


National Infant Immunization Week 2025

National Infant Immunization Week (NIIW) is **April 21- April 28, 2025**. NIIW highlights the importance of protecting children two years and younger from vaccine-preventable diseases, such as whooping cough, chickenpox, and mumps. These diseases threaten the health of children and the community.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommend that children stay on track with their well-child exams and routine vaccinations. All staff in healthcare practices (doctors, nurses, physician assistants, and office staff) play important roles in promoting NIIW and in communicating with parents on childhood vaccines.



Talk with parents about vaccines:

- Give your strong recommendation on any needed vaccine.
- Encourage parents to check if their child is up to date on vaccines.
- Listen to and respond to parents' questions and concerns.
