

2020 CALIFORNIA WILDFIRE DISASTER FOOD ASSISTANCE

- Attention All Californians -

Disaster CalFresh food benefits are available for a limited time.

Am I eligible?

Even if you are not eligible for CalFresh food benefits, you may be eligible for Disaster CalFresh.

If during the affected dates you:

- Had at least one person in your household not getting regular CalFresh food benefits; and you
- Spent money because of the wildfire or related power outage; or
- Lost money from work because of the wildfire; or
- Spent money because of damage to your home or business
- Lived or worked in counties affected by the wildfires between the dates listed below.

If you already receive CalFresh food benefits, you are not eligible for Disaster CalFresh.

How do I apply?

You can apply for Disaster CalFresh food benefits between November 16 - November 20, 2020

- Call the phone number listed below for your county.
- If approved, your county will tell you when and where to pick up your EBT card, which you'll use like a debit card to purchase food.

*Simply dial 2-1-1 on your telephone and tell the operator you're interested in applying for Disaster CalFresh food benefits.

Additional Information:

- Disaster CalFresh is NOT a public benefit considered for public charge.
- You do not need a social security number to apply for Disaster CalFresh.
- The CalFresh student eligibility rule does not apply to Disaster CalFresh.
- There is a Disaster CalFresh household income limit. For example, a household of two may qualify for a one-time food benefit of \$355 if their monthly available income and resources for the affected dates is less than \$2,146, after considering the impact of the disaster on their household.
