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- ~ Outreach - Online and In Person
- ~ Linkage/Navigation – PrEP, PEP and ART (Biomedical Interventions)
- ~ Social Media and Marketing – Countywide promotion of HIV prevention resources and service
- ~ Condom Distribution - San Diego Condom Distribution Partner Program, venue based
- ~ Partner Services - Disclosure assistance services
- ~ HIV Testing - New services include focused testing with linkage/navigation
- ~ Surveillance – Data utilized to inform prevention
- ~ Administration and Evaluation - Intervention Specialist and Evaluation Consultant

- ❖ Capacity Building Assistance (CBA) from



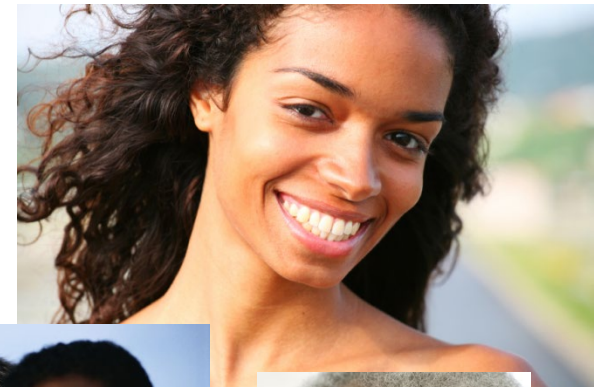
## WHAT IS ON THE HORIZON

- ❖ HPG has ranked and allocated funds for Health Education and Risk Reduction (HERR) and groups; although funds were reallocated
- ❖ Efforts to coordinate activities from various funding sources
- ❖ Expansion of Harm Reduction Services (promotion of SSPs)
- ❖ Social Networking Strategies Technical Assistance
- ❖ New developments such as injectable PrEP

# GAP ANALYSIS



Are we serving the priority populations to the degree that they exist in the epidemiology in each region/area(s)?





- Institute of Public Health (IPH) operates out of San Diego State University; HIV evaluation since 1997 and HIV prevention evaluation since 2006
- IPH provides data for all local prevention efforts (COSD, CDC, CDPH, SAMHSA)
