C. Davis asked for clarification of the meaning of "w/p" in section F) a) in the BCSG meeting minutes for July 2, 2019 and made a motion to approve, second by Faulk, all approve.

D. PUBLIC COMMUNICATION

E. There was no Bonsall School Board meeting during the past month, so Larissa Anderson did not have a reason to attend with a report.

F. ACTION ITEMS: (Voting Items)

- a. San Diego County Planning Manager Eric Lardy presented news on the County's draft zoning ordinance for small cell wireless networks (5G) that are to begin operation in cities in 2020. The County will follow the Federal rule that prohibits use of health guidelines in setting network facilities. There are bills in the U.S. House and Senate to overturn the FCC guidelines, which the State of CA is backing. The County is recommending stricter distance requirements for the maximum density coverage, which currently would allow each carrier to install an antenna every 500 ft. The County wants to allow two antennas per pole with the infrastructure being underground with the antenna and radio on the pole. The County is requiring proof of a <http://www.bcs.org>

reason why a new pole will be needed (thus pushing the carriers to use existing poles). There will continue to be a 1000 foot exclusion zone to schools, nursing homes, churches and day care centers. The group examined the maps provided and sought an answer about the exclusion zone South-East of Sullivan Middle School. Davis commented that the lack of an overall plan by the collective group of cell carriers has led to the chaotic development that exists today. Hatano and Davis requested stronger effort to co-locate antennas. Morgan requested strong enforcement of the carriers using their existing poles before allowance to put up new ones.

G. GROUP BUSINESS – INFORMATION AND DIRECTION

- a. The only update to the County’s Land Use Clean-Up General Plan is the purchase of land for the San Luis Rey River Park and its designation for park usage.
