How do I schedule an appointment?

Call 1-800-290-5000 or 711 (TTY), Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. or Saturday from 7 a.m. to 12 p.m. An advice nurse will help determine if a video or telephone appointment is right for your child's condition.

*Video appointments are not appropriate for emergency conditions, such as severe shortness of breath, severe abdominal pain, severe bleeding, or urgent conditions—like sprains, falls, or cuts needing stitches.
