

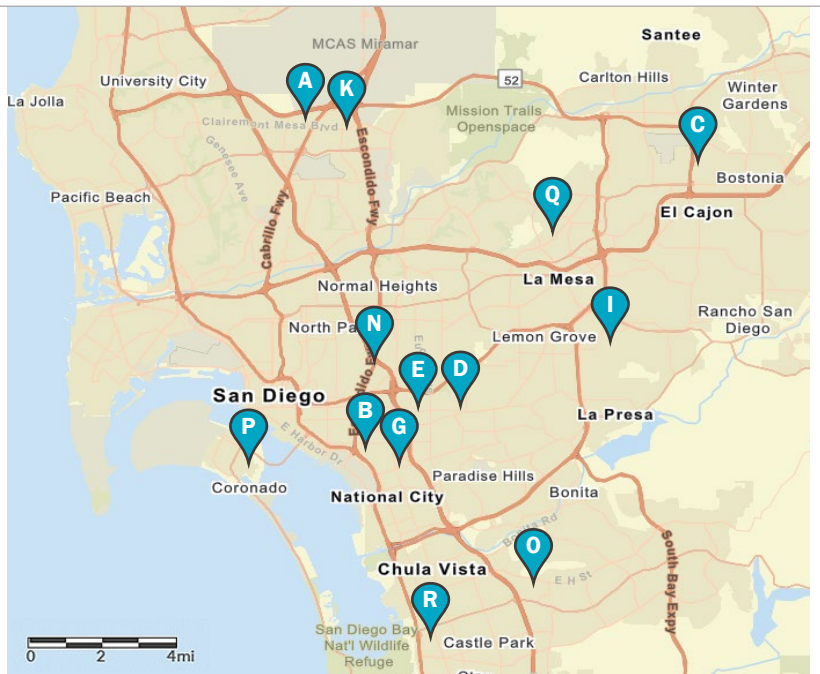
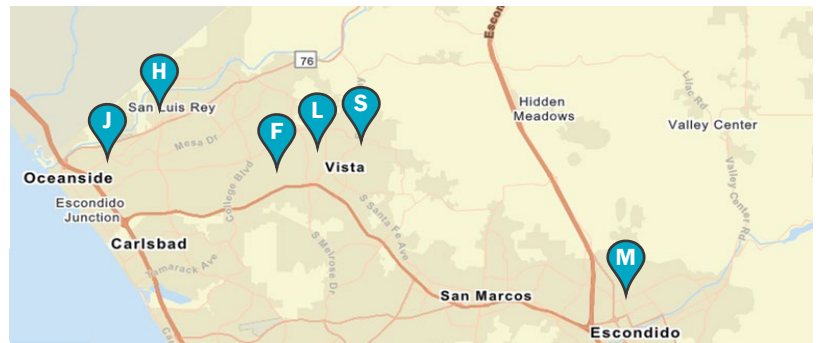

Everyone 6 months and older can get a vaccine at no cost. Individuals younger than 18 may only receive the Pfizer-BioNTech (Pfizer) COVID-19 vaccine. [Parental consent](#) is required for all eligible minors to be vaccinated. Visit the website below for the most up-to-date days and hours of operation for these County-hosted vaccination sites.

Everyone 12 years and older can receive a booster dose at least 5 months after completing their primary COVID-19 vaccination series of Pfizer-BioNTech. Adults 18 years and older can receive a booster dose at 5 months after completing their primary COVID-19 vaccination series of Moderna or 2 months after primary COVID-19 vaccination series of J&J/Jansen.
