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Overview: Leading Health Conditions Among Older Adults in San Diego County, 2023

The tables in this report provide the leading health conditions (LHCs) for each older adult age group by health outcome (death, hospitalization, and emergency department discharge). Below is a summary of the LHCs among older adults in San Diego County in 2023, by age group.

Older Adults in San Diego County

- In 2023, among all older adult age groups in San Diego County, **Overall Heart Disease** was the only condition found across all health outcomes. The most common heart diseases impacting older adults in San Diego County were **Overall Hypertensive Diseases, Heart Failure, and Coronary Heart Disease (CHD)**.
- Overall Cancer** was a leading cause of death and hospitalization among all older adult age groups in San Diego County in 2023. The most common cancers impacting older adults in San Diego County were **Lung Cancer, Colorectal Cancer, and Pancreatic Cancer**.
- Non-Alzheimer’s Dementia and Alzheimer’s Disease** were a leading cause of death, hospitalization, and emergency department discharge among the 60 and older age group.
- In San Diego County, **Falls** were a leading cause of hospitalization and emergency department discharges in all older adult age groups in 2023. **COVID-19, Urinary Tract Infection, and Pneumonia** were other common conditions causing hospitalization and emergency department discharge among all age groups.

60+

- Among all older adults 60 years and over, **Overall Heart Disease** was the number one LHC for deaths and hospitalizations, while **Falls** were the number one LHC for emergency department discharges in San Diego County in 2023.

60-69

- In 2023, **Overall Cancer** was the number one LHC for deaths among older adults aged 60-69 years in San Diego County.
- In 2023, medical encounters due to **Drug Overdose** or **Alcohol Use** were most common among older adults aged 60-69 years in San Diego County.

70-79

- In 2023, **Overall Cancer** was the number one LHC for deaths among older adults aged 70-79 years in San Diego County.

80+

- Alzheimer’s Disease** and **Non-Alzheimer’s Dementias** were most prevalent among older adults 80 years and over in San Diego County in 2023.
- Among older adults 80 years and over, **Falls** were more likely to be fatal, compared to those aged 60-69 or 70-79 in 2023.
