- 1. <u>DISCRETIONARY PERMIT FOR ALCOHOL BEVERAGE CONTROL PDS2023-ABC-23-002:</u> The Planning Group shall submit their recommendation within 7 days following the Board's vote on the discretionary permit application submitted to PDS for a liquor/convenience store (APN 612-040-08-00), located at 39335 Old Hwy 80, Boulevard, CA 91905 (the former Deli/Market location at the intersection of 94 & Old Hwy 80).
- 2. MOUNTAIN TOP MARKET POWER CONNECTION TO THE SDG&E'S MICRO GRID: This item was tabled until the July meeting by a Board vote for lack of participation by Nick Aziz, owner of Mountain Top Market. A letter of support was sent to Supervisor Anderson (cc: to Gregory Kazmer, Dallin Young, SDG&E) By private citizen Donna Tisdale 4/25/2023. There was no response from Supervisor Anderson's office. Dallin Young responded with a commitment to supply a standby generator. Since the last meeting, Nick has mailed a letter to Supervisor Anderson asking for help from his office. G. PROJECT UPDATES:

1. 100 MW STARLIGHT SOLAR PLUS BATTERIES PLANNED FOR 565 ACRES IN 8 EMPIRE RANCH AREAS OF JEWEL VALLEY AREA; MAJOR USE PERMIT (MUP) NOTICE OF PROJECT: PDS2022-MPA-22-006. 20 MW POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT REPORTED WITH SDG&E: Project is industrial scale 100 MW solar facility with battery energy storage system (BESS), collector substation, transformers, inverters, gen-tie line, and 24' internal roads,

water tanks for fire protection, security fencing, lighting, and signage. Project has proposed eight solar array areas with approximately 300,000 PV modules on support structures. - 2. **REGIONAL DECARBONIZATION FRAMEWORK (RDF):** Consideration is pending the confirmation of a new District 4 representative.

- 3. TERRA-GEN'S BOULDER BRUSH FACILITIES (SUBSTATION GEN-TIE) PDS2022-MUP-19-002TE: The County vested Terra-Gen's project so their permit Time Extension application has been withdrawn. On October 21, Judge Ronald Frazier granted Intervenor-Defendant Campo Band of Diegueno Mission Indians' Motion to Dismiss the legal challenge to the County's approval of this project, due to their sovereign immunity. - 4. 74 MW RUGGED SOLAR PDS2017-MUP-12-007W1 MAJOR USE PERMIT MODIFICATION APPROVED ON 10-12-22. CONSTRUCTION EXPECTED TO START WITHIN A YEAR OR SO: The developer agreed to remove the concertina wire from fencing; to reduce interior pole height to 40ft; and to include additional \$25,000 to community benefit donation. The Board of Supervisors approved the project on October 12, 2022 with direction to the Chief Administrative Officer to report back to the Board within 180 days with the three options for the Mountain Empire area: https://bosagenda.sandiegocounty.gov/cob/cosd/cob/doc?id=0901127e80f2ae72
- 5. **DECORATIVE COMMUNITY SIGN:** Waiting for response to our interest from Kenton Jones at DPW.
- 6. **SDG&E's BOULEVARD MICROGRID & STRATEGIC UNDERGROUNDING:** CPUC approved the project on 6/23/22. Work in progress. Completion is expected in August 2023.
- 7. TERRA-GEN'S 252 MW-60 TURBINE CAMPO WIND PROJECT. ON OCTOBER 27th THE 9th CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEALS DIMISSED THE LEGAL CHALLENGE BASED ON TRIBAL SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY: Campo Wind was approved for Campo Reservation land by Dept of Interior April 2020. Federal lawsuit filed 7-8-20. On August 6, 2021, the federal judge granted the Campo Band's Motion to Dismiss the case based on sovereignty. The case was appealed to 9th Circuit. In 2021, the FAA approved the project for second time despite SO CAL TRACON objections over significant aviation impacts. An appeal of FAA approval is still in process at the 9th Circuit.
- 8. 90 MW JACUMBA VALLEY RANCH ENERGY PARK (JVR SOLAR); APPROVED BY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ON 8-18-21. CEQA LAWSUIT WAS FILED AND DISMISSED. AN APPEAL WAS FILED: 90 megawatt (MW) solar energy facility and a battery energy storage system of up to 90 MW (360 MWh) on 613 acres. Project documents are posted at: https://www.sandiegocounty.gov/content/sdc/pds/ceqa/MUP-18-022.html.
- 9. <u>TERRA-GEN'S 126 MW TORREY WIND PROJECT WITH 30-4.2 MW TURBINES: PDS2018-MUP-18-014:</u>
 Notification was received on 6/12/2023 that the Torrey Wind project has been formally withdrawn per email message from Nick Koutoufidis, Land Use & Environment Planner: Nicholas.Koutoufidis1@sdcounty.ca.gov.
- 10. 60 MW 420 ACRE BOULEVARD SOLAR MUP12-010TE PDS2012-3300-12-00 @ 796 Tierra Del Sol Road; No project progress reported. The absentee owner is still promoting it. Permit was set to expire at the end of July 2022. Another Major Use Permit Time Extension is reportedly being processed.
- 11. **SEMPRA'S CIMMARON WIND**: 300 MW wind & 500 MW Volta Mexicali battery storage project in Mexico. Nothing to report.
- 12. <u>TULE WIND PHASE II-69MW</u>: Currently permitted to erect up to 24 new turbines on State land and the Ewiiaapayaap Reservation. No progress since approximately 2016.
