BUSINESS UPDATE

No COVID-19 Testing Required Before Employees Can Go Back to Work

Based on new guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, it is no longer recommended that employers require employees who tested positive for COVID-19 to be tested again before they can return to work. The [CDC test-based strategy](#) is no longer recommended to determine when to discontinue home isolation, except in certain circumstances.
