Get your HPV vaccine to prevent cancer today



- Age matters! Human papillomavirus (HPV) cancer **prevention decreases** the longer you wait to get vaccinated.
- The ideal age to get the HPV vaccine is **11-12 years old**, yet kids as young as 9 years old or adults up to 26 years old can receive the vaccine.
- HPV vaccine is for **both males and females**.

- Protect yourself or your child **from six types of cancer**.
- HPV infection has no treatment, but **the vaccine can prevent it**.
- About **four out of five** people will get HPV at some point in their lives, but most infected people do not know it.
- HPV vaccine is **safe**. Talk to your doctor.
