

Sample Business Policy for Smoke-Free Outdoor Dining

General Information

San Diego County Ordinance No. 10647 prohibits smoking in all outdoor dining areas, and within 25 feet from the perimeter of such areas. Additionally, smoking is prohibited within 40 feet from a mobile food or temporary food facility, such as a food truck or food cart. To comply with the law and to protect the health of our employees, *[Business Name]* has established a smoke-free outdoor dining policy.

Smoke-Free Outdoor Dining Policy

Smoking and using e-cigarettes are not allowed in our outdoor dining areas. Additionally, smoking is not allowed within *[25 feet from the perimeter of our outdoor dining areas OR 40 feet from our mobile food facility]*. Under this policy, *[Business Name]* will clearly post “No Smoking” signs at the entrance to and throughout outdoor dining areas. Ashtrays are not permitted in any outdoor dining area.

Compliance
