Non-Agenda Comment

 Public comment supporting wrap-around services with Housing, and follow up for in home supportive services as a focus for committee topic.

Housing and Community Development Services (HCDS) - Housing Program Accessibility

- HCDS presented an overview of the department and responded to committee questions.
- Committee Inquiry and Feedback
 - Clarify use of non-elderly individuals as a reference
 - o Emphasize projects that serve veterans
 - Grants for homeowners as well as mobile homeowners
 - Rural east county programming
 - Funding sources determine standards used for programs and projects
 - No known impacts from current administration changes
 - o Affordable housing deed restrictions are a minimum of 55 years
 - County's permitting and programs consideration of universal design to support accessible housing designs.
 - More attention to ADA accommodations and reasonable requests in order to maintain long term housing for individuals with disabilities and who need ongoing support.
 - Committee can assist with ideas to advocate for funding, streamline processes and remove barriers
 - A more robust interactive process for requests due to disabilities
 - Dedicate more attention to individuals needing reasonable modification requests based on communication challenges
 - Voucher Retention
 - Contractor ADA Compliance and Commitment to Accessibility
 - Followup to Requests (inspections, annual recertification, etc.)
 - Ongoing Communication/Interaction with Individuals
 - Ongoing Care Needs
 - o Number/percentage of people with disabilities participating in programs
 - o Number of staff supporting "boots on the ground" activities
