



SINGLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT: PUBLIC HEALTH INFORMATION SYSTEM (PHIS) CONTRACT

Health Services Advisory Board

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- Authorization for Single Source Contract with Netsmart
 - Current contract over ten years old
 - Contract has been amended 26 times
- Flexibility to add upgrades and enhancements
 - New module for TB
 - Client portal



- PHIS has been the system of record for PHS since 2002
- Currently there are more than 700,000 client registrations
- More than 200 users at Regional Public Health Centers, satellite clinics, and Health Services Complex at Rosecrans
- Users include: registration staff, support staff, PHNs, supervisors, MD's, billers and analysts



SYSTEM HAS EVOLVED AND NOW INCLUDES:

- Appointment scheduling
- Client Registration for programs: TB, STD, Immunizations and others
 - Records client demographics, services and diagnoses
 - Insurance billing
- Customized module that includes the ability to record TB Tests and generate patient letters
- Chart tracking



- Field services module for Public Health Nursing activities
- Clinical Work Station module for Hansen's Disease
- Two way interface with SDIR (San Diego Immunization Registry)
- One way interface with Starlims (Lab System)
- STD EHR UAT is about to start
- ACMS module for EPSDT and PCN programs



- Current Funding:
 - \$400,000 Annually.
- Funding Sources: Health Realignment
 - Period: July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017
- Option Years:
 - Four additional option years through June 30, 2021



- Award a contract for maintenance and licensing fees for continued use of Public Health Information System as well as additional modules, interfaces, customizations, reports, and training.
- Authorize the Director, Department of Purchasing and Contracting to amend the agreement as required for changes that do not materially impact or alter the program or funding level, subject to approval of the Director, Health and Human Services Agency.
- Authorize the Director, Health and Human Services Agency, to pursue future funding opportunities related to the maintenance and support of Public Health Information System.
