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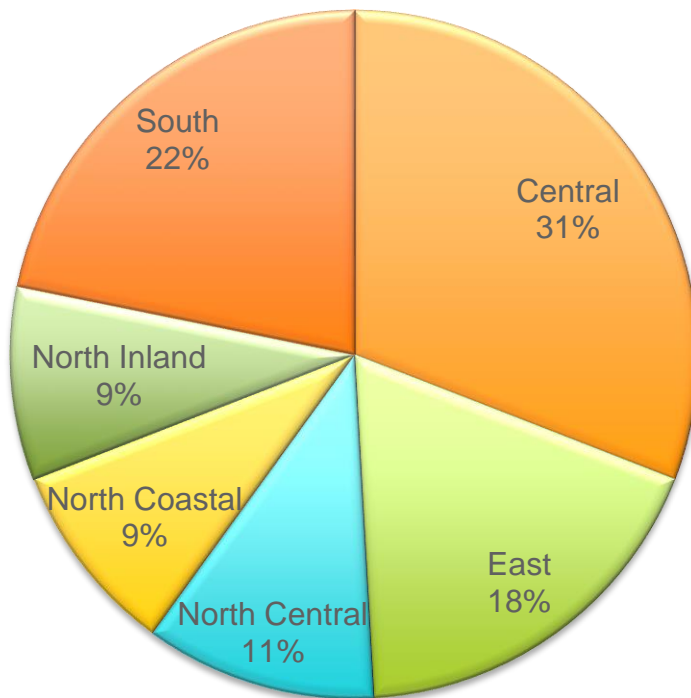

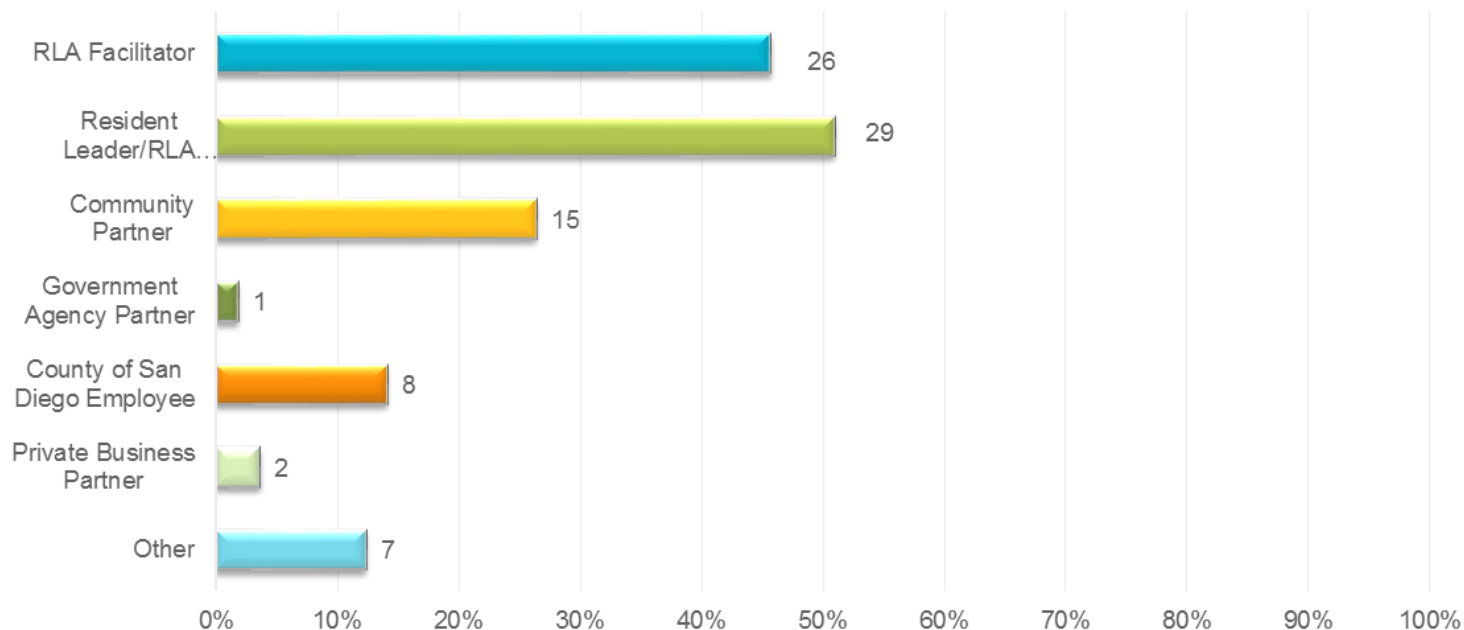

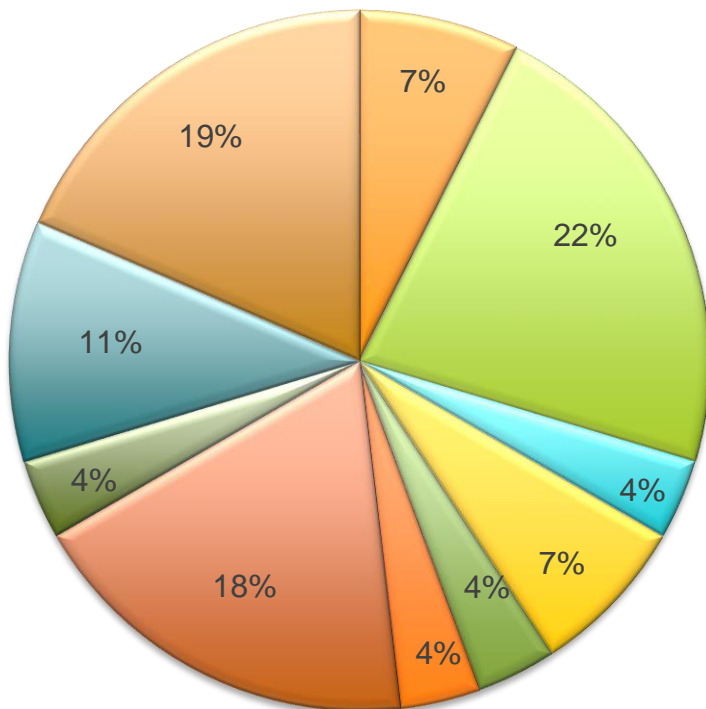

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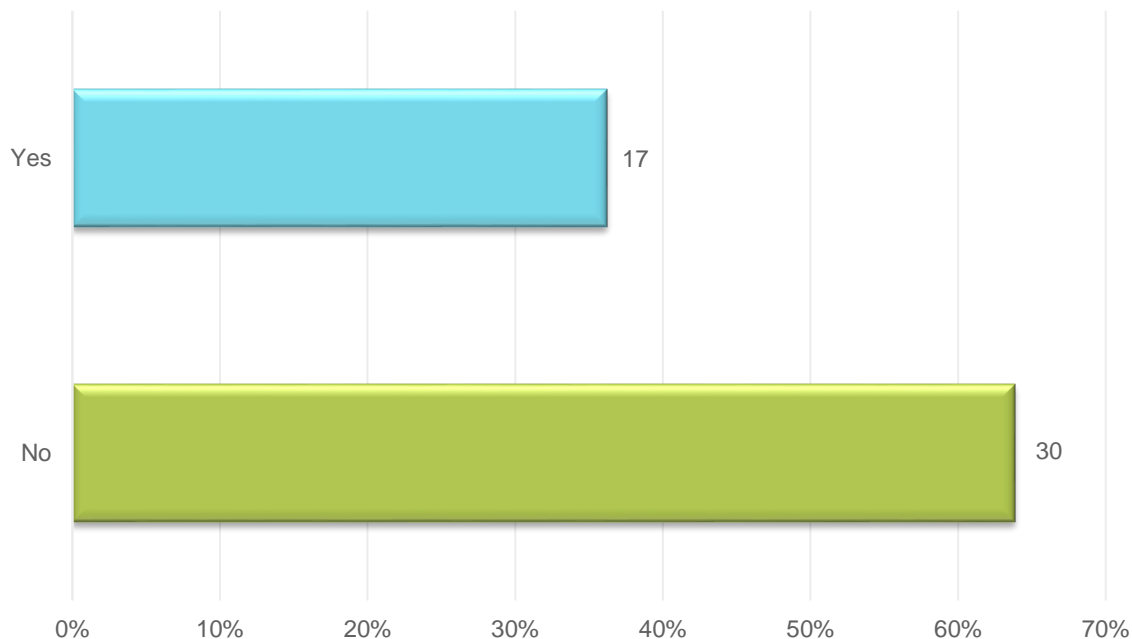

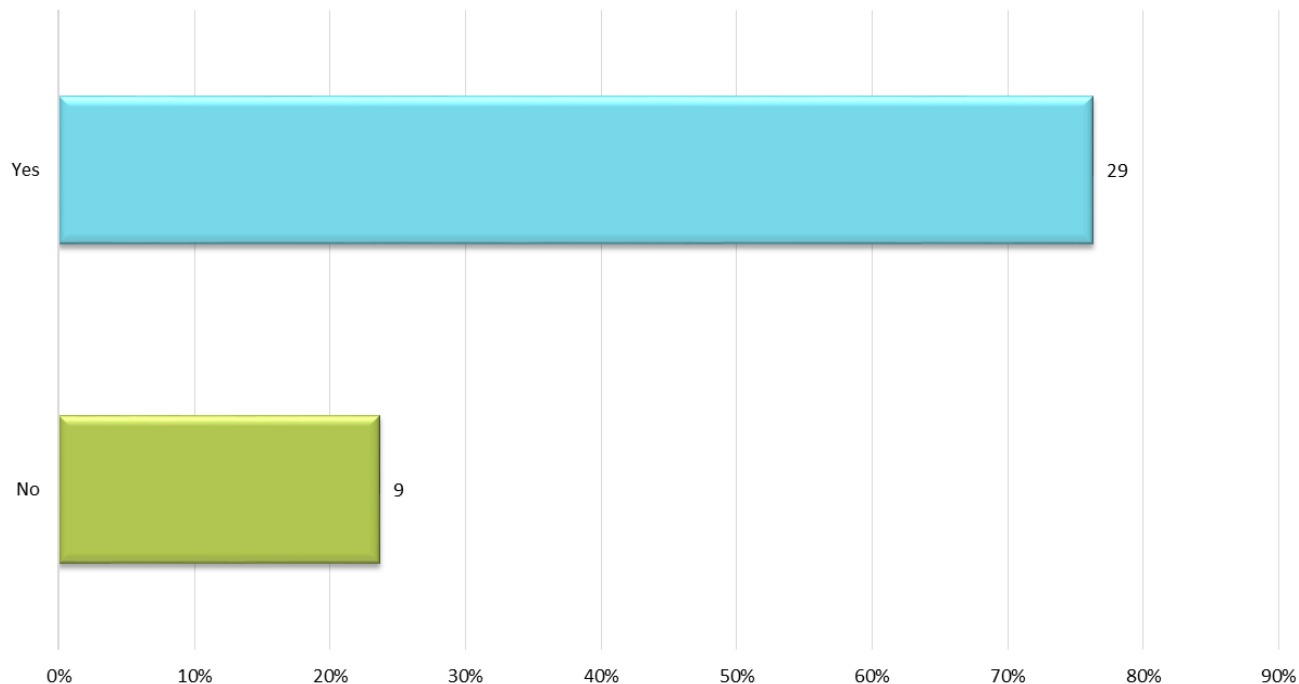

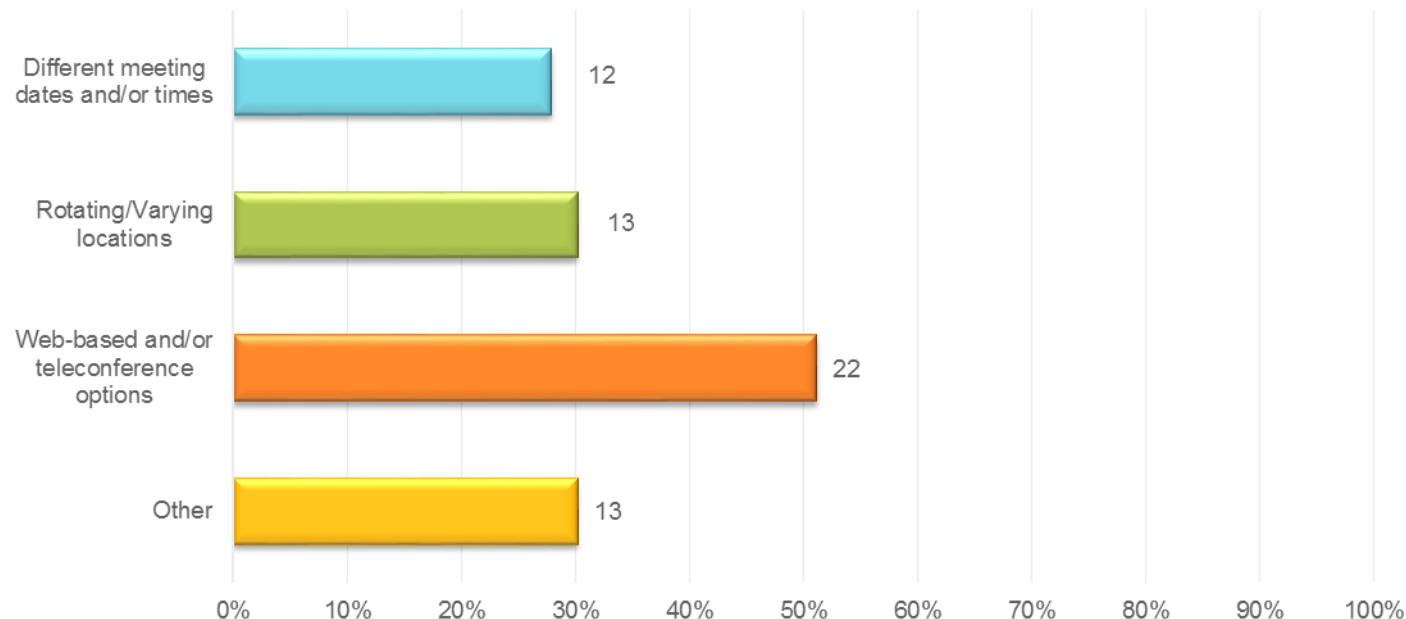

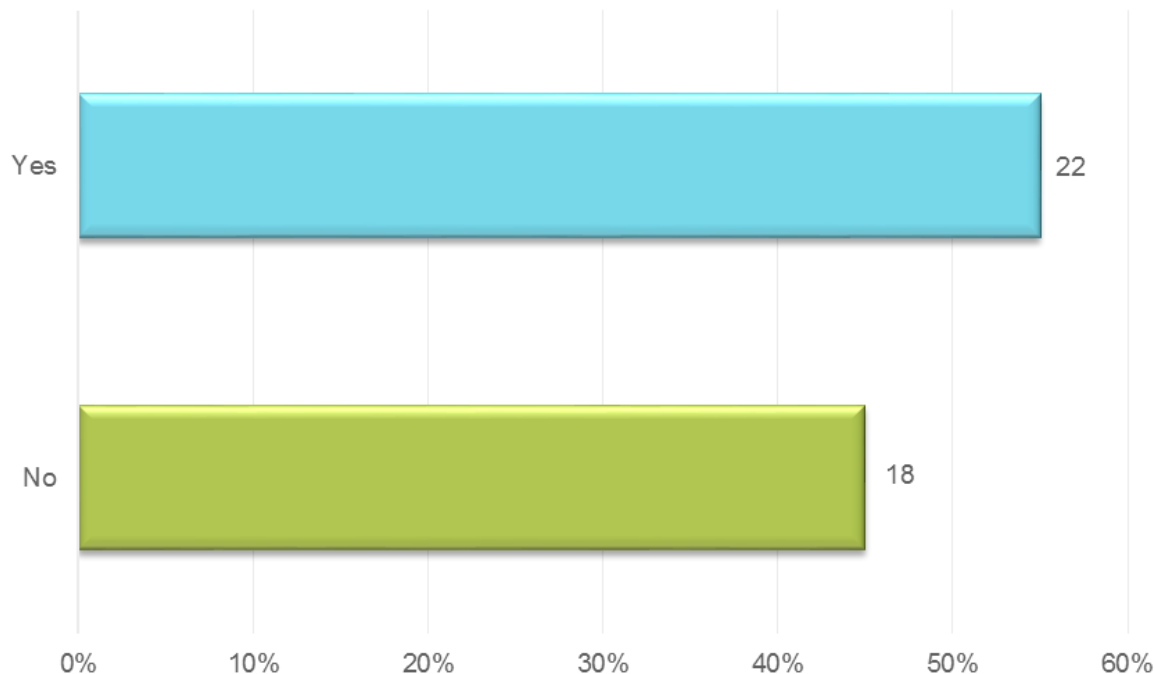

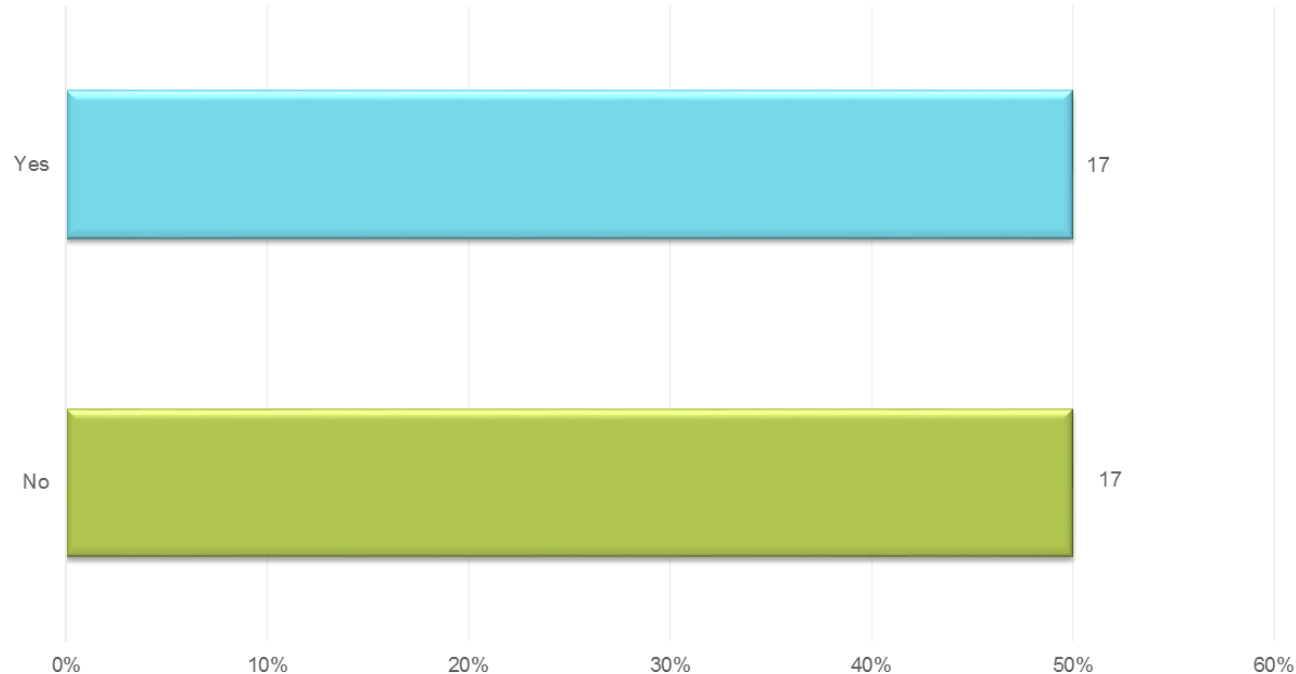

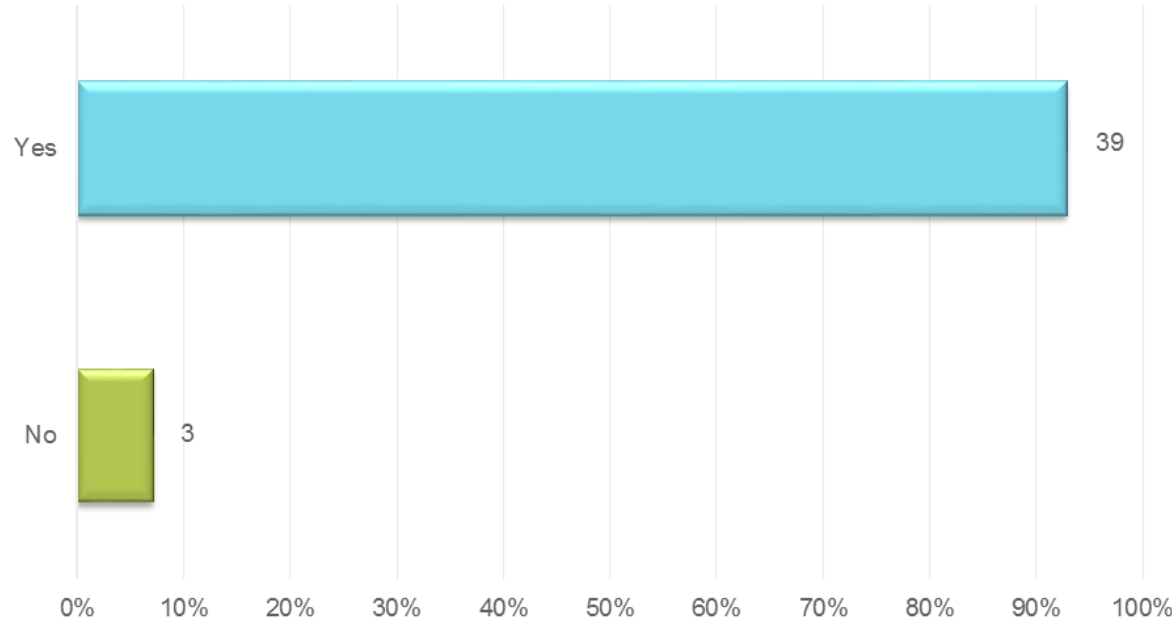

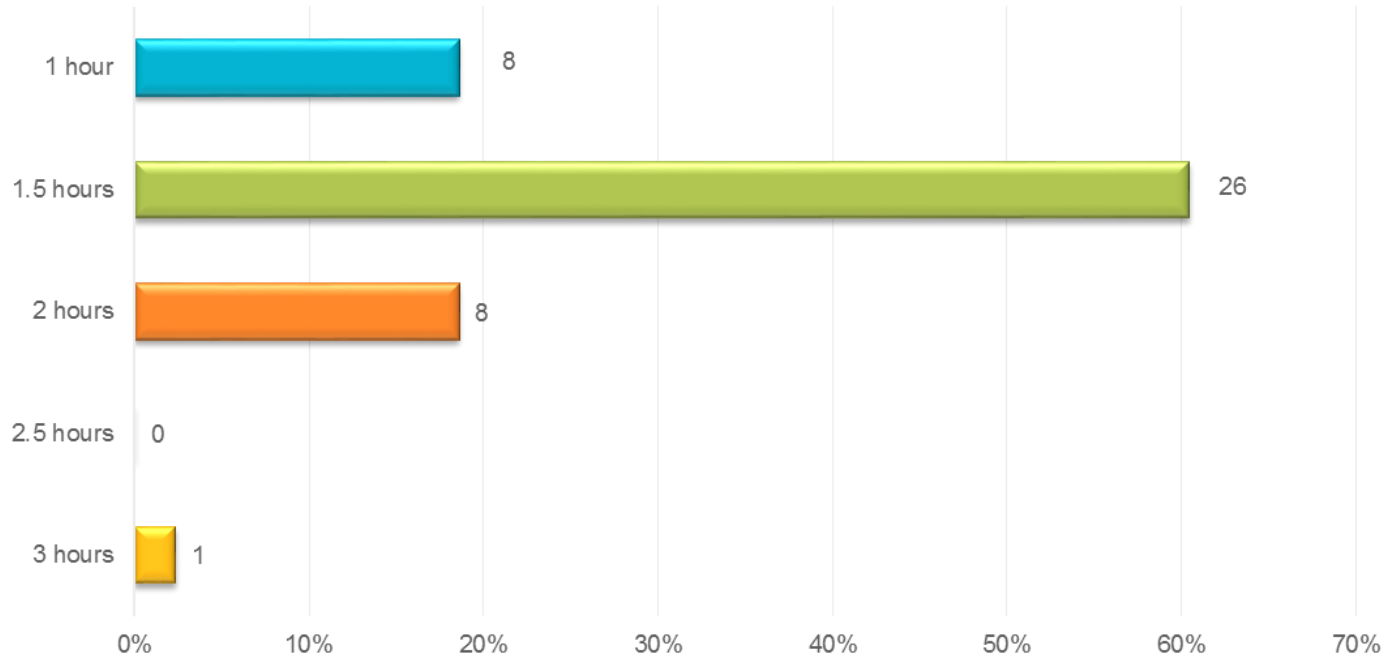
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THE RLA COUNCIL MEETINGS SHOULD LAST FOR A DURATION OF...

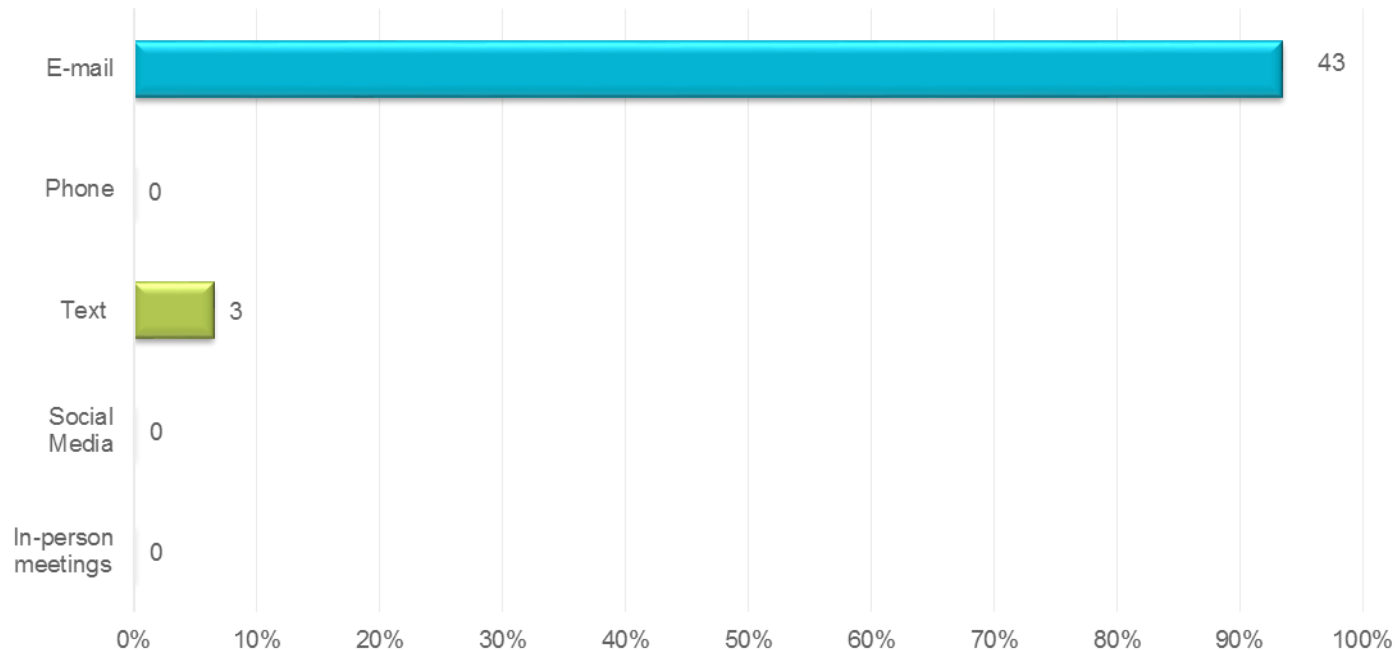
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THE BEST METHOD OF COMMUNICATION FOR ME IS...

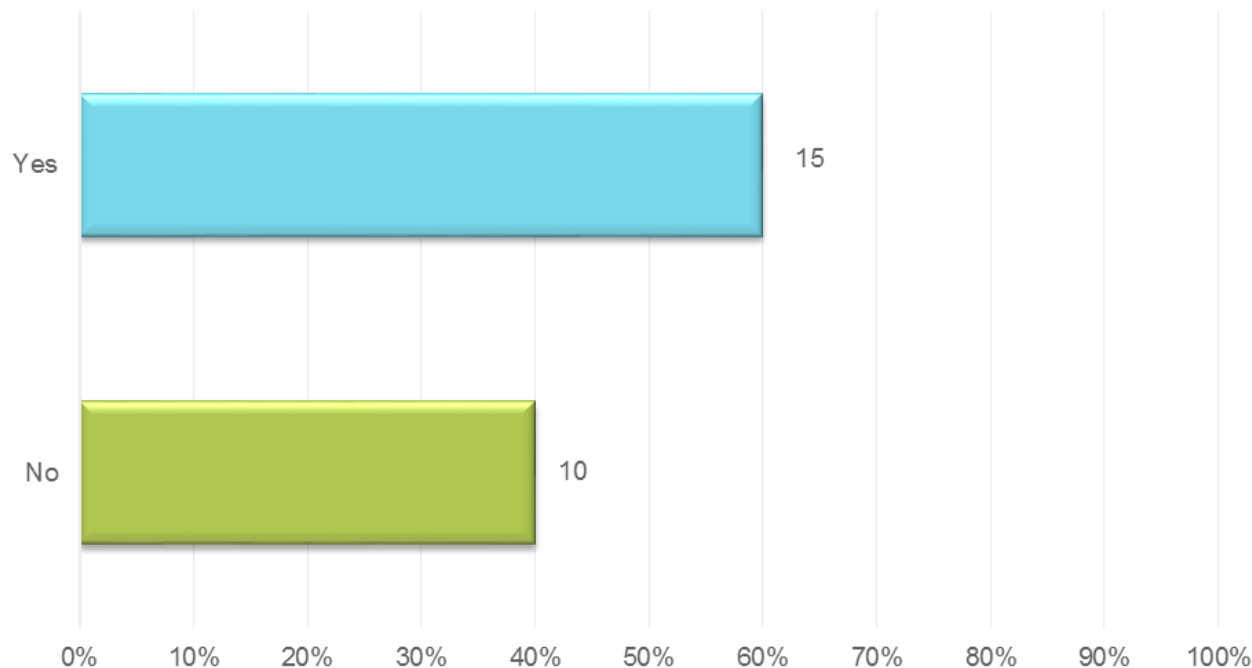

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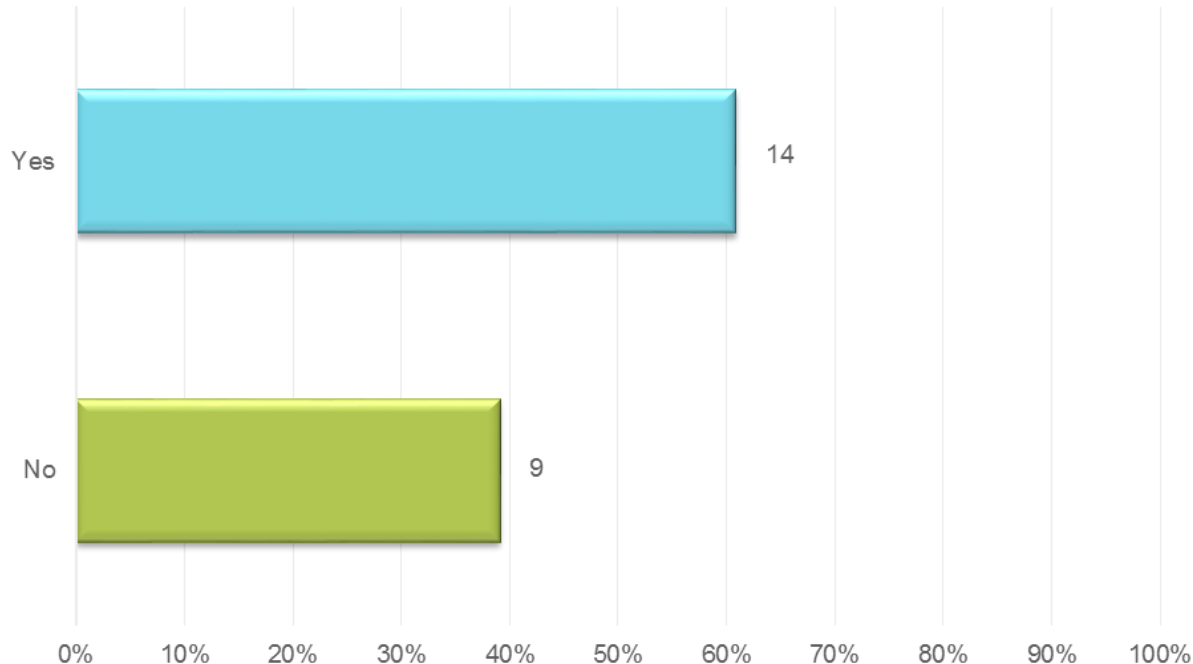

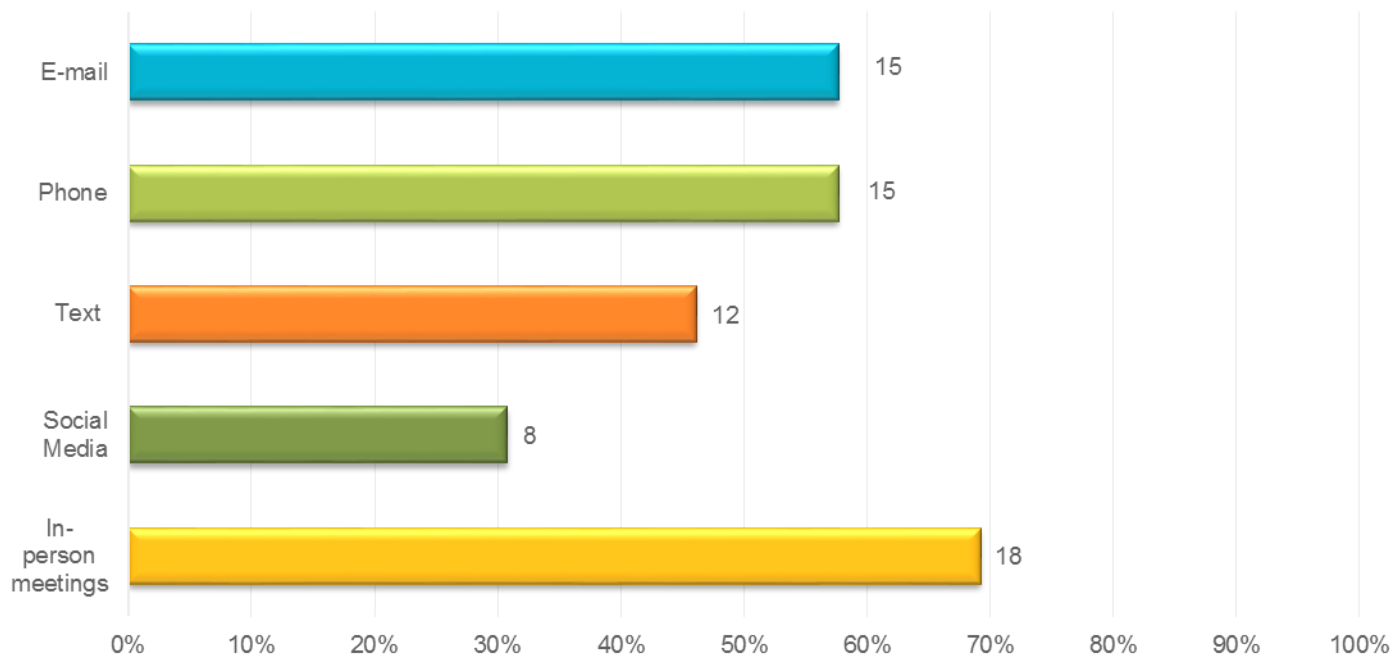

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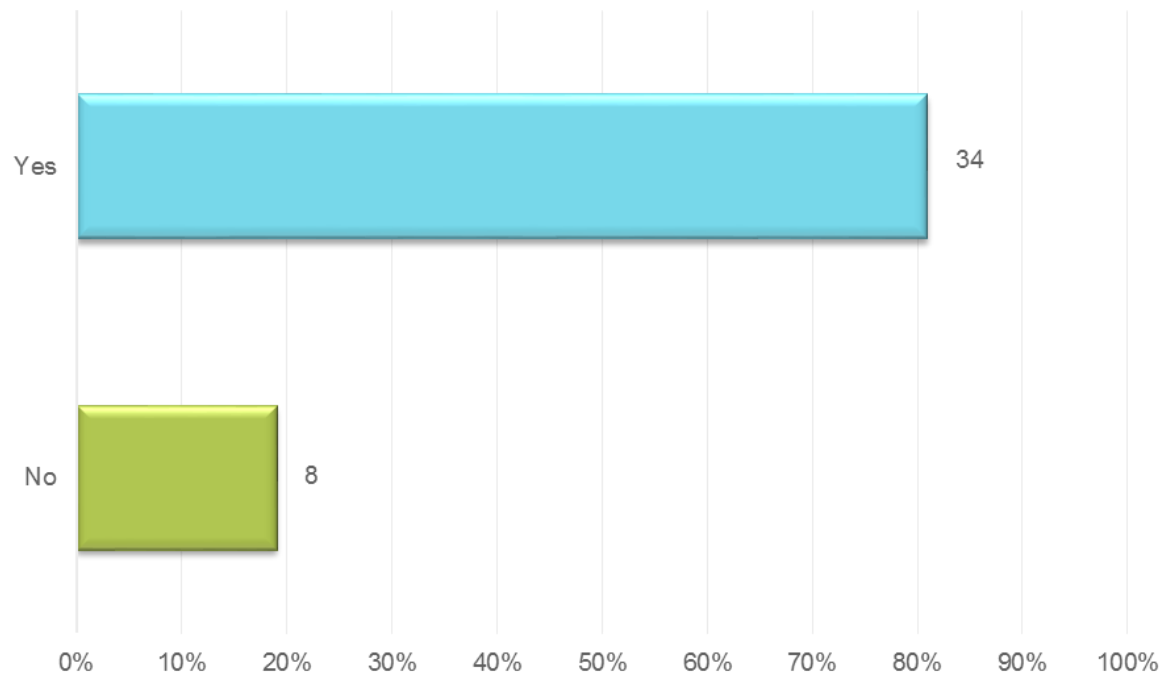


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CAPACITY BUILDING FOR THE RLA NETWORK

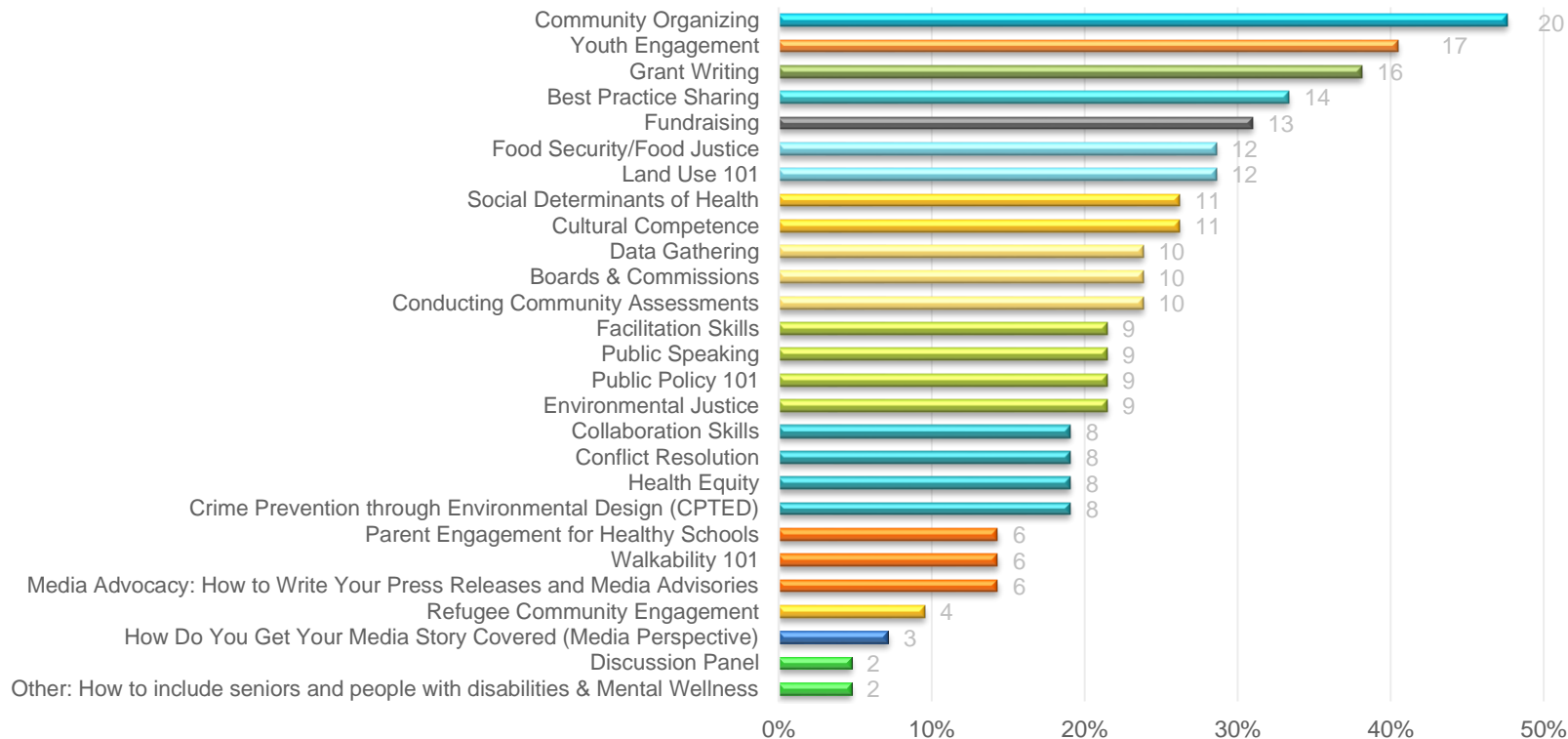

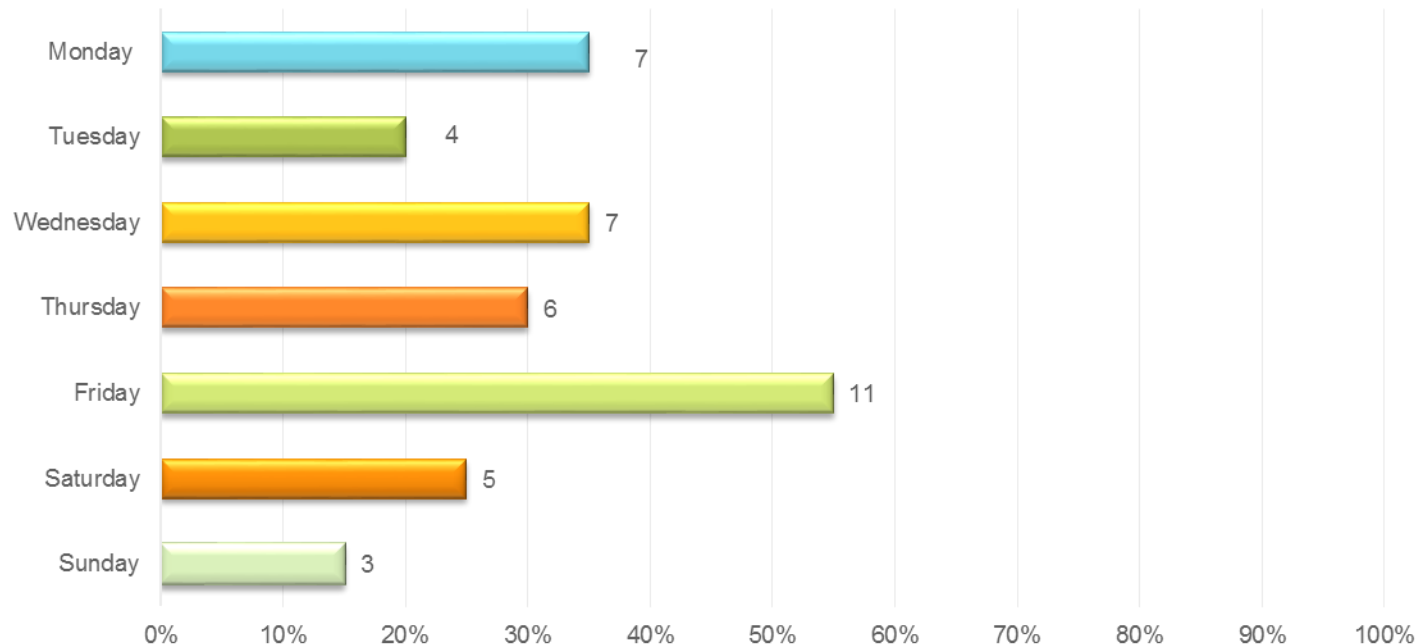

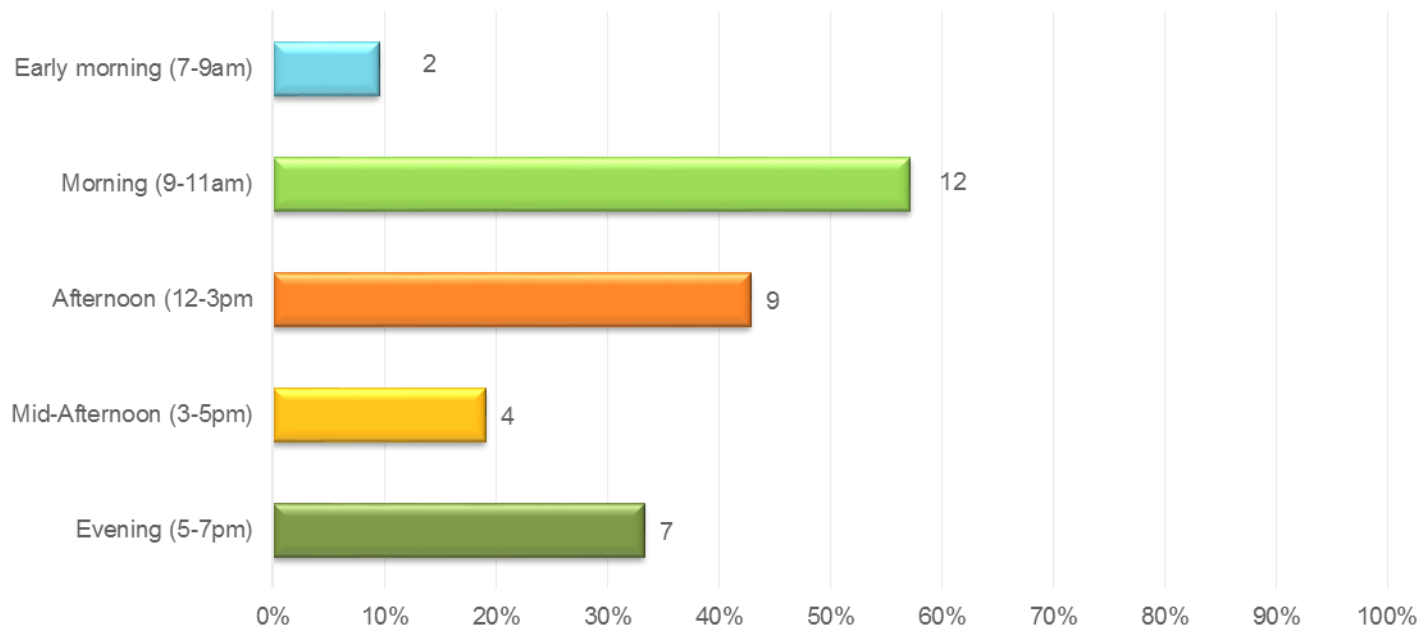
