- 1. Meeting called to order at 9:33 by Chair, Vino Pajanor.
- 2. The December 13, 2023 Meeting Minutes were approved, with all Board Members present voting yes.
- 3. Public Comments:
  - No public comment
- 4. **Action Item:** Nomination and Selection of the 2024 SSAB Chair and Vice-Chair. Vino Pajanor was reelected as 2024 Chair (6 yes, 0 no, 0 abstain). Jan Spencley was re-elected as 2023 Vice Chair (6 yes, 0 no, 0 abstain).

- 5. **Discussion Item:** SSAB 2024 Priorities and Strategic Goals: All SSAB Members. Ms. Assmaa Elayyat and Dr. Alberto Banuelos presented a list of suggestions to the Board Members, for the 2024 priorities and strategic goals for the Social Services Advisory Board. This included continuing to advocate for legislative bills, but also incorporating advocacy around the State Budget for administrative funding as well as local advocacy for the County Budget. Mr. Rick Wanne also suggested the Board Members' advocacy in the elimination of the Semi-Annual Report and the initial and annual interview that is required for the CalWORKs and CalFresh Programs, as well as the introduction of Artificial Intelligence funded at the State level for 24/7 on-demand customer service, with the Self-Sufficiency Services willing to pilot the program. The proposed 2024 priorities and strategic goals are as follows:
  - Continue State and Federal Legislative Advocacy
  - State Budget Advocacy
  - Continue Community Outreach Efforts
  - Promote Increased Use of Technology Automation and Customer Self Service
  - Support SSAB Members for Increased Elected Officials and Community Education Regarding Self-Sufficiency

A public comment was made by Mauricio Medina of the San Diego Hunger Coalition, requests that the Board continue to prioritize the implementation of the Make the County Work For All initiative in the 2024 priorities, and for the State Budget he believes there is more opportunity to weigh in as the public in shaping the budget in the next year between today and the main revise with the governor.

- 6. **Information Item:** Review Legislative Advocacy Bills that Support SSAB Strategic Priorities: Assmaa Elayyat, Deputy Director, Self-Sufficiency Services, Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA). Ms. Elayyat provided an overview of what occurs in the legislative session, explaining that as 2024 is the 2<sup>nd</sup> year of the cycle, held bills from last year will be carried forward into this year. New legislation will also be introduced around February 16, 2024 and the Social Services Advisory Board will be able to discuss advocacy following this date.
- 7. **Information Item:** Update on Medi-Cal Renewals, PHE Lift for Public Assistance Programs, Waivers, Enrollment, Service Delivery, Data: Assmaa Elayyat, Deputy Director, Self-Sufficiency Services, Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA). Ms. Elayyat provided quick updates for CalFresh and CalWORKs programs, focusing mainly on Medi-Cal Renewal updates and reports.

# Social Services Advisory Board (SSAB) 2023 Annual Report to the County Board of Supervisors

#### February 2024

In accordance with the County Administrative Code, Article LIX, Section 911 the Social Services Advisory Board (SSAB) submits the following report of activities and accomplishments for 2023.

#### **Background:**

The Charter of the SSAB is to review and evaluate Social Service policies, programs and budgets; recommend means of improving services and facilities; serve as a sounding board for the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA); and where appropriate, submit to the Board of Supervisors recommendations concerning the Agency budget and practices.

The plan for 2023 was to advise the Board of Supervisors on goals and objectives relevant to all Self-Sufficiency Programs: CalWORKs, Employment Services, Medi-Cal, General Relief, CalFresh, and Program Integrity, etc. The SSAB monitored and gave feedback on the delivery of Social Services, as required by the County Charter.

#### **Membership and Organization:**

The SSAB consists of ten volunteer citizens who are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Each Supervisor nominates two members, who are subject to approval by the full Board of Supervisors. A Chair and a Vice-Chair are elected annually and serve for one calendar year. The 2023 Chair was Vino Pajanor (D1), CEO of Catholic Charities, and 2023 Vice Chair was Jan Spencley (D4), Executive Director of San Diegans for Healthcare Coverage.

The SSAB started 2023 with one membership vacancy, which was filled during the year. In 2022, no meetings were adjourned, due to the lack of a quorum. SSAB meetings were regularly announced to the public via the Clerk of the Board and SSAB websites. All meetings were held in person.

#### **Focus and Oversight**

The primary focus areas of the SSAB in 2023 were:

- Local Response to COVID-19 Emergency for all Public Assistance Programs, Waivers, Enrollment, Service Delivery: Self-Sufficiency Services staff provided monthly comprehensive updates for the SSAB.
- **Reducing Barriers to Enrollment:** Per the April 6, 2021, Board of Supervisors meeting, the Social Services Advisory Board (SSAB) was tasked by the Board of Supervisors with identifying opportunities ton increase access and enrollment in County Self-Sufficiency programs to serve every community member in need without barriers to entry.
  - O To carry this vision out, the SSAB was tasked with establishing a temporary adhoc subcommittee called the "Outreach, Accessibility, and Enrollment Task Force" comprised solely of four SSAB members. The Task Force has included a number of key stakeholders in the process as regular guests to the meetings.
  - o To assist with these activities the Task Force worked with a County procured contractor to obtain input from local experts, advocates, and County staff.

- During 2021, the Task Force provided monthly updates to the Board of Supervisors, provided an update on activities for the Board of Supervisors to review on December 7, 2021, and final recommendations were presented to the Board of Supervisors on March 15, 2022.
- Transparency and Access: To make it easier for stakeholders to attend and participate in SSAB meetings, the SSAB revised the language on its monthly agendas to clarify opportunities for public comment and began using the Zoom platform and recording its virtual meetings, and had translators available as needed.



- Hours of Operation: 8am 2pm 1<sup>st</sup> day.

- One-Stop-Shop: property tax relief, debris removal & disposal, vital document replacement, along with DMV, EDD services, and food distribution by NGOs such as San Diego Food Bank

- A total of 7 departments were represented



### **Overall LAC Results**



- A total of 39 different service providers were on site
- We had a robust staff presence, with between 150 to 200 individuals supporting LAC operations or providing direct services each day
- Approximately 1,375 households visited our LAC over the four days
- Service providers recorded 6,733 service interactions, providing information, guidance, or resources to families and individuals
- County Animal Services provided over 400 pounds of pet food for dogs and cats
- The County Department of Public Works fielded 126 new requests for assistance from unincorporated residents which included reports of flooded roads, damaged County and private infrastructure, and debris removal requests
- The County's Recorder County Clerk replaced over **500 vital records**, including marriage certificates, birth certificates, death certificates, and house deeds
- The San Diego Food Bank distributed 113,990 pounds of food to 940 families/3,726 individuals.
- The Social Security Administration processed 91 replacement applications for social security cards, with the new card being mailed directly to the applicants
- The Salvation Army contributed over \$30,000 to 313 households/ 1,222 individuals, along with providing 3,447 articles of clothing to 295 households and 31 emotional/spiritual care contacts
- The American Red Cross added an additional 219 addresses to their damage assessment teams'
  queue for follow-up.

    - This is a new <u>two-year</u> waiver based on 36 months of unemployment data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics from the period of August 2019 July 2022
  - Reinstatement waiver extended from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2027

# **Upcoming Changes**

  - With this expansion, all Medi-Cal applicants and beneficiaries are now approved for Full scope benefits regardless of age and immigration status if otherwise eligible

  - CalSAWS began transitioning existing customers and sending advance notices beginning November 1, 2023, for the
     January 1, 2024, month of eligibility

### **Asset Test Elimination**

- Effective January 1, 2024, the elimination of assets (property) became effective for all Non-MAGI Medi-Cal programs including:
  - Medically Needy
  - Aged & Disabled
  - Medicare Savings Programs
  - Long-Term Care
- Income producing assets such as Annuities, Retirement Plans/Pensions, Rental Property, are no longer considered when determining Medi-Cal eligibility
  - Any income from these assets will continue to count as Unearned income





# **Medi-Cal Managed Care Plans**

- Effective January 1, 2024, Aetna Better Health of CA and Health Net Community Solutions Inc. are no longer part of the San Diego County Geographic Managed Care Plan model in San Diego
  - Customers currently enrolled in these plans will be Automatically transitioned to Blue Shield or Community Health
     Group if no other plan is selected by December 31, 2023
- Aetna and Health Net plans stopped accepting new members as of October 1, 2023
