- b. DPW Special Events Permit Ordinance Update - The County is updating the existing ordinance for “Special Events” in the right-of-way. Special Events include neighborhood block parties, athletic events, and parades and will update bicycle events, 5K runs as this is currently not included.
- c. San Diego County receives federal entitlement funds to invest in local communities. Requesting community goals and associated funding priorities for a 5- year period 2020-2024. Goals could include housing for persons with AIDS, Emergency Solutions Grant, HOME Investment Partnership, and Community Development Block Grant. Workshops will be held at 10 locations in the County from July 1, 2019 to July 31, 2019 at the County Administration Bldg.
