<sup>\*\*\*</sup>HHSA Region determined by resident zip code or city; some zip codes not available.

<sup>\*\*\*\*</sup>Persons of Hispanic/Latino ethnicity may belong to any race group. All categories except Hispanic/Latino include persons for whom race is known but ethnicity is non-Hispanic or unknown. This report categorizes "Multiple Races" as "Other Race" so all people who report being multiple races are categorized as "Other Race." "Other Race" may not have a standardized definition across data collecting entities or among patients reporting their own demographics.

<sup>^</sup>The percentage and rate of the population vaccinated with a completed primary vaccine series may approach, or exceed, 99% or 999 per 1,000 San Diego residents ages 5 to 11 years old. The most recent age, gender, region, and race/ethnicity population are 2019 estimates, which may under estimate the current population. When these demographics are analyzed, the population estimates may not reflect social and environmental changes of a community, possibly leading to an under- or overestimate of a population.
