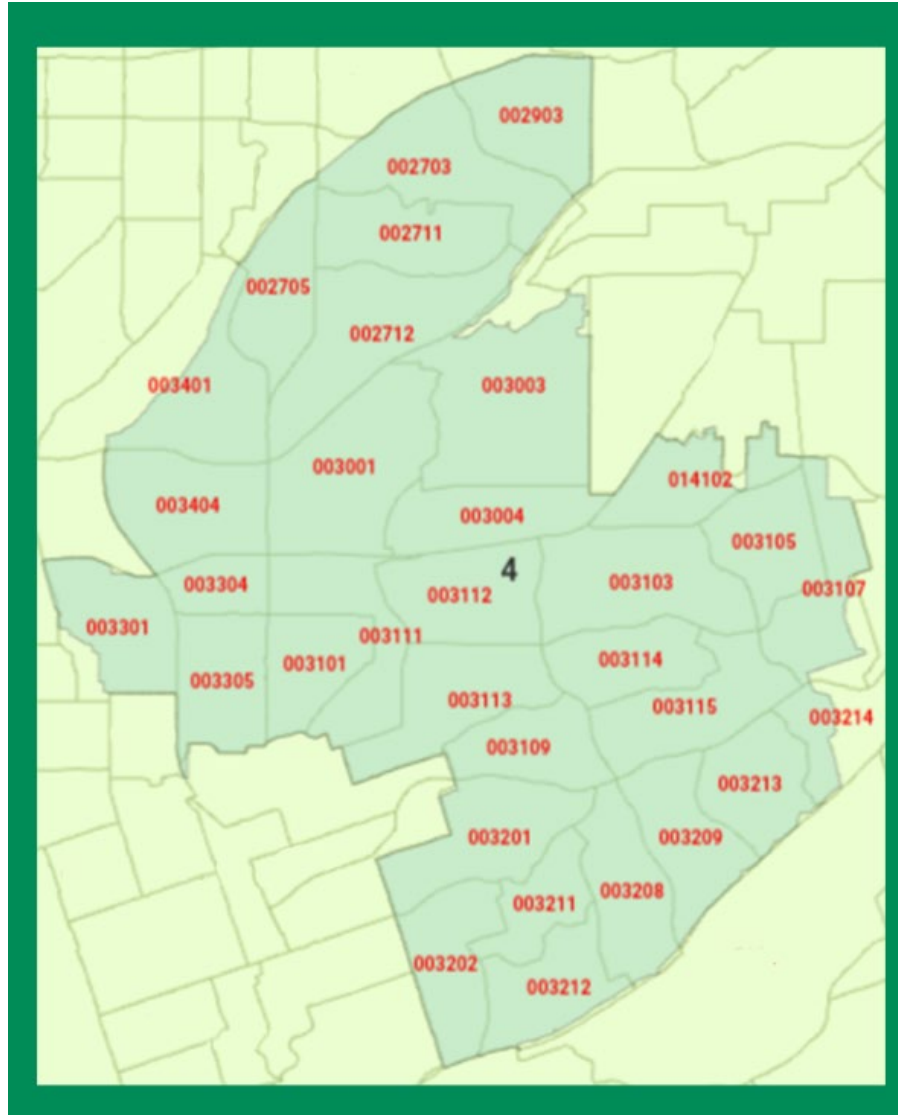

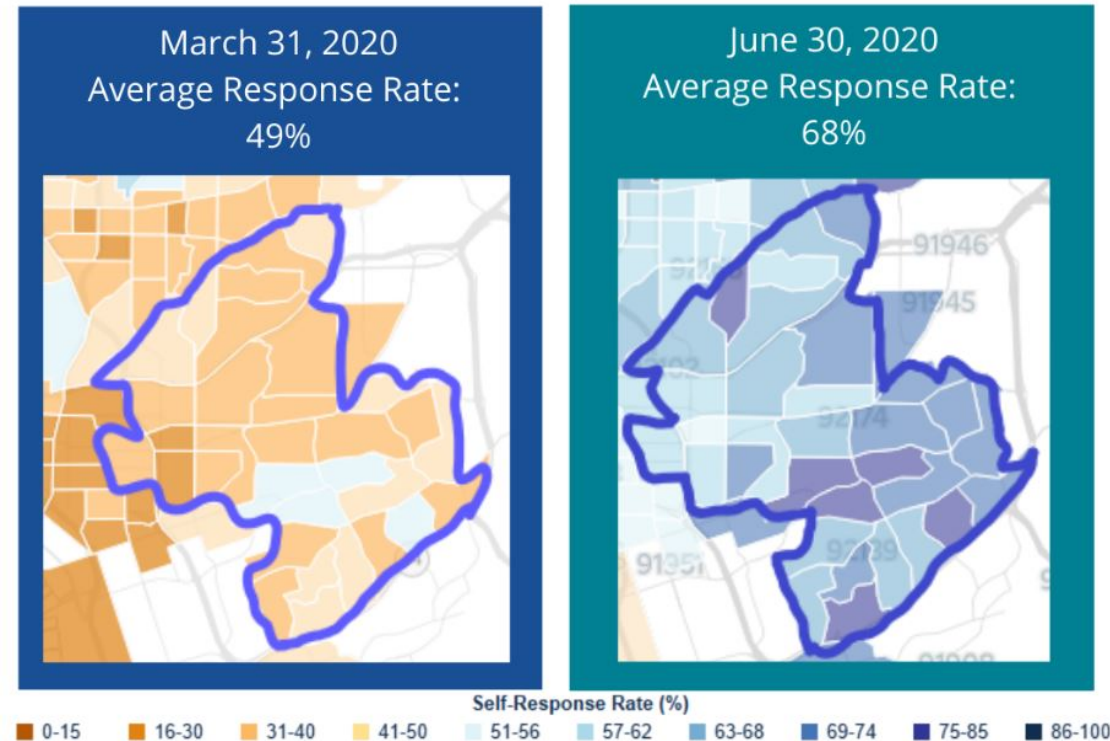

NEW GUIDANCE

- Under the [new state guidance](#), some businesses can operate indoors with modifications starting August 31st
- Places of worship may operate at 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is lower.
- The Safe Reopening Plan needs to be followed and displayed at the entrance where employers and visitors can view it.



TEMPERATURE SCREENINGS FOR EMPLOYEES

- Requiring temperature screenings for all employees of essential and reopened businesses.
- Persons with a temperature of 100.0 degrees or above, OR with any COVID symptom, should be asked to go home.

❖ Have outdoor weddings?	Yes
❖ Have wedding receptions?	No
❖ Have outdoor funerals?	Yes
❖ Have indoor funerals/memorial/baptism services?	Yes: 25% or <100 people
❖ Have baptisms outdoors?	Yes
❖ Have indoor bible study/day camp for youth?	Yes w/ cohort limits
❖ Have outdoor bible study/day camp/Sunday School?	Yes
❖ Have indoor Sunday School?	Yes w/ cohort limits
❖ Hold communion outside?	Yes
❖ Sing inside?	No
❖ Sing outside?	Yes

QUESTION	GUIDANCE
❖ Have outdoor services?	Yes
❖ Is there a max capacity on outdoor services?	No - Practice Big 4 & Safe Reopening Plan Posted
❖ Have parking lot services?	Yes – Big 4 & Safe Reopening Plan Posted
❖ Have livestream services (held indoors)?	Yes – essential staff only
❖ Have drive-in services?	Yes
❖ Have worship services in a private home?	No
❖ Have AA and 12-step group meetings inside places of worship?	Yes
❖ Have AA and 12-step group meetings outdoors?	Yes

Do I STILL NEED TO...

- Post/implement the Safe Reopening Plan wherever I do services (outdoor, drive thru)? **Yes.**

If you are hosting any services:

- Post and implement the Safe Reopening Plan
- Remember the **BIG 4!**
 1. Temp screenings
 2. Physical distancing
 3. Facial coverings
 4. Increased sanitation

THE "BIG FOUR"

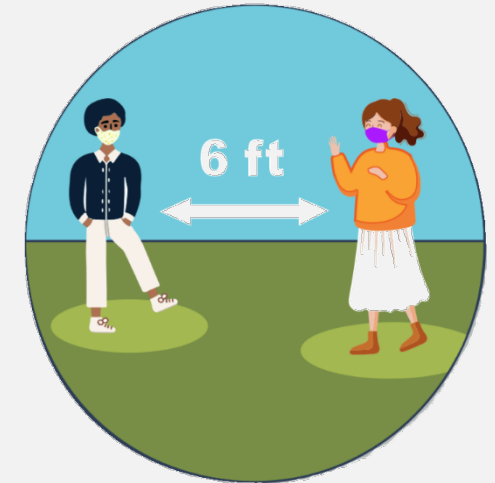
1 TEMPERATURE & SYMPTOM SCREENINGS



- ◆ Provide temperature and/or symptom screenings for all employees and volunteers at the beginning of their shift.
- ◆ Encourage workers and congregants/visitors who are sick or exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, or who have family members who are ill, to stay home.

2 PHYSICAL DISTANCING

- ◆ It is recommended that six feet of distance is allowed between individuals where feasible
- ◆ Implement measures to ensure physical distancing of at least six feet between workers and congregants/visitors, cars (for parking lot services) etc.
- ◆ Only outdoor worship services are permitted at this time
- ◆ For drive-in and parking lot services, maintain six feet distance between cars and people from different households.

FACE COVERINGS

- ◆ All patrons/visitors must wear facial coverings.
- ◆ Remind congregants and visitors in advance to bring a face covering and make them available to anyone who arrives without one, if possible.
- ◆ Workers should wash or sanitize hands before and after using or adjusting face coverings.

INCREASED SANITATION

- ◆ Wash hands with soap and water regularly for at least 20 seconds.
- ◆ Perform thorough cleaning of high traffic areas such as lobbies, halls, chapels, meeting rooms, offices, libraries, and study areas and areas of ingress and egress including stairways, etc.
- ◆ Discourage sharing items used in worship and services (such as prayer books, cushions, prayer rugs, etc.) whenever possible and provide single use or digital copies.

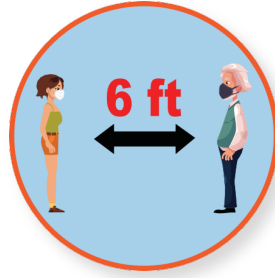
