



## Ryan White Primary Care Program Information for Patients

### Eligibility Information for Ryan White Primary Care (RWPC)

- Available to those between the ages of 21 and 64 with an HIV positive blood test, and who have no other source of payment for health care, for example, Medi-Cal, Medicare, private insurance or insurance obtained through Covered California. **All participants will be regularly screened for other payors (including Medi-Cal, Medicare, private insurance and Covered California insurance).**
- RWPC Participants must enroll or recertify every six months.
- If you are referred, you must complete the application process for other health coverage (for example – Medi-Cal).

- Some lab tests and some diagnostic services by non-clinic providers if ordered by a primary care provider.
- Viral load and drug resistance tests (with limitations) when ordered by the primary care provider.
- Basic vitamins and nutritional supplements (limited to 3 months) when ordered by the primary care provider.

#### Pharmacy

- Medications on the approved Ryan White Formulary list are covered when ordered by the primary care provider or a referred specialist. Drugs not listed in the formulary must be authorized before the pharmacy will fill the order.
- Ryan White program does not pay for drugs covered by the AIDS Drug Assistance Program (ADAP). To apply for ADAP coverage ask the clinic staff for a referral or call (619) 293-4722 or (888) 311-7632 for more information.

- Emergency, medically necessary, and palliative (pain relief) care is available.
