This All Facilities Letter (AFL) informs health facilities of the availability of both Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) and serology testing for COVID-19 across California hospital, academic, commercial, and public health laboratories. This interim guidance supports the local public health department, health care providers, and laboratories in determining prioritization of specific groups for PCR molecular testing. This AFL requests all Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNFs) to report daily updates regarding current staffing levels, the number of COVID-19 patients, and equipment availability to the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) via an online survey. This reporting is to ensure that California has the information necessary to respond to the COVID-19 outbreak and to provide resources and support to SNFs. The entire AFL is available [here](#).
