Health Advisory Update #62: COVID-19 Vaccine Update: Deauthorization of Monovalent mRNA Vaccines

Key Messages

- On April 18, 2023, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) announced changes to the emergency use authorizations (EUAs) for mRNA (Pfizer and Moderna) COVID-19 vaccines:
 - o Monovalent Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines are no longer authorized for use in the United States.
 - Authorization of the bivalent mRNA vaccines (original and Omicron BA.4/BA.5 strains) to be used for all doses administered to individuals ≥ 6 months of age.
 - Authorization of an additional bivalent dose for individuals ≥ 65 years of age.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) updated the <u>Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines</u> to reflect these changes.

Situation

Following thorough evaluation, on April 18, 2023, the FDA <u>amended the EUAs for Pfizer and Moderna COVID 19 vaccines</u>. On April 19, 2023, the CDC <u>endorsed the FDA changes</u>. For additional information, review CDC's updated <u>Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines</u>. Additional CDC updates on COVID-19 vaccine recommendations for persons with <u>moderate or severe immune compromise will be available soon</u>.

Actions Requested

- 1. **Stay up to date** on CDC's <u>Interim Clinical Considerations for Use of COVID-19 Vaccines</u>, including updates, if any, for immunocompromised patients.
- 2. **Replace** the monovalent primary series doses with the bivalent vaccine for all ages in accordance with CDC recommendations.
- 3. **Provide additional bivalent boosters** to persons \geq 65 years of age.
- 4. **Report** vaccine-related adverse events and deaths, as well as vaccine administration errors to the Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) and to the County Immunization Program at IZINFO.HHSA@sdcounty.ca.gov or Fax: (619) 692-5677.
