Attachment A: Email sent Peterson to Malone September 14, 2023, regarding the groundwater monitoring program:

Thanks for your time last June 15 to take a look at the potential monitoring wells (for water levels) that the community has identified. Specially this for the area south of Henderson Canyon Road and north of Borrego Palm Canyon.

We believe that there are a number of steps that must be taken before the Watermaster staff can bring the wells into the monitoring system. At this point only step one and two has been completed so far. (See below for additional details).

Steps:

- 1) Have the local community identify potential existing wells that could be potential used for monitoring sites.
 - 2) Technical personnel from West Yost with the local representatives examine the sites.
- 3) Determination from West Yost that the potential well(s) could be used to expand the monitoring network. This would be based on the location of the well(s) and if it would fill in a gap in the existing network.
- 4) The local community works on identifying the parcel owner(s) and then works with local resources and/or West Yost personnel to obtain ownership permission to add the well into the network.
- 5) Based on the results of the above tasks the decision will need to be made to retrofit the well(s) to allow for access wire line water level equipment or an installation of a data logger. It is likely that a pump rig will be required to make the modifications.
- 6). Plan for a day or two with a pump rig to make the necessary modifications to the well. (That must be paid for from Watermaster Board funds).
- 7) Only after all these steps have been completed can we include the monitoring well into the system and this will likely require time to complete all necessary steps.

As I see it (and please correct me if I have missed anything) we are waiting for step 3 on this list prior to us in the community starting on step 4. Can we get this information from you guys? Or do you want to wait until after the next Watermaster Board meeting in October.

Thanks much and looking forward to working with you in the future to expand the monitoring system.
