# Introduction

The Community Health Statistics Unit (CHSU), under the Health and Human Services Agency (HHS) Public Health Services Division, was formed in 2005 to provide a single point of contact for public health data and support to the HHS Regions and their communities. CHSU generates publications including the Demographic Profiles and the Community Health Profiles, topic specific reports (e.g., older adult falls, economic burden of disease, health disparities, and health status), health briefs, fact sheets, atlases, and the demographic profiles, all of which are available at [www.sdhealthstatistics.com](http://www.sdhealthstatistics.com).

## Limitations of data<sup>1</sup>

The *2024 San Diego County Middle Eastern and North African Population by Ancestry and Place of Birth* explores the Middle Eastern and North African (MENA) population by ancestry and place of birth in lieu of a direct method to estimate this population. Currently, the U.S. government classifies Middle Eastern and North African persons as White per Directive No. 15: Standards for Maintaining, Collecting, and Presenting Federal Data on Race and Ethnicity (SPD 15)<sup>1</sup>. Directive No. 15 was developed by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) in 1977 to “ensure the comparability of race and ethnicity across Federal datasets and to maximize the quality of that data by ensuring that the format, language, and procedures for collecting the data are consistent and based on rigorous evidence.” These standards have historically only been revised once in 1997 since its development in 1977. Data on this document reflect the OMB's 1997 SPD 15.

Race and ethnicity are considered fluid sociopolitical constructs. On January 27th, 2023, OMB released a notice and request for comments on revisions to the current Federal standards on race and ethnicity to capture the societal, political, economic, and demographic shifts in the United States since 1997. The purpose of these revisions is to capture changes in the population in addition to the evolving needs and uses of data.

One of the initial proposals of the Federal Interagency Technical Working Group on Race and Ethnicity Standards is for MENA to become a new and separate minimum reporting category. The arguments for a MENA category include recognizing this community who does not identify, or are seen, as White and to differentiate this population from White persons of European ancestry who may not have the same shared lived experience. On March 28, 2024, the Federal Interagency Technical Working Group made final recommendations for the Race and Ethnicity Standards, which finalized the decision to add MENA as a new and separate minimum reporting category. To ensure that race and ethnicity data are consistent and comparable across the federal government, federal agencies are instructed to update their surveys and administrative forms, submit an Agency Action Plan for complete compliance within 18 months, and update all data collections and programs into compliance with the updated standards within five years of this date.<sup>2</sup>
