9 **Administrative Items**

11 A. Call to Order: R. Caldwell called the meeting to order at 4:35PM  
12 B. Roll Call: Present - Beltran, R. Caldwell, Dr. S. Caldwell, Falk, King, Webb  
13 Absent – Haldeman  
14 C. Approval of Agenda: King moved to approve the sponsor group agenda as amended  
15 (location of meeting was changed from Community Room to Cafeteria). Dr. S. Caldwell  
16 seconded. The motion passed unanimously (6 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained).  
17 D. Members’ review of maps and other printed materials for meeting: No time was  
18 required to review printed materials.  
19 E. Approval of Minutes: King moved to approve the May 2, 2013 minutes for the study  
20 groups workshop and for the sponsor group meeting as amended. Falk seconded. The  
21 motion passed unanimously (6 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained).  
22 F. Correspondence: R. Caldwell announced that he attended the May 5 meeting of the  
23 Borrego Village Association. R. Caldwell had nothing to report other than the fact that  
24 he attended.  
25 G. Committee Reports:  
26 • Community Plan Development Committee – R. Caldwell attended the meeting at  
27 1:15PM on May 2 with county staff to discuss the general plan cleanup.  
28 • Parks Committee – Abby King reported that there were no new developments for  
29 that committee.  
30 H. Public Comment:  
31 • Gwen Marie requested that the Sponsor Group put the Community Right of Way  
32 Development Standards update on the September agenda in order to start the review  
33 process. The last update was in 1989. The update request must be received by the  
34 county from the Sponsor Group.  
35 • Joe Hopkins called to the Sponsor Group’s attention a project on Split Mountain  
36 Rd. The project is a 330 acre photovoltaic electricity generating facility. Hopkins’  
37 specific concern was whether or not the project’s water, which will come from the  
38 Borrego Valley Water district, was adequately addressed in the project’s  
39 environmental review. It is not clear if the project is in the Sponsor Group’s  
40 community planning area.
