Outreach, Treatment, Housing





- Human Services Specialists as part of the Homeless Outreach Team
- Clinicians for 16 PERT teams in the City
- Public health nurses provide assessments and connect people to services, particularly TB and HIV
- Veterans Resource Officers co-located at the Downtown Library
- Home Finder Program
