






## **UNEMPLOYMENT RATE**




# Historical and Projected General Purpose Property Tax Revenues

## STATE PERSONAL INCOME TAX REVENUE




### STATEWIDE MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT REVENUE

#### **Mental Health Services Act Funding**


by Fiscal Year (in billions)




### CALIFORNIA SALES & USE TAX REVENUE



## STATE BUDGET

#### **HHSA Impacts**

- \$54 million allocated to County of San Diego to further support COVID-19 efforts
- No cuts to State funding for HHSA programs:
  - Growth in all major public assistance programs including CalWORKs, Medi-Cal, and CalFresh.
  - Additional one-time supports in Foster Care.
  - Maintains funding for In-Home Supportive Services (no growth)
- Partial Realignment backfill
- Housing & Homelessness funding Opportunities








# HHSA BUDGET ISSUES & PRIORITIES

- Pandemic Response/Community Health is top priority
- Providing critical services, including increased service needs in safety net programs, during loss of significant revenue
- Continuing focus on vulnerable populations through:

  - Prioritizing Behavioral Health &
  - Homelessness/Affordable Housing
