 - 1. The owner/applicant of an approximately 160-acre property located at 23137 Japatul Valley Road, Alpine, CA (APN 523-120-32-00) has applied for a discretionary permit for a tentative parcel map to subdivide the property into 4 residential lots (PDS2023-TPM-21325). The lots would have septic systems and would rely on wells for water. The Group may make a recommendation on this application. **Presentation, Discussion & Action**
 - 2. The owner/applicant of the property located at 23137 Japatul Valley Road, Alpine, CA (APN 523-120-32-00) has applied for a discretionary permit for an oversized accessory structure (PDS2023-AD-23-002). The proposed structure will be a 2-story barn for farm equipment and general storage. The proposed structure height of 32 feet requires the discretionary permit. No electrical, lighting, plumbing (except fire suppression system), or mechanical shall be part of this project. No parking. Fire apparatus access shall be provided. Private use only for the main residence. The proposed shall be placed out of view and a minimum of 1,000' from the nearest property line. The Group may make a recommendation on this application. **Presentation, Discussion & Action**
 - 3. Representatives from the Sweetwater Authority (SWA) will make a presentation to the Group regarding operational decisions at Loveland Reservoir. Following the special presentation by SWA the Group will hear

individual and group public comments. The Group may make recommendations based on the feedback it receives. **Presentation, Discussion & Action**

- 4. The San Diego County Department of Public Works (DPW) has requested the ACPG's participation in identifying a prioritized list of transportation improvement projects on the county-maintained road network in Alpine. Project types include the following:
 - Road Reconstruction/Reconfiguration/New Roads: Improvements include adding and/or modifying street lighting, lanes, turning lanes, roundabouts, or bike lanes to improve safety and/or increase roadway capacity.
 - ii. *Bridges Repair/Reconstruction:* Improvements include adding and/or modifying street lighting, lanes, or bike lanes to improve safety and/or increase bridge capacity.
 - iii. Sidewalk/Pathways/Pedestrian Access Ramps: Improvements include sidewalks, pathways, and ramps that promote safety and walking in the community.
 - iv. Drainage: Improvements include corrections to storm drain problems on roadways or dip sections.
 - v. Traffic Signals: Installation of traffic signals to improve safety and traffic operation.
 - vi. *Intersections:* Improvements could include new signals and turn lanes to improve safety and traffic operation.
