



Immunization Support Services: Application, Revenue Agreement, and Single Source Contract

San Diego County receives approximately \$1.8 million annually to defray costs of program efforts to improve immunization coverage and control diseases preventable by vaccines.

- **Promote and support use of the Immunization Registry.**
- **Technical assistance to local providers to improve immunization practices.**
- **Promote partnerships with schools, hospitals and health systems, community groups, and providers to maximize outreach to underserved communities.**
- **Surveillance and investigations of cases of vaccine preventable diseases.**



- **Vaccine Accountability and Management**
- **Immunization Information System (SDIR)**
- **Quality Assurance**
- **Perinatal Hepatitis B Prevention**
- **Education, Information, Training, Partnerships**
- **Prevention, Surveillance, and Control of Vaccine Preventable Diseases**
- **Assessment of Compliance with Childcare and School Immunization Entry Requirements**



- **Conduct daily operations for San Diego Immunization Registry, including managing Help Desk (2,605 calls in FY 15/16)**
- **Conduct quality assurance and monitor electronic data interfaces with hospitals, clinics, and pharmacies**
 - **8 interfaces via Health Information Exchange (HIE)**
 - **6 interfaces direct into SDIR**
 - **10 interfaces in the pipeline**
 - **213 sites total**
- **Test new releases and troubleshoot problems**
- **Train medical personnel on SDIR (1,203 trained from schools and providers in FY 15/16)**
- **Support distribution of 60,000+ doses of flu vaccine**



- **Conduct evaluation of services, including Random Digit Dialing Survey**
- **Provide information and education to schools and childcare facilities (124 trainings to schools and childcare facilities)**
- **Support County and community organizations with flu clinics**
- **Convene the San Diego Immunization Coalition**
- **Organize community events, including annual Flu Summit**
- **Support Public Health Nurses with Perinatal Hep B Prevention case management**

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI)



- **A Request for Information (RFI) was posted on San Diego County BuyNet website in September 2016**
- **RFI was used to assess interest and capacity of community organizations to provide immunization support services**
- **Only one community organization expressed interest in the RFI and submitted a response: UCSD**

TODAY'S REQUEST



- **To approve submission of a three-year grant application to CDPH for the period July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020 for immunization related services.**
- **To approve execution of all required grant documents with CDPH for current three- year period and subsequent agreements or renewals that do not materially impact the program or funding level.**
- **To approve entering into negotiations with UCSD for operational support to the San Diego Immunization Program for one year with four option years.**
