Atlas of San Diego County's Foreign-born Populations

Purpose: This atlas has four map series created from the American Community Survey (ACS) 2011-2015 data which describe the origins and the English-speaking ability of foreign-born populations. All maps show data at the census tract level.

Foreign-born Atlas Map series:

The following were uploaded as separate documents for downloading convenience, but are intended to be regarded as one product with the following sections:

- Place of Birth (ACS Table B05006)
- Language Spoken at Home (ACS Table B16001)
- Speak English Less Than "Very Well" (ACS Table B16001)
- Linguistic Isolation (ACS Table S1602)

Guide to the selected results from the American Community Survey 2011-2015:

- The 2011—2015 ACS 5-year estimates are based on data collected between January 2011 and December 2015.
- Published for small geographic areas (census tracts in the maps).
- Represent the average characteristics over the 5-year period of time.
- Have larger sample size than the 1-year and 3-year estimates.
- Are less current than the 1-year and 3-year estimates.

Definitions:

Place of Birth (Among Foreign-Born):

The foreign-born population includes anyone who was not a U.S. citizen at birth. This includes respondents who indicated they were a U.S. citizen by naturalization or not a U.S. citizen. The foreign-born population is shown by selected area, country, or region of birth. The places of birth shown in data products were chosen based on the availability from the ACS data.

Language Spoken at Home:

The language currently used by respondents at home, either "English only" or a non-English language which is used in addition to English or in place of English. These questions were asked only of persons 5 years of age and older.


Ability to Speak English:

For a respondent who speaks a language other than English at home, refers to his/her assessment of his ability to speak English, from "very well" to "not at all." This series is a subset of the Language Spoken at Home data.

Linguistic Isolation (Household):

Households in which no one 14 and over speaks English only or speaks a language other than English at home and speaks English very well.




Linguistically Isolated Population in San Diego County, 2015






