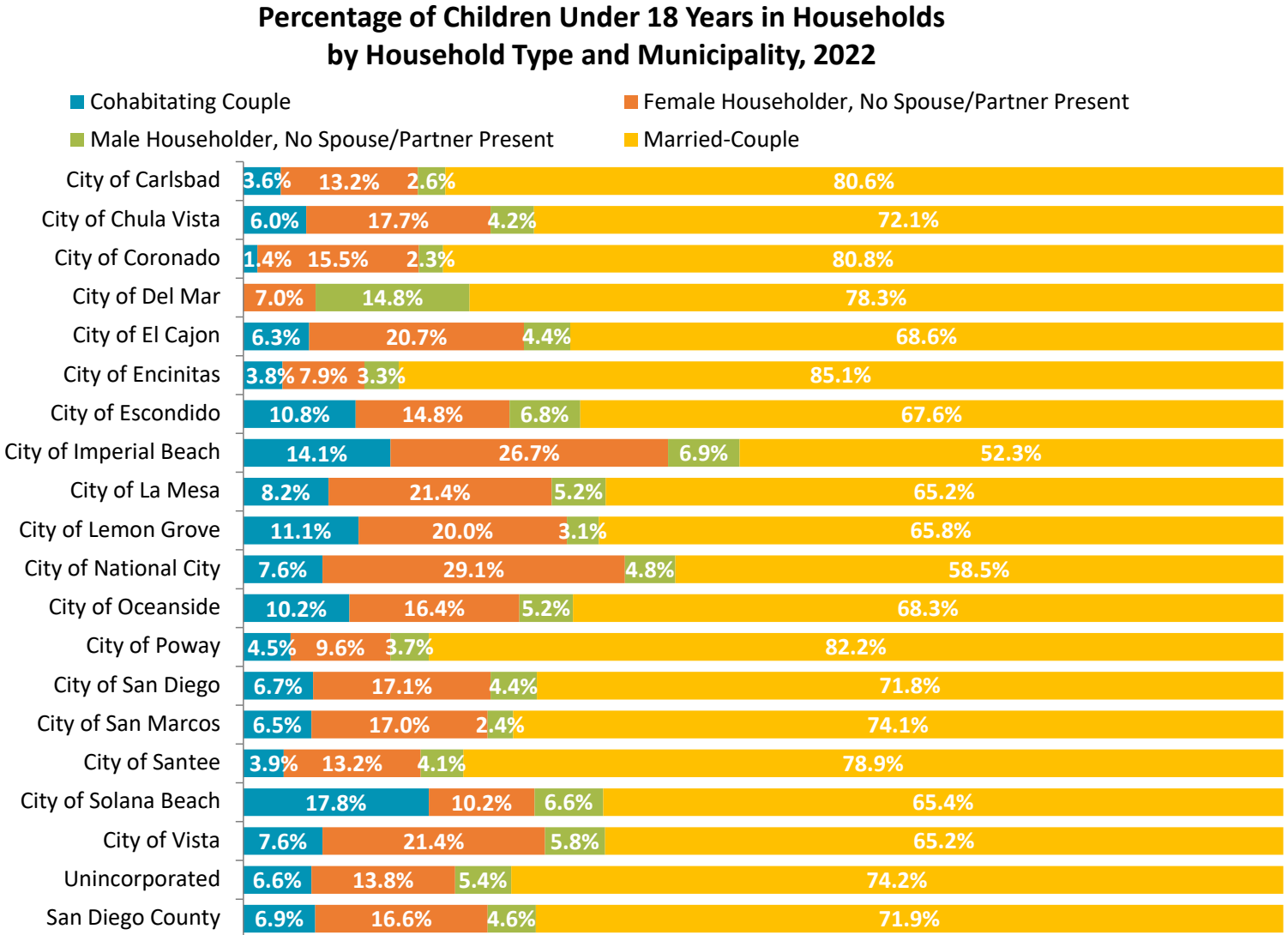

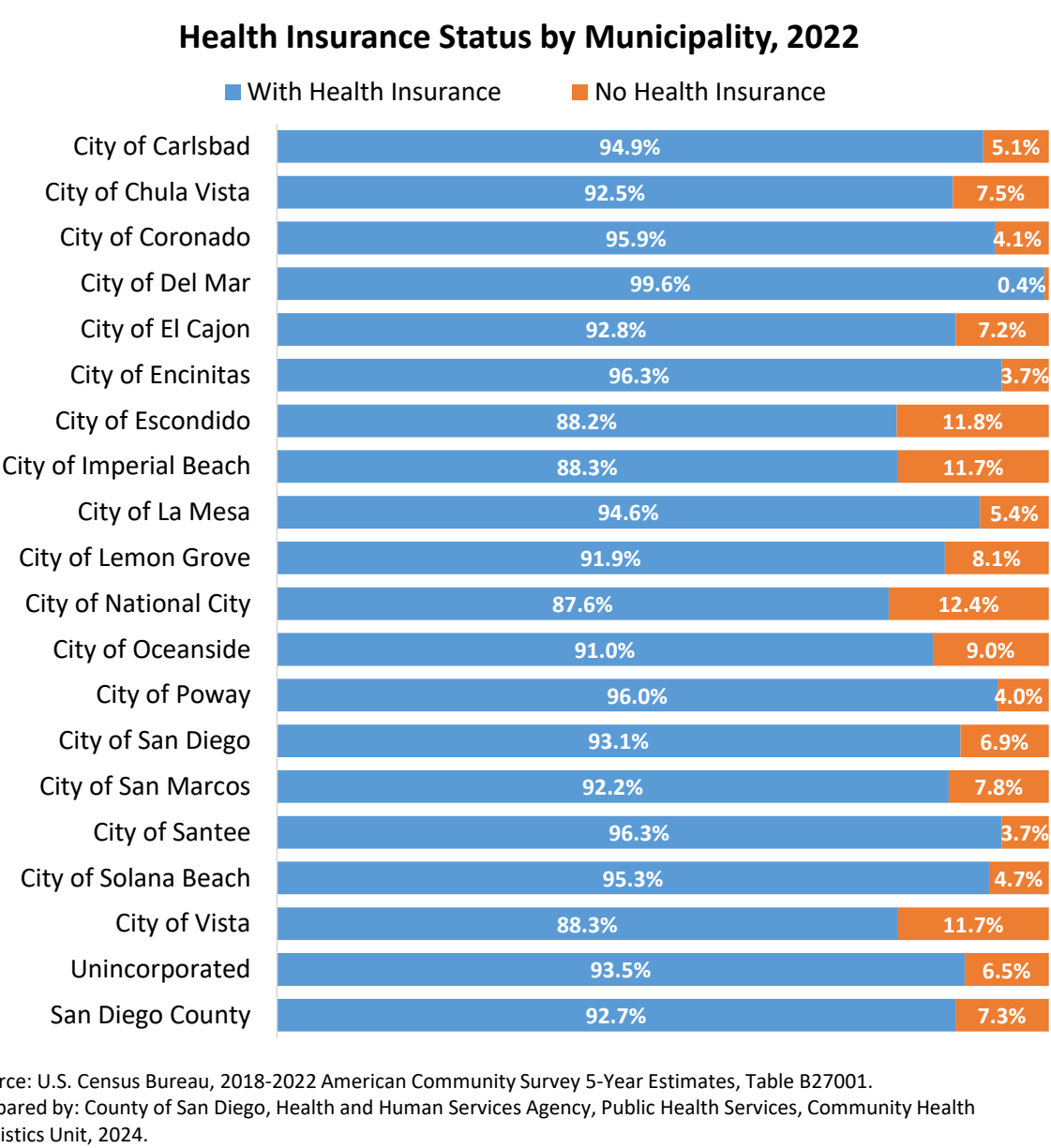

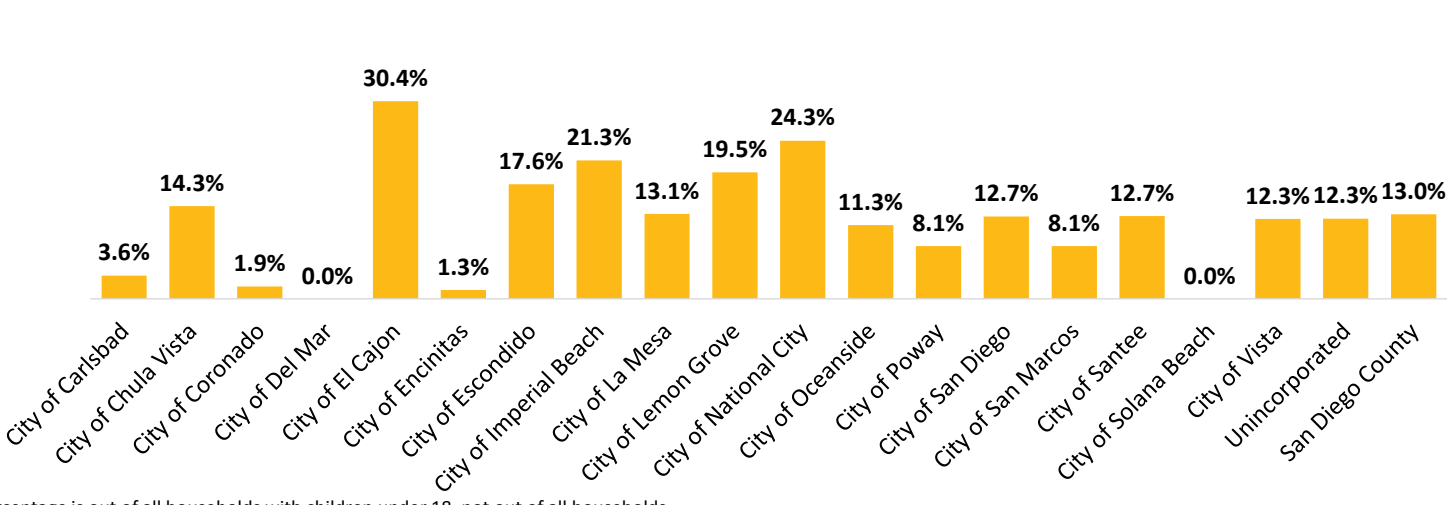

Veterans by Race/Ethnicity

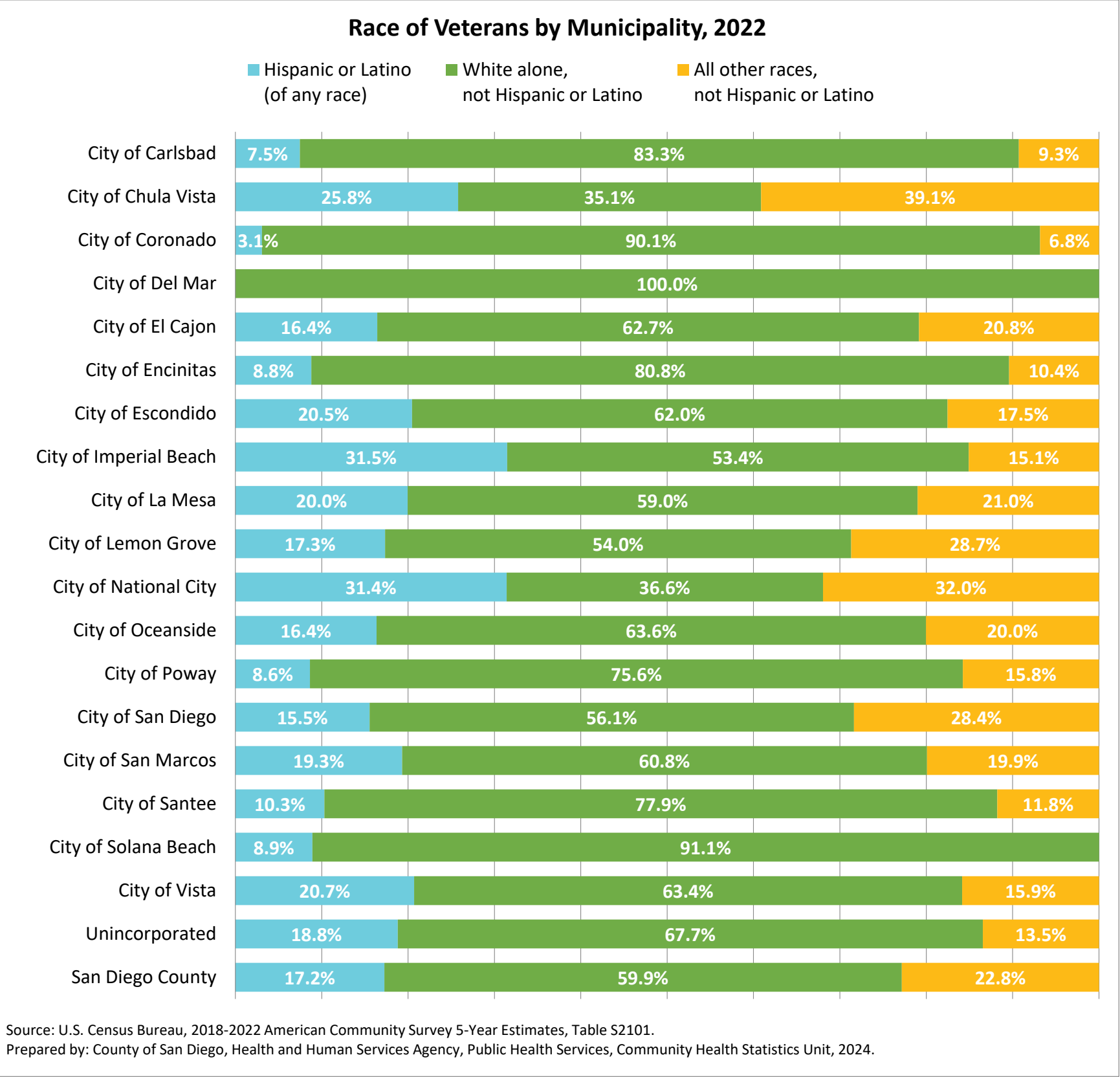

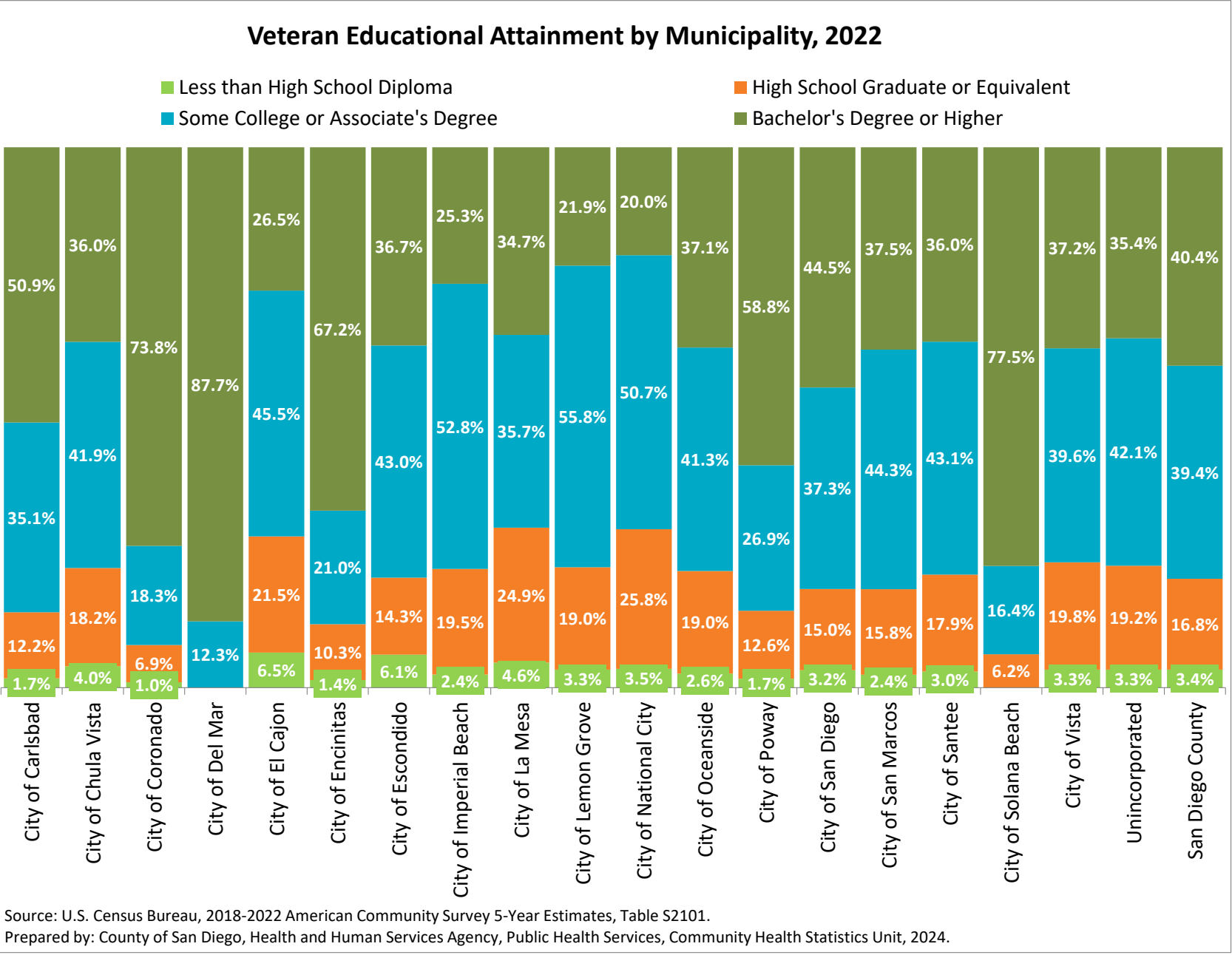

Currently, there are 9 periods of service on the ACS questionnaire. Respondents are instructed to mark a box for each period in which they served, even if just for part of the period. The periods were determined by the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and generally alternate between peacetime and wartime.

How to interpret these data: As of 2022, over 1 in 4 veterans (25.35%) in San Diego County served during the Vietnam Era without serving in the Korean War or World War II.
