- E. ACTION ITEMS: (Voting Items)
- a PDS2016-STP-05-050W1 Lilac Del Cielo project is located north of Camino Del Cielo and Camino Del Rey and is described as 76 residential units on an 8.5-acre parcel including appropriate utility and surface improvements. This item was continued from the January 3, 2017 meeting and the February 7th meeting massive new scoping letter was submitted to Group for review.
 - b. Chair has received a resignation of member Phillip Schwartze representing area two seat 2. Chair has received an application from Jeff Faulk who would like to represent area two seat number 2. Mr. Faulk has met the Bonsall Sponsor Group Standing Rules of Order filled out and submitted all County of San Diego documents. The Bonsall Sponsor Group will vote on his application and with approval will forward it to County staff for Board of Supervisor's approval and appointment.



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- c. County staff member **Crystal Benham Land Use/Environmental Planner, Planning** will present the County's Multiple Species Conservation Program (MSCP) which is a comprehensive habitat conservation planning program that addresses multiple species' habitat needs and preserves native vegetation communities. The program provides permitting authority to the County for "take" of endangered species – therefore, it also streamlines permitting processes and provides certainty to the development community. The County has three separate planning processes for the overall MSCP – one in the South County, one in the North County, and one in the East County. The South County Plan was finalized in 1998 and the North County Plan is currently being developed – County staff will provide an update on the current status and next steps for development of the North County Plan.

F. GROUP BUSINESS

- a. Community Planning and Sponsor Group Quarterly Chair's Meeting will be held at the County Operations Center April 15th 2017. Vice-Chair Davis will be attending in place of Chair Morgan. The Valley Center Planning Group will be requesting that in addition to the Counties agenda the topic of the amendment to the Quimby Act be added to the agenda.
