

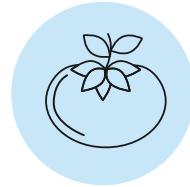
STATE OF THE FOOD SYSTEM FOR THE SAN DIEGO REGION

\$1.8 billion



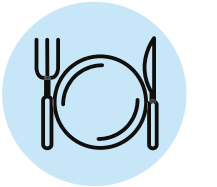
Commercial agriculture represents \$1.8 billion in annual total sales

30%



Of the total agriculture economic value, 30% derives from food production while 70% is from nursery and cut flower products

1 out of every 7



It is estimated that in San Diego region, over 500,000 tons of food is wasted each year while 1 out of every 7 residents face food insecurity

95%



Of the total agricultural land in the region, 95% is dedicated to food production, while 5% is for nursery and cut flowers

10%



Food system jobs represent 10% of the local economy

Local Food System



The region has 36 Certified Farmers' Markets, 21 farm stands, 17 community supported agriculture programs, and 1 dockside fishermen's market
