Some addresses with a postal address indicating a city may be reallocated to the unincorporated area based on their physical location of the address. Unincorporated jurisdictions are based on postal addresses and denominators to match are not available; thus, rates are not calculated.

COVID-19 transmission is widespread. People may have contracted the illness anywhere in the county or during travel outside the county. This may not necessarily be in the city where they live. These data should not be interpreted as an indication of activity in any specific location. Under a community transmission status, the true prevalence of this disease may not be known as most cases are likely not diagnosed or reported.
