

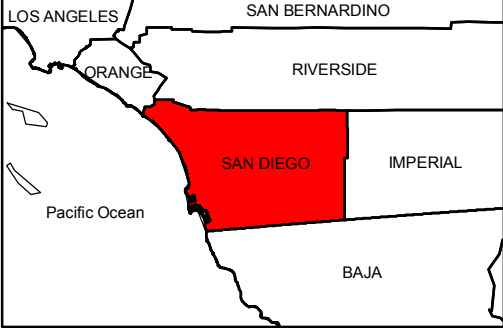

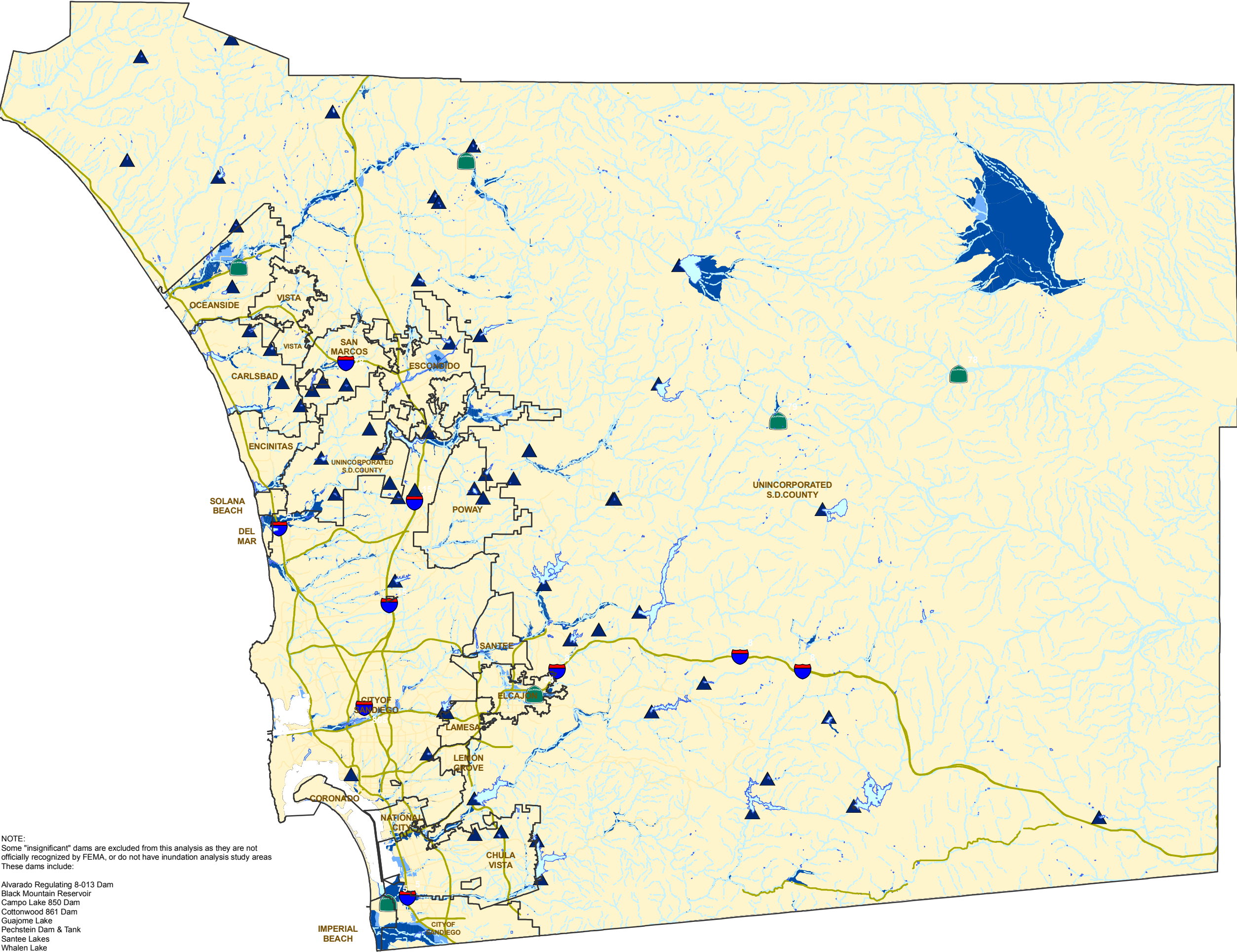
OVERVIEW MAP:
