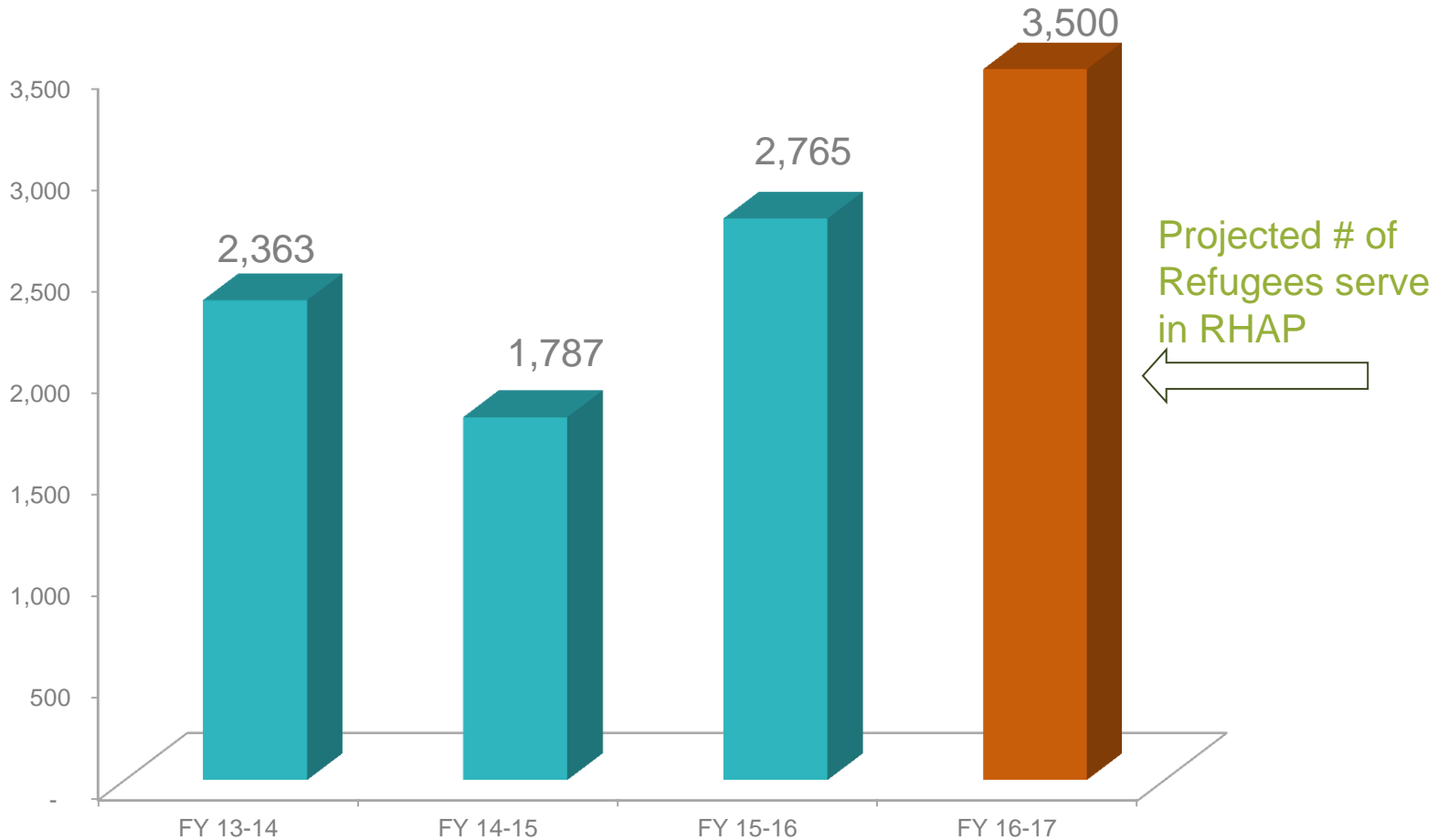
# PURPOSE OF BOARD LETTER

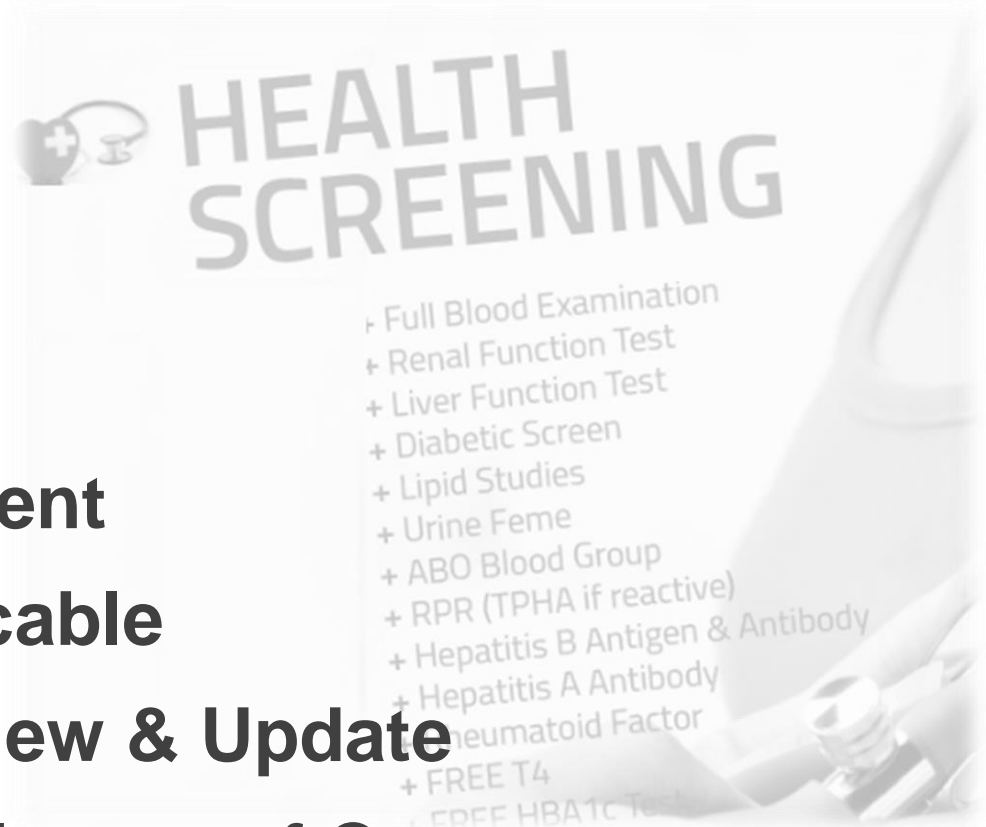




- To prevent & control health problems of public significance
