Apply for Disaster CalFresh food benefits by calling your local county social services office. Dial **211*** between **November 16 and November 20.**

2

Complete the application and interview with your county. This will happen by phone. After you finish your application, you will receive a call for your interview.

3

Pick up your EBT card. If you are approved for Disaster CalFresh food benefits, your county will tell you when and where to pick up your EBT card, which you'll use like a debit card to purchase food.
