### I. Communicable Disease Issues

### A. Infectious Disease Issues

- 1) Influenza Season Implementing public education campaign
  - Continuing HO Order from November 2014
  - Week 10: Activity for Influenza-like illness (ILI) is at 6% (3<sup>rd</sup> straight week)
  - Flu Watch (attachment for Week 10, week ending 3/12/16)
    - 4,928 total cases (483 new cases reported for Week 10, compared to 847 for Week 9; and 153 for Week 10 for 2014/15 flu season & FYTD 6391)
    - 95 ICU cases
    - 41 death (compared to 6 for Week 10 last flu season)
    - 15 outbreaks
    - 6% ILI (compared to 6% in last week)

# 2) Zika Virus

- All reported cases are imported; from 2013-2106 3 cases
- CDC is creating a US Zika Pregnancy Registry for local, state, and territorial health departments
- No locally acquired cases; invasive Aedes species is in San Diego
- Focus in on education and outreach, case reporting, and prevention of mosquito breeding
