D. PUBLIC COMMUNICATION:

- Linda Shannon asked why the County is so proactively educating the neighbors on Ribbonwood what a private
 road is (relating to the new asphalt-paved access road from Ribbonwood to Rough Acres).
- The Chair answered that the new road is under the County's jurisdiction because it serves the large scale industrial projects such as Tule Wind, Rugged Solar, and big Rough Acres Conference Center /campground project. The related Major Use Permits all require a secondary fire access route.
- The Chair advised Linda to talk with her neighbor, York, as he recently spoke with the County with similar concerns about the pavement, curbs, and drainage.
- Mark Ostrander announced that the Jacumba/Boulevard Revitalization Alliance 501c3 will be taking over the Boulevard Training Room facility. The will allow the Boulevard Planning Group to continue their monthly meetings there free of charge.
- The Chair expressed her appreciation to Mark and the Revitalization Alliance for their efforts and support.

- 6. 74 MW RUGGED SOLAR: PDS2017-MUP-12-007W1 MAJOR USE PERMIT MODIFICATION-NEW PROJECT DESCRIPTON: (The Boulevard Planning Group formally voted to deny this project and to submit comments on 11-2-17)
 - Jim Whalen reported there will be a January 5th meeting with County staff on the new Scoping Letter released on 12-22-17, the Friday before Christmas.
 - Neither the Chair, nor board member Ron Hynum, received copies even though they were both listed on the distribution. Jim said he would forward a copy.
 - Project is 60% of old Soitec project. In Jim's opinion, the issues raised were minor due to the project size reduction, reduction in ground water, and the differing technology.
 - Whalen suggested the Group could be more effective if we don't contest these smaller, less intrusive projects so that the developers are able to steer more of their mitigation funds to the community rather than to delays and legal posturing to get them approved.
 - A visual side-by-side analysis will be done to compare the size of the approved and proposed project.
 - The Chair commented that other rural communities have community centers, libraries, and parks
 without having to accept industrial scale energy/transmission projects and noted that the Group had
 previously developed and provided a list of community needs to project developers.
