Groundwater, Sewer and Septic, Nick: **NICK REPORTS OBSERVING GROUND WATER COMING UP FROM THE GROUND NORTH SIDE OF OLD HWY 80 NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF OLD BUCKMAN SPRINGS RD AND HOLD HWY 80. THIS WATER HAS BEEN RUNNING ACROSS THE ROAD FOR A WHILE, BUT NOW THERE ARE VISIBLE ROAD ISSUES, ROAD IS CRACKED AND LARGE POTHOLES ARE FORMING. CONTINUED CONCERNS ABOUT GROUNDWATER CONTAMINATION IF THE CRESTWOOD CEMETARY MOVES FORWARD.**

Community Economic Impacts, Steve Biddle: **STEVE REPORTS LOTS OF BUSINESS FRONT VACANCIES AND WAS CONCERNED ABOUT THE LOCAL ECONOMIC IMPACTS.
