CDC's funds California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Office of AIDS (OA) for HIGH IMPACT PREVENTION (HIP) Currently PS18-1802; previously PS 12-1201:

- Effectiveness and cost
- Feasibility for full-scale implementation
- Coverage in priority populations
- Interaction of interventions
