

Transportation

- 1. If someone calls 2-1-1, speaks to the Nurse Triage Line, and meets criteria for the quarantine hotel rooms, how will clients receive transportation to the hotels? How will homeless individuals who have symptoms get from shelter to isolation?**

In order to assist with the COVID-19 crisis, Facilitating Access to Coordinated Transportation (FACT) is offering free transportation for San Diego County residents for any essential need until the stay at home order is lifted. Seniors, persons with disabilities, students, veterans, medical workers and other residents who need assistance, may call FACT at 888-924-3228 between 8am and 3pm, Monday-Friday, to request free transportation anywhere in San Diego County. Drivers and riders are required to wear a face covering while being transported. In addition, people can call their Medi-Cal Plan for access to transportation resources (link in Health Plan Card here).
