NEED FOR FUTURE OF PUBLIC HEALTH FUNDING



- Funding and policy decisions have long challenged the U.S. public health system.
- This funding supports the ability of public health jurisdictions for:
 - Preventing diseases,
 - Improving living conditions,
 - Extending life expectancy, and
 - Efforts to address critical social, economic, and environmental issues that contribute to health.



INVESTMENT IN PUBLIC HEALTH

Ongoing Future of Public Health funding to be allocated to local health departments for:

- A diversified workforce
- A ready and sustainable public health infrastructure
- Expanded data access and interoperability
- A holistic partnership network
- A proactive, personalized, and highly coordinated communication strategy and operations, and
- Comprehensive community health improvement strategy

1. Authorize the acceptance of \$14,356,108 in grant funds from the California Department of Public Health for Future of Public Health Funding for the period of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, and authorize the Clerk of the Board to execute all required grant documents, upon receipt, including any annual extensions, amendments, or revisions that do not materially impact or alter the services or funding level.
2. Authorize the Agency, Director, Health and Human Services Agency to apply for any additional funding opportunity announcements, if available, to further develop and strengthen the public health workforce and infrastructure.
