- A. CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL. Meeting called to order at 5:00 p.m. Present Chair Rebecca Falk, Vice-Chair John Peterson, Nancy McRae, Bill Berkley, Bill Haneline, Julie Gerson, Jim Dax, Bruce Durbin, Judy Haldeman.
- **B.** APPROVAL OF MINUTES FOR THE MEETING OF May 4, 2023. MOTION: Approval of the Minutes of May 4, 2023. Peterson M, Haneline S. Falk added some clarifications to Items D. 3. and D. 4. Approval as amended. Unanimous.
- C. PUBLIC COMMUNICATION (may be limited to 3 min): Opportunity for members of the public to speak to the Group on any subject matter within the Group's jurisdiction that is not on the posted agenda. Tammy Baker asked to have an item added to a future agenda regarding volutaria weed and asked that the Sponsor Group take action to request a more aggressive eradication policy by the county.

D. ACTION ITEMS:

- 1. San Diego Traffic Engineering Study of Trucks on Montezuma Grade. The BSCSG had questions about the study before being able to make a recommendation. Zoubir Ouadah, County Traffic Engineer, presenting, with Murali Pasumarthi, Acting Deputy Director, Department of Public Works via Zoom. See agenda packet for the study. Quadah presented the report to the Sponsor Group and explained the recommendation to post signs prohibiting trucks over 60 feet from using Montezuma Grade. MOTION: To accept the recommendation. Peterson M, Berkley S. Falk, Peterson, Berkley, Haneline, Gerson, Dax, Durbin and Haldeman aye. McRae abstained.
- 2. San Diego Climate Action Plan (CAP) Update, Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (SEIR), smart growth alternatives. The County conducted stakeholder outreach to provide input on smart growth alternatives, including input on location (e.g., where smart growth should occur) and incentives/disincentives to develop smart growth areas. We are meeting with your group again to make sure we have the smart growth locations requested and to capture any remaining input. PDS will begin to write the Alternatives Chapter in May/June. See: https://www.sandiegocounty.gov/content/sdc/sustainability/climateactionplan/sgamaps.html for maps. Darin Neufeld, Director Environmental Planning/Compliance, Harris and Associates. One map in agenda packet. Neufeld reported that the climate action team will continue working on this and reach out to the Sponsor Group at a later date and stated that ways to encourage development were on the table. Falk reported that plans were underway to create a new fire station and senior living adjacent to the library and Durbin commented that VMT was appropriate for senior housing. Neufeld added that affordable housing was also exempt from VMT.
- 3. Update from SDGE on last power outage and upcoming Sunday, June 6^{th-} 7th overnight outage, 7:30 pm 6:30 am. Dallin Young, Public Affairs Manager, SDGE, presenting. Young stated that this outage was planned in order to complete the work that was not done in May and responded that the micro grid could not be used in this case as the large generator was not operating. Young stated that the micro grid should be online by next year. Durbin commented that this is why Community Choice is growing.
- 4. Two or three nominations needed for Watermaster Board Community Representative Alternate because Martha Deichler, who has held that position, has resigned. Nominations come from the BSCSG, the ABDSP, the BVSC--each group nominating at least two (or three) people for the positions, and the BS Unified School District nominating one person, and then a hearing and vote is held at the Borrego Water District to choose the community representative from the nominees. There are requirement to fill the position. See agenda packet for the process to elect a replacement. Sponsor Group nominees will be affirmed by BSCSG vote. MOTION: To recommend Jim Dax and Gary Haldeman for the alternate position. Peterson M Berkley S. Unanimous approval.

- 5. Updating Standing Committee Membership/Meeting Times. Updates from Community ID Signs Committee-(Bruce Durbin and Nancy McRae Co-Chairs, Committee Member Jim Dion, affirm addition of Community
 Members Ellen Fitzpatrick, Betsy Knaak and Alicia Wszelaki. MOTION: To add Ellen Fitzpatrick, Betsy Knaak and
 Alicia Wszelaki to the committee. McRae M, Durbin S. Unanimous approval. WATCO/Water Committee, Chair
 John Peterson, Committee Members Jim Dax, Bill Berkley and Diane Johnson. Confirm additional member Gary
 Haldeman to take effect if also voted in at the next WATCO Committee meeting. MOTION: To support the
 addition of Gary Haldeman when the committee meets in the fall. Falk M, Dax S. Unanimous approval.
- 6. Affirm BSCSG in summer recess in July and August. Next regular meeting September 7th unless urgent business requires a special meeting. MOTION: To approve summer recess until September. Gerson M, Berkley S. Unanimous approval.

Supervisor Desmond's item passed unanimously at the May 24th Board of Supervisors Meeting: INCREASING UNDERSTANDING OF DECARBONIZATION EFFORTS BY CONDUCTING A LOCAL ANALYSIS OF EXISTING RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL AND OTHER INFILL RENEWABLE ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY AND IDENTIFYING REMAINING AVAILABLE ROOFTOP, PARKING LOT AND OTHER INFILL CAPACITY FOR FUTURE RENEWABLE ENERGY PROJECTS (DISTRICTS: ALL). Falk stated that the intriguing idea of a public facility campus adjacent to the library was presented and also stated that she had met with Elizabeth Rodriguez and Marsh Boring on infrastructure long-range planning.
