



HIV MULTI-SERVICE PROCUREMENT

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HRSA recommended revising existing procurement practice and procure at one time in a single procurement action.

Multi-service procurement will include the majority of the Ryan White care and treatment services.



Requesting authority to issue a multi-service procurement in the amount of \$8,418,128.



35 contracts, 14 providers

Each service category procured separately on a 5-year cycle

1/5th of service categories procured annually



Service delivery system is not fully integrated, which can be difficult for clients

Administrative requirements for each contract lead to inefficiencies for clients, providers and the County



Most services procured at once

Services planned to ensure coordination and access in each region
