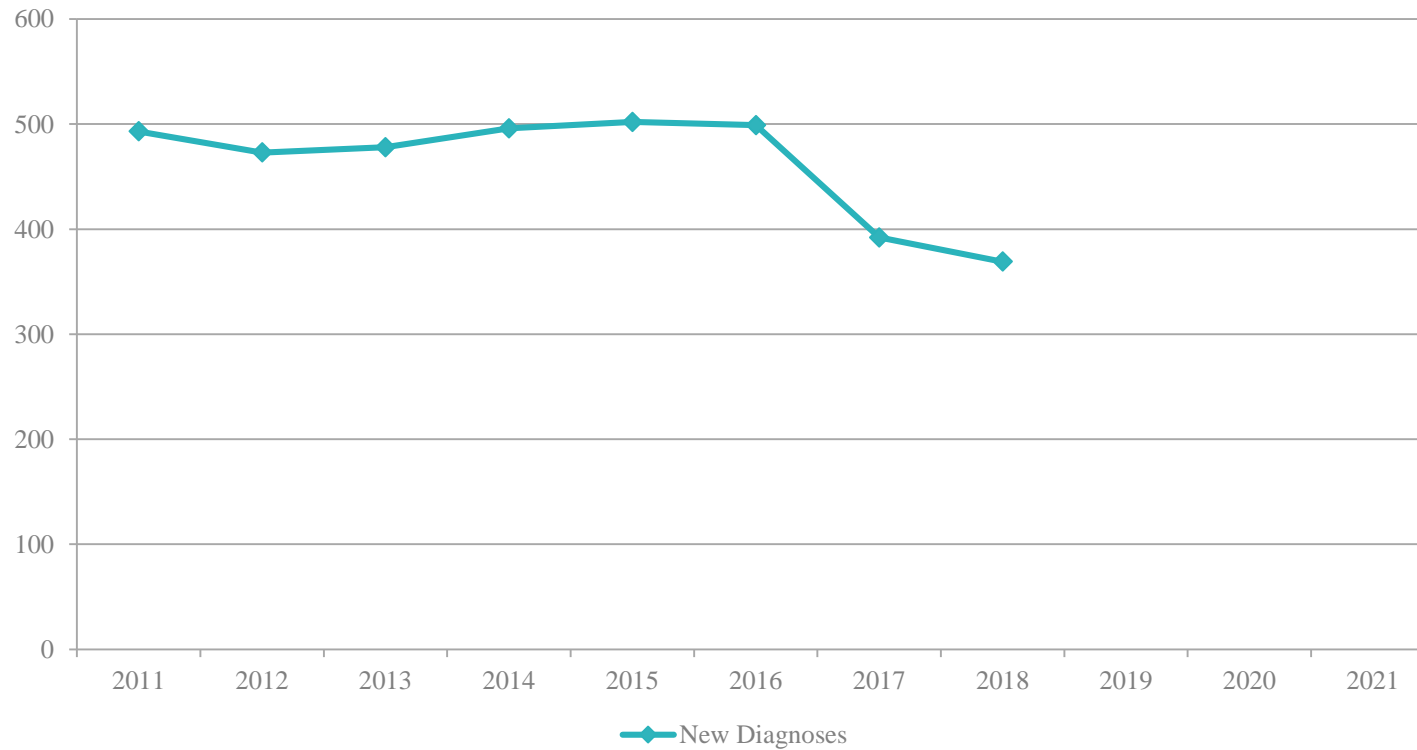

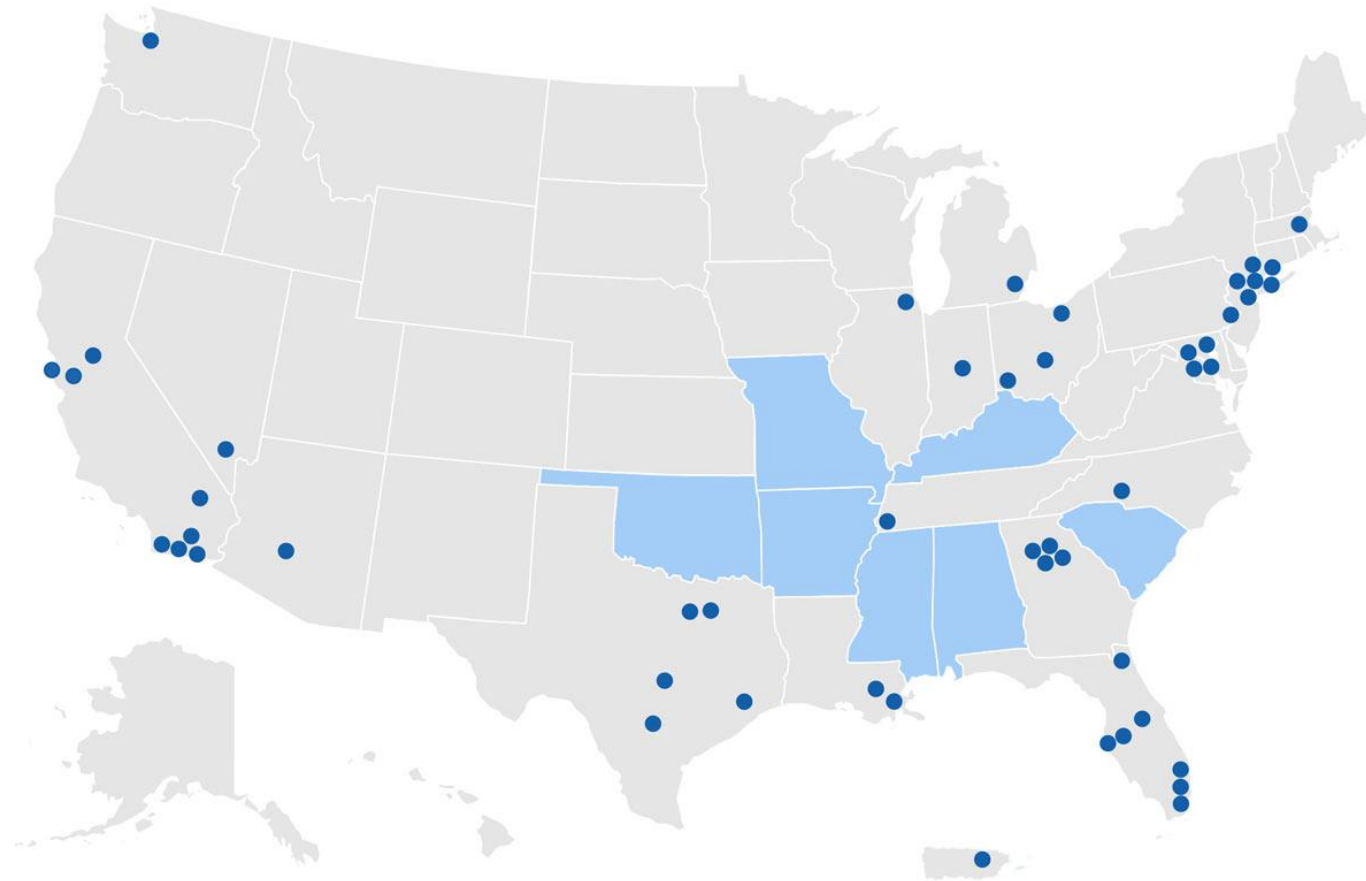

PHASE 1: GEOGRAPHIC FOCUS ON 57 COUNTIES/STATES/TERRITORIES





Diagnose all people with HIV as early as possible.

Treat people with HIV rapidly and effectively to reach sustained viral suppression.



Prevent new HIV transmissions by using proven interventions, including pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and syringe services programs (SSPs).

Respond quickly to potential HIV outbreaks to get needed prevention and treatment services to people who need them.

GOALS

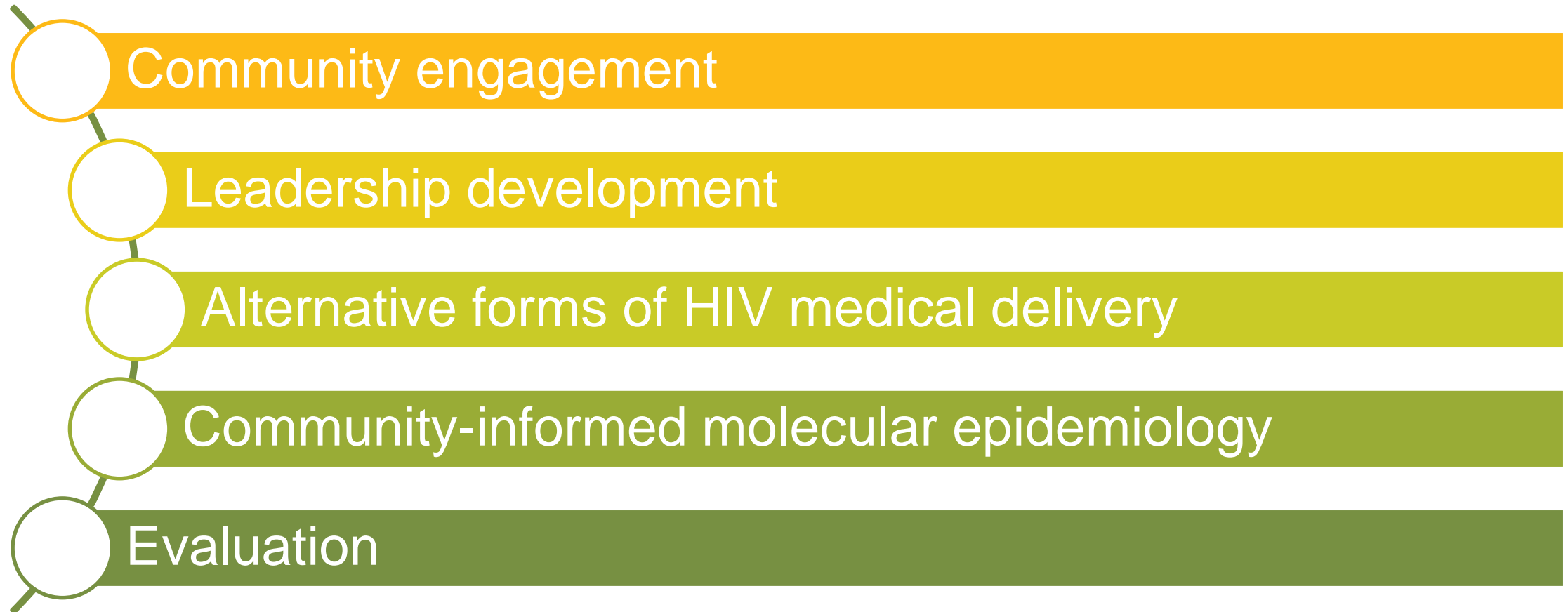
Reduce new HIV diagnoses by 75% by December 31, 2024
(from 369 new HIV diagnoses in 2018 to 92 in 2024)

Increase proportion of persons living with diagnosed HIV who
receive from 74% in 2018 to 95% in 2024

Increase proportion of persons living with diagnosed HIV who
are virally suppressed from 63% in 2018 to 90% in 2024.



COMPETITIVE PROCUREMENT: \$16.5 MILLION OVER 5 YEARS
