

PAID INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Jay's Program is a 6-months, part-time, paid internship opportunity with the County of San Diego available to candidates served by PRIDE Industries. The program exists to help those with intellectual and developmental disabilities improve their job skills and increase opportunities for future employment.

Intern Experience Overview:

During the internship, interns collaborate with County mentors to discuss career goals and craft the course of their program experience. Tailored support is provided by PRIDE Industries job coaches, and twice a month interns join their cohort members for learning opportunities and townhalls to debrief their experiences and growth. Each cohort commences with a celebration and resume resources.

Expect to:

- o Gain practical work experience for resume development
- Learn knowledge, skills and abilities for entry-level County of San Diego office jobs

Qualifications:

- o Individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability
- Legal working age and eligible to work
- o Minimum High School Diploma or equivalent education
- Can travel independently or has dependable transportation
- Can work 20-hours a week
- Must be both an active SD Regional Center and PRIDE Industries client
- Preferred basic computer skills (MS Word, Outlook, Excel, PowerPoint, and Teams)
