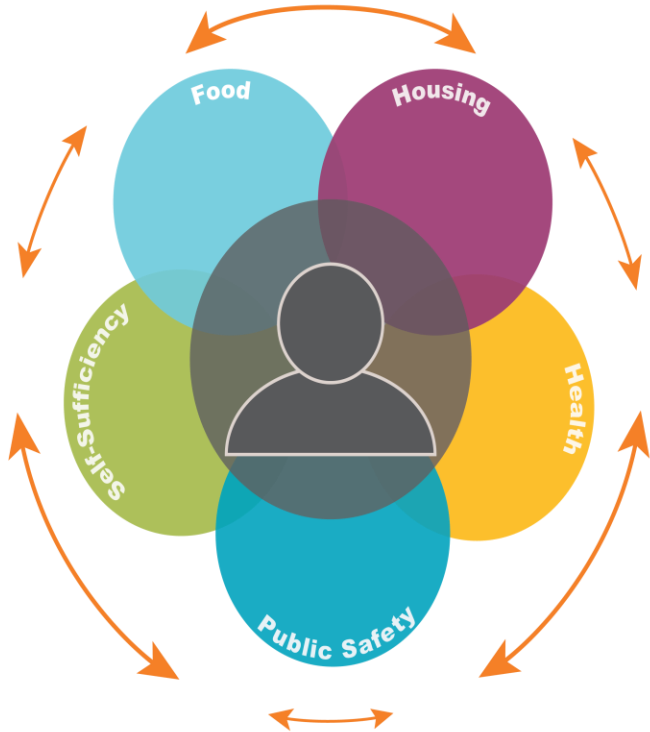
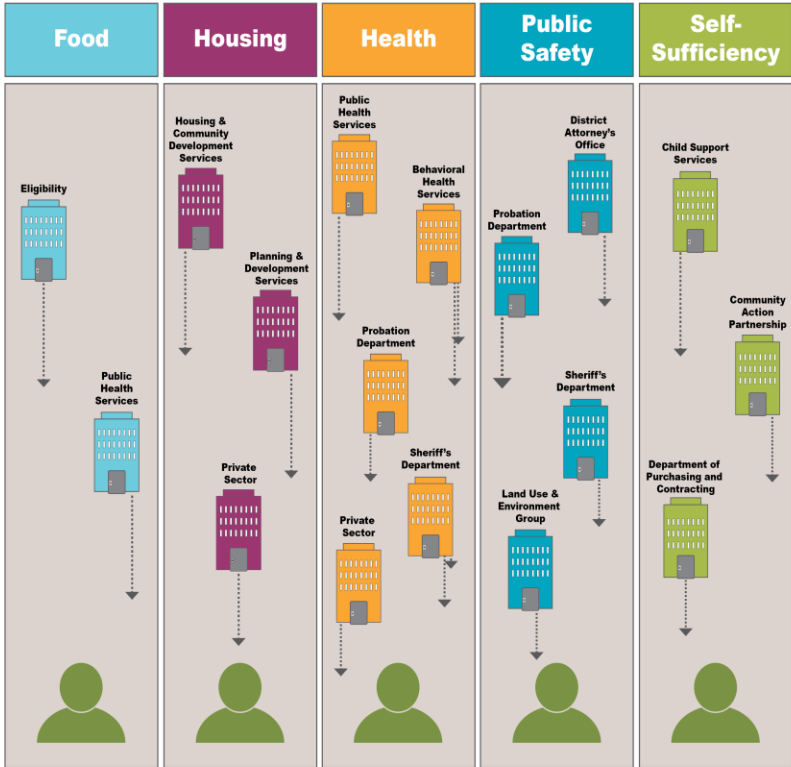

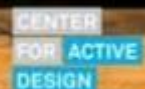

Integrating Health and Housing: *Healthy improvements to the built environment and the context of a person's home to drive healthy outcomes.*

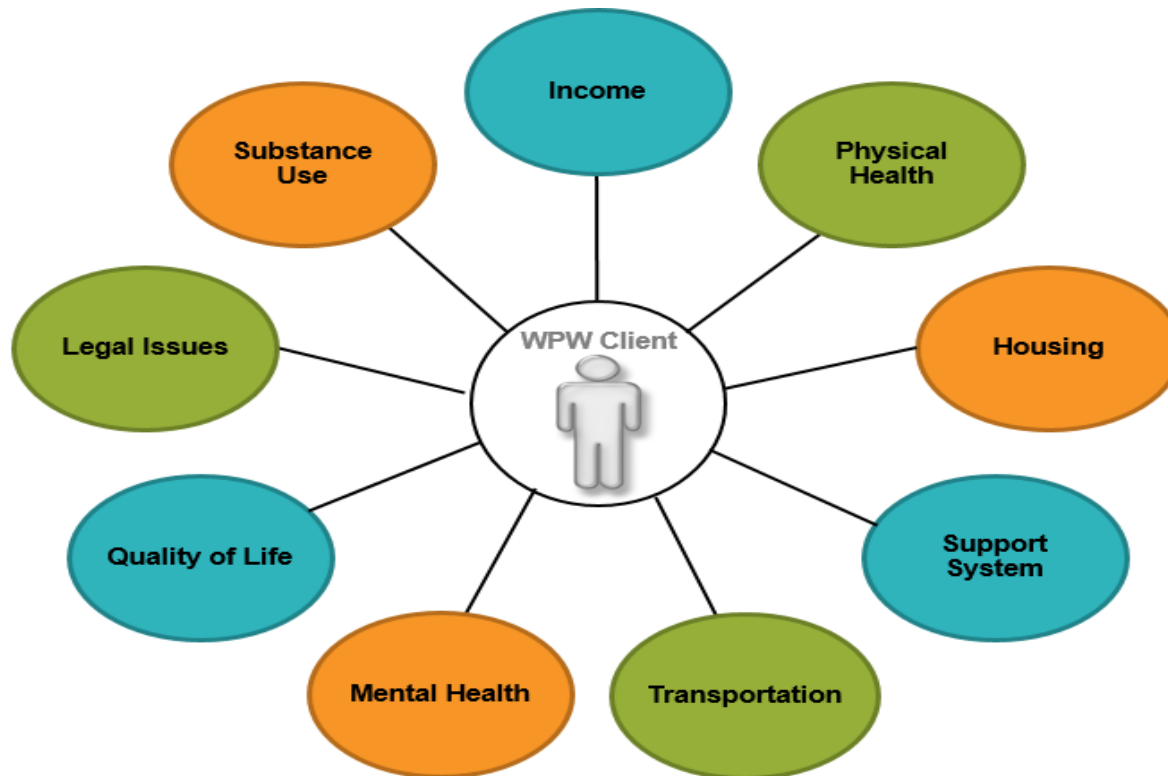
